CREATED TO DO GOOD WORKS

Ephesians 2:10

We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

We are God's workmanship

You are My workmanship, Joan. I have designed you and given you all that you need to do what I have for you to do.

We are created in Christ Jesus. What does that mean?

Created in Christ Jesus. What does that mean? I created you in Me. You are My creation. I chose you and created you to be just exactly what I wanted you to be. All you have to do is trust Me and follow Me.

We are created to do good works

I created you to do good works. That means I have a special good work for each of My creation to do. I put the ability in you do the good works I have planned for you to do. If all My children do the good works I put in them to do, then all will be done right and well.

God prepared in advance those good works for us to do

I put each person on the earth at just the right time for that person to do the good works I created them for - and I created for them. I did all this in advance of your coming to earth.

CONSUMINGFIRE

This scripture caught my attention this morning:

Who of us can dwell with the consuming fire? Who of us can dwell with everlasting burning? He who walks righteously and speaks what is right, who rejects gain from extortion and keeps his hand from accepting bribes, who stops his ears against plots of murder and shuts his eyes against contemplating evil - this is the man who will dwell on the heights, whose refuge will be the mountain fortress. His bread will be supplied, and water will not fail him.

Your eyes will see the king in his beauty and view a land that stretches afar. (Isaiah 33:14-17)

I think I am to study about "the consuming fire" today. Is that right, Lord?

Yes, that's right. I have some special scripture passages I want to show you about My consuming fire.

Habakkuk 2:2-3

Then the Lord replied: 'Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it. For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it: it will certainly come and will not delay.

That makes you think of the last scene in your series of visions in 1985, doesn't it?

The Last Scene in my series of visions in 1985

I see people praying, kneeling at the front of the sanctuary in front of the platform. I only see their silhouettes and they are aqua blue. They are surrounded by a rose-colored light. The four who met in the air came together into a ball of fire. This ball started moving around inside the sanctuary in an arc to come down and touch someone, then went up in another arc to some other part of the sanctuary to come down and touch someone else. It kept doing this over and over, faster and faster, touching more and more people. Each time it went in the arc through the air it left a trail of silver dust, like a jet trail in the sky, so these trails increased and increased within the inside of the sanctuary. It kept going faster and faster until it exploded so the light and silver dust filled everywhere.

That last scene is starting to happen now - now meaning since about 2000. It is increasing and going faster every day, and touching millions of people. It will accelerate much faster. You will see it. Much will be happening that I have been getting you and Beth in place for. You will be part of it - the "much happening".

It will surely involve CTC in a profound way, and you both will be part of that, as well as one-on-one with others and also personally for each of you.

You see in your mind that "ball of fire" moving up and around, touching people here and there. If you think of that sanctuary in which you see it moving as 'the world' then you can see that ball of fire going around 'the world' and touching people and groups all over the world. That's what the sanctuary represents - it represents where I am working around the world, in My sanctuary, the place where I am dwelling and working.

My Holy Spirit ball of fire is using and taking *My* people all around the world to people groups and setting them on fire for *Me*.

My fire is burning!

Look up all the Scriptures that fit this scenario and write them here:

Jeremiah 23:29 "Is not my word like fire?" declares the Lord.

Acts 2:3

They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.

Hebrews 12:29 For our God is a consuming fire.

Luke 12:49 I have come to bring fire on the earth.

Exodus 24:15-17

When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, and the glory of the Lord settled on Mount Sinai. For six days the cloud covered the mountain, and on the seventh day the Lord called to Moses from within the cloud. To the Israelites the glory of the Lord looked like a consuming fire on top of the mountain.

Ezekiel 1:4-5

I looked, and I saw a windstorm coming out of the north--an immense cloud with flashing lighting and surrounded by brilliant light. The center of the fire looked like glowing metal, and in the fire was what looked like four living creatures.

Ezekiel 1:27

...and high above on the throne was a figure like that of a man. I saw that from what appeared to be his waist up he looked like glowing

metal, as if full of fire, and that from there down he looked like fire; and brilliant light surrounded him.

Daniel 7:9-10

As I looked, thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His clothing was as white as snow; the hair of his head was white like wool. His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him. Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him. The court was seated, and the books were opened.

This is now, Joan. I am on My throne with the books open and judging the ten thousand times ten thousand (meaning all peoples) who are 'before Me' - as My eyes run to and fro throughout the earth. The court with Me is also seated meaning they are also ready and waiting to judge with Me and watch Me judge the earth. The books are now open for the judgment. That judgment is like a fire coming out from before Me to the earth.

There is very little 'time' left for people to change positions from where they are right now.

Isaiah 4:4

In that day -- The Lord will.... cleanse the bloodstains from Jerusalem by a spirit of judgment and a spirit of fire.

Hebrews 1:7 He makes.... his servants flames of fire.

My fire is burning. It is making judgment throughout the earth. You (people) will either be consumed by fiery passion for Me or fiery passion for the enemy. Soon there will be no "in between." People must choose. They choose Me or they reject Me (which means they choose to live on earth without Me). If they choose to live without Me, then they will be deceived by the enemy and will think they are right, but they will be dead wrong!

Joel 3:14

Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the Lord is near in the valley of decision.

Come, My children, come to Me and be saved! I want you for Mine, but I allow you freedom to choose to live without Me. It is a sad choice to do so, a sad choice. It means you will die. There will be no 'life' in you for I am Life. If you have no Life, then you die. I want My own to come to Me, Joan, and I want you to pray for that as often as I bring it to your mind. They have mostly come already, but there are a few more.

I didn't know it was that close, Lord.

It is. There is not much time left.

Come to Me, My children. I love you and I want you to be Mine. When I close the opportunity to choose Me, I want you to be with Me. And the opportunity will close soon. Then I will take My own to heaven to be with Me, and you (if you don't choose Me) will be left on earth to face the judgment. Some of you will choose Me then, and I will love you for that, but you will have to 'go through' the judgment just the same.

It is so much better if you choose Me now, before the Rapture...so much better!

Come, My children and choose Me while there is still time.

THENAME

Today I want you to focus in on MY NAME and study My Word regarding My name. I have a lot to teach you from My Word about My name. Learn from Me. Listen to Me as you read these scriptures. Ask Me to reveal Myself to you through My name.

Numbers 6:22-24

The Lord said to Moses, "Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites, Say to them: "The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace." So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them.' "

Exodus 3:15

This is my name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation.

Exodus 20:7

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

Deuteronomy 28:58-59

If you do not carefully follow all the words of this law, which are written in this book, and do not revere this glorious and awesome name - the Lord your God - the Lord will send fearful plagues on you and your descendants, harsh and prolonged disasters, and severe and lingering illnesses.

THE SCHOOL OF SALVATION

In this dream it was the first day of kindergarten class. The setting was the kindergarten room. Somehow I had invited the parents to visit that day also. I led the class as usual, but had occasional discussions with various parents also. Then it was time for them all to leave and go home. Several children went to another room or place and didn't leave in time to catch the bus home. I found them and tried to make arrangements for them and their parents to get home. It seemed like I may have been taking some of them home in my own car.

Is teaching the earth people like teaching children? Children who may not have even started the School of the Spirit - The School of Salvation?

Yes, Lord, it seems like that. And it seems many earth children not only don't know about eternal salvation but also have been brainwashed into negative thinking - which also must be untaught so they can be re-taught right thinking.

Yes, it is so. It is that way now. Children have an extra hard time coming to know Me because they are not taught right thinking from their parents, from their schools, from going to church, from things they read, and from society on TV, etc.

But, do not fear; I am greater than all these influences. I can touch ANYONE - I can touch the seed I planted down inside them that gives them a yearning to find Me (just like I gave you).

In the dream, what does it mean? Does it refer to your time right now with the rapture imminent? Yes, it does.

It means, it is the first day of school for some children. and it is the first day of kindergarten for some parent-aged people too (men and women). And you are talking with all of them and starting their teaching/learning process in My

School of the Spirit. It means you are influencing them individually and directly - AND seeing that they all get HOME - or at least have a way home and are on their way there. Home refers to heaven.

CHILDRENOFGOD

Deuteronomy 4:9

Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you do not forget the things your eyes have seen or let them slip from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them.

Deuteronomy 11:18-19

Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. GREAT AND UNSEARCHABLE

I had a dream. Basically what I remember about it was that it dealt with scripture. There seemed to be a tunnel where the scripture was and in that tunnel there were three levels of translations of scripture. These levels seemed to be time related, as if there were different translations at different times in history and/or different times relating to me.

Lord, did I remember the dream right? Was the dream from You? What does it mean in my life?

Yes, the dream WAS from Me. And yes, you remember it rightly. What does it mean? Wait before Me until I tell you. It is "great and unsearchable" so you must call to Me and wait for Me to answer you.

Jeremiah 33:3 Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.

I call to You, Lord, to tell me what the dream means.

This is what the dream means.

I have three different levels of understanding of various things that happen on earth.

- Lowest level is your earth-thought level that which comes to your mind immediately when you hear or see it.
- The middle level is that which can come with study, dream interpretation, experience, wisdom and understanding.
- The highest level is thinking and perceiving from My mind, My thoughts, and My intentions. For that level of understanding you must wait before Me until I reveal it to you because it comes through your spirit-to-Spirit communication with Me. This takes time and focus on Me.

This highest level (My mind and My thinking) is what you desire and what I desire. So, I have shown this to you in your dream so that you know that it exists.

THAT is what I am referring to in Jeremiah 33:3 as "great and unsearchable."

HEAVEN

THE EXPANSE CREATED BY GOD

Genesis 1:1, 8 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...God called the expanse "sky."

Psalm 8:1, 3

You have set your glory above the heavens...When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him?

There are levels of forgiveness: surface level and deeper level.

If you don't forgive deeply, then you judge in that area.

Cleanse me, Jesus, when I need it. Change me when I need it.

That's part of the Fear of The Lord.

I know what level you are on - in everything.

Forgive me, Lord, for forgiving some people on a surface level and then judging them. Change me, Lord, to be like You, and so I can forgive as You do - "as far as the east is from the west." Cleanse me, wash me, in Your blood, and forgive me.

As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. (Psalm 103:12)

THAT, Joan, is the Fear of the Lord.

They overcame by the blood of the Lamb, and the word of their testimony, and they loved not their lives unto death. (Revelation 12:11)

They were not afraid to give up their lives unto death. That's what that means - give up their lives unto death - giving up what they think and letting it die so I, Jesus, can be formed in them.

Teach me Your ways so that I may know You and continue to find favor with You.

If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you. (Exodus 33:13)

I will, Joan. This is called - The Fear of the Lord - submission to MY ways of doing things...and willingness to treasure My words and follow them.

If I have you print this - those who don't have My Spirit won't understand. And those who do have My Spirit will be blessed by it - to the level they are ready to understand. That's why I say My Spirit gives wisdom and understanding.

A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him - The Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord - and he will delight in the fear of the Lord. Part of what My Spirit is, and gives, is understanding.

That's when the seven Spirits of God were on Him (Isaiah 11:1-3). I thought about His spending time communing with Father and how delightful that was for Him.

My beloved is mine and I am his. (Song of Solomon 2:16)

I, the Lord, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. (Isaiah 42:6)

WHAT IS LOVING?

I was thinking about how we are supposed to learn to love and about how things we do don't have eternal value unless they are done in love as per 1 Corinthians 13. So I was asking the Lord about "What is loving?"

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing. (1 Corinthians 13:1-3)

Forgiving is loving. It is a choice you make to love Me and to love others.

Forgive as the Lord forgave you. (Colossians 3:13)

You love Me by choosing to be obedient to what I gave as commands.

If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. (John 15:10)

You loved people by organizing Discipleship Training classes for them so they could grow closer to Me. You loved Me by teaching them to observe whatever I commanded you.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19-20)

You loved one person by forgiving him and praying for him.

So - if I obey Your commands and forgive others and bless them and pray for them, I will be loving them?

Yes.

I tell you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven. (Matthew 5:44)

So if I deny myself and take up my cross and follow You - I will be loving You and loving others?

Yes.

If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. (Luke 9:23)

IN MY FATHER'S HOUSE

In my Father's house are many rooms: if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. (John 14:2-3)

This scripture referring to my Father's house caught my attention today as I read in the book of John chapter 14. So I looked up more scriptures referring to my Father's house.

Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked. (Psalm 84:10)

Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. (Psalm 23:6)

In studying the Father's house I am drawn to contemplate about the heavenly house which the Lord has prepared for us in a city called the heavenly Jerusalem. I am intrigued by pondering the heavenly Jerusalem, which is what the angel in Revelation 21:9 call the bride, the wife of the Lamb.

One of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues came and said to me, "Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb." And he carried me away in the Spirit to a mountain great and high, and showed me the Holy City, Jerusalem,

coming down out of heaven from God. It shone with the glory of God, and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal. (Revelation 21:9-11)

And I have prepared a city for you, My daughter, a lovely place where you will find all the joy and peace that you seek while you are living on earth - and more, much more. It will be the place where I dwell WITH YOU completely.

I will be there, and you will be there, and all who belong to Me will be there in this heavenly dwelling place. It is called "the city of the living God."

But you have come to Mount Zion, the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. (Hebrews 12:22-23)

I saw the Holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now, the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God." (Revelation 21:2-3)

Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life. (Revelation 21:27)

The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him. They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. There will be no more night. (Revelation 22:3-5)

Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city. (Revelation 22:14)

The New Jerusalem is the dwelling place throughout eternity for the saints of all ages and fulfills the hope of Abraham for the heavenly city. (From NIV Scofield Study Bible note on Revelation 21:2)

Abraham: For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God. (Hebrews 11:10)

Instead, they were longing for a better country - a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them. (Hebrews 11:16) ~ 30 ~

HOLY SPIRIT TEACHING ME WHO HE IS

During the night the Holy Spirit taught me. I asked Him to heal my infected toe before I went to sleep. When I awoke during the night He told me He fixed it. Then He reminded me of one scripture:

Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him? (Matthew 7:9-11)

Then He began to tell me who He, the Holy Spirit, is...

I am the Power Source of the Godhead. I am the Spirit of the Father. I entered Jesus at His baptism with Holy Spirit power.

As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. (Matthew 3:16)

I am the One who talks to you in our conversations.

I am the Healer who came into the Kathryn Kuhlman meetings and healed people.

I am the shadow that exuded from Peter that healed all who came into it.

People brought the sick into the streets and laid them on beds and mats so that at least Peter's shadow might fall on some of them as he passed by. Crowds gathered also from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those tormented by evil spirits, and all of them were healed. (Acts 5:15-16)

I am the One who can cause everyone in a meeting to fall to the floor.

I am the Power that transported Philip from the Ethiopian man traveling along the road to a city miles away.

The Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing. Philip, however, appeared at Azotus. (Acts 8:39-40) Remember the Word says some say they belong to the Lord but have no power? That's because they don't have Me. They aren't baptized in the Spirit.

Remember the five foolish virgins? They didn't have Me. They didn't carry Me.

The foolish ones took their lamps but did not take any oil with them. The wise, however, took oil in jars along with their lamps. (Matthew 25:3-4)

I am the mark that seals you for eternity.

Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession. (Ephesians 1:13-14)

There is a friend that sticks closer than a brother - I am that Friend.

There is a friend who sticks closer than a brother. (Proverbs 18:24)

I have seven spirits in Me or seven divisions.

Before the throne, seven lamps were blazing. These are the seven spirits of God. (Revelation 4:5)

The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him - the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. (Isaiah 11:2)

I wrote the Bible. I spoke through the prophets. I led, and the writers and prophets followed Me, just like I do with you.

Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. (2 Peter 1:20-21)

I am the "inspiration", the "visions," the "dreams," the "guidance" that they who carry Me follow.

I am the One speaking to you now.

I am your best Friend.

I am the One you draw near to when you "draw near to God."

Come near to God and he will come near to you. (James 4:8)

I spoke through the donkey.

Then the Lord opened the donkey's mouth, and she said to Balaam, "What have I done to you to make you beat me these three times?" (Numbers 22:28)

I can do anything Father wants Me to do.

I and the Father are One. The Father is in Me and I am in the Father. I and the Son are One also in the same way. We are three in one.

AND I LIVE IN YOU!

When I touched my toe and it didn't cause me pain, He said:

I am the Fixer.

I am Jesus in you. I am God in you.

I am the Living Word. I am alive and active and sharper than any two-edged sword.

For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any doubleedged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. (Hebrews 4:12)

I am the Sword of the Spirit, the Word of God.

We are three in One, the Trinity God.

Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Matthew 28:19)

This morning when I read the next portion of scripture (John 14:15-31) at breakfast with Beth, it was about the Holy Spirit. I knew immediately when I started reading it that the Lord had timed this perfectly to be read just after He had instructed me regarding who the Holy Spirit was during the night.

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth. (John 14:16)

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. (John 14:26)

THINK ABOUT SUCH THINGS

Beth mentioned something positive to counter a negative this morning and we discussed Pollyanna and positive thinking. I said I liked Pollyanna and the positive thinking she stood for. Then the scripture came to my mind, and I mentioned it, from Philippians 4:8, that tells us to "think about such things." When I mentioned it I received the thought that that was what I was to study today.

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble [honorable], whatever is right [just], whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable [gracious] - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things. (Philippians 4:8)

So I felt I wanted to search for scriptures on these things we are to think about, and meditate on (and pray) these scriptures today.

TRUE

Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. (John 17:3)

The angel said to me, "These words are trustworthy and true." (Revelation 22:6)

NOBLE [HONORABLE]

But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop. (Luke 8:15)

In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. (2 Timothy 2:20)

RIGHT [JUST]

Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. (Romans 12:17)

And as for you, brothers, never tire of doing what is right. (2 Thessalonians 3:13)

PURE

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. (Matthew 5:8)

Who may stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart (Psalm 24:3-4)

LOVELY

How lovely is your dwelling place, O Lord Almighty! (Psalm 84:1)

He is altogether lovely. This is my lover, this is my friend. (Song of Solomon 5:16)

ADMIRABLE [GRACIOUS]

Yet the Lord longs to be gracious to you, he rises to show you compassion. (Isaiah 30:18)

Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer everyone. (Colossians 4:6)

EXCELLENT

O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Thy name in all the earth. (Psalm 8:1)

Let them praise the name of the Lord: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven. (Psalm 148:13)

PRAISEWORTHY

For great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; he is to be feared above all gods. (1 Chronicles 16:25)

Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel. (Philippians 1:27)

DOASIHAVEDONE

After that he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him. (John 13:8)

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. (John 13:14-15)

If you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. (1 Peter 2:20-21)

Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did. (1 John 2:6)

So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you, for this sums up the Law and the Prophets. (Matthew 7:12)

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 2:5)

Lord, make my attitude the same as that of Christ Jesus. Change me, Lord, so that I become more and more like You.

I will, Joan, as you come to Me each day like you have today, and seek Me and seek My face, and seek to think like Me. Keep seeking Me and I will keep changing you to be like Me. I know this is what you want, and this is also what I want.

And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. (2 Corinthians 3:18)

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. (Romans 8:29)

HE CREATED US FOR GOOD WORKS

There are certain people (you may call them intercessors) who like the quiet. You know why? Because they want to hear Me all the time. They want to walk in My presence moment by moment, day by day. And you are one of those people. And your friend S. A. was one of those people. You will meet her again in heaven when you get there.

And then there are other people who are joyful and happy and want to be stimulated all the time by music and TV and radio, so they can continue in that joyful state. They also belong to Me but are different than My intercessors. That was what M. J. was. She and S. A. were very different in that way, and it caused friction between them at times, even though they were friends.

And then there is you. You are My intercessor and like peace and quiet most of the time. It's like a hunger inside you to have it quiet and to listen to Me. I put that in you - on purpose - so you would follow the path I've taken you on of listening and writing. I created you to fulfill that purpose.

Remember how My Word says I created you "for good works" which I prepared beforehand for you to do? That is the "good work" I created you to do. And you are not satisfied unless you are fulfilling that.

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (Ephesians 2:10)

This is My word to you today: follow Me and you will fulfill the desires of your heart.

Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart. (Psalm 37:4)

I really like to read Psalm 37. Here some of my favorite parts.

Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun.

Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him. Those who hope in the Lord will inherit the land. The meek will inherit the land and enjoy great peace.

The days of the blameless are known to the Lord, and their inheritance will endure forever. In times of disaster they will not wither; in days of famine they will enjoy plenty.

If the Lord delights in a man's way, he makes his steps firm; though he stumble, he will not fall, for the Lord upholds him with his hand.

(From Psalm 37:3-7, 9-11, 18-19, 23-24)

Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:25, 32-33)

I said not to be anxious about them. What I speak is the truth and you know that.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. (Proverb s 3:5-6)

I wanted you to come to this place/this moment of realization that I have made the promise to you to be that person you are seeking to take care of you.

I MAKE THAT COMMITMENT. Will you accept it?

*I am capable of fulfilling that commitment. I am the ONLY ONE capable of doing it. Do you want that?* 

Then it is yours. I have already made it to you, but you have to receive the gift and then it will be yours.

No human can be all this to you. But I can. And I promise to.

You belong to Me. and I am THE FAITHFUL ONE. I never lie. I have all resources. I am everything you need.

He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. For when I am weak, then I am strong. (2 Corinthians 12:7-10)

"I tell you the truth," Jesus said to them, "no one who has left home or wife or brothers or parents or children for the sake of the kingdom of God will fail to receive many times as much in this age and, in the age to come, eternal life." (Luke 18:29-30)

In him was life, and that life was the light of men. (John 1:4)

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:14-16)

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him. (John 3:36)

Whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life. (John 4:14)

I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. (John 5:24-26)

A time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out - those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. (John 5:28-29)

You diligently study the Scriptures because you think that by them you possess eternal life. These are the Scriptures that testify about me, yet you refuse to come to me to have life. (John 5:39-40) Do not work for the food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. (John 6:27)

For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world. (John 6:33)

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life." (John 6:35)

For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:40)

I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life. (John 6:47)

I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. (John 6:51)

Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:53-54)

The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life. (John 6:63)

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. (John 10:10)

I give them eternal life and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25-26)

The man who loves his life will lose it, while the man who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. (John 12:25)

For I did not speak of my own accord, but the Father who sent me commanded me what to say and how to say it. I know that his command leads to eternal life. (John 12:49-50)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him. (John 17:2)

Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. (John 17:3)

These are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. (John 20:31)

That's what I wanted you to read today - about eternal life and how you receive it. I am the life and I give it to those who believe in Me.

Let these words sink in to your soul. Let them become part of you. Let My words become life in you as you read and believe them.

I come to give life to all who will receive it through Me. There is no other way to have real life, the life that is eternal, except through Me. I am the Way to life. I am the Truth about life. I AM LIFE.

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved. (Acts 4:12)

But while Joseph was there in the prison, the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden. (Genesis 39:21)

He gave Joseph wisdom and enabled him to gain the goodwill of Pharaoh king of Egypt; so he made him ruler over Egypt and all his palace. (Acts 7:10 NIV)

And God gave him favor before Pharaoh king of Egypt. (Acts 7:10 NLT)

#### MOSES

Moses said to the Lord, "You have said, 'I know you by name and you have found favor with me'" (Exodus 33:12)

And the Lord said to Moses, "I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name." (Exodus 33:17)

O Lord, if I have found favor in your eyes, then let the Lord go with us. (Exodus 34:9)

#### DANIEL

Now God had caused the official to show favor and sympathy to Daniel. (Daniel 1:9)

As soon as you began to pray, an answer was given, which I have come to tell you, for you are highly esteemed. (Daniel 9:23)

Daniel, you who are highly esteemed, consider carefully the words I am about to speak to you. (Daniel 10:11 NIV)

This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands. This is love for God: to obey his commands. (1 John 5: 1-3) This scripture tells me that we know that we love the children of God by loving God and carrying out His commands.

And it also says that we love God by carrying out His commands.

So here are the answers to my questions:

How do we know that we <u>love God</u>?

#### This is love for God: to obey his commands

How do we know that we <u>love others</u>?

# We know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands

That brings to my mind a scripture I memorized many years ago from John 15:10...

#### If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. (John 15:10)

So loving God and obeying His commands enables us to remain in His love.

And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. (2 John 6)

If a person does not have life then he has death. Those who have life go to heaven when they die from earth. Those who do not have life go to hell, the place of the dead.

Psalm 7:10 My defense and shield depend on God, who saves the upright in heart.

Isaiah 40:10 See, the sovereign Lord comes with power, and his arm rules for him.

#### I rule with My righteous right arm.

Psalm 147:5 Great is our Lord and mighty in power.

Psalm 66:7 He rules forever by his power.

I rule forever by My power. There is no time that I do not rule.

Matthew 28:18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority (power) in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

ALL authority, Joan, not just partial authority. There is no place or situation where I do not have authority. I have ALL authority in heaven and on earth. Authority equals power.

## NOT DEAD, BUT ASLEEP

When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's son may be glorified through it." (John 11:4)

After he had said this, he went on to tell them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I am going there to wake him up." (John 11:11)

So then he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead, and for your sake I am glad I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him." (John 11:14)

Jesus called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" the dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face." (John 11:43-44)

What did Jesus mean when he said someone was not dead but asleep? Is there a state of "seeming dead" to people on earth, but not really dead, but in some in-between stage?

A ruler came and knelt before him and said, "My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live." Jesus got up and went with him and so did his disciples. (Matthew 9:18-19)

When Jesus entered the ruler's house and saw the flute players and the noisy crowd, he said, "Go away. The girl is not dead but asleep." But they laughed at him. After the crowd had been put outside, he went in and took the girl by the hand, and she got up. (Matthew 9:23-25)

Here are the stories of two people who are current-day examples:

- 1. Don Piper (from his book *Ninety Minutes in* Heaven) died and was pronounced dead by paramedics at the scene of a car accident. Then a man prayed for him, and he returned to life after 90 minutes of being dead.
- 2. Bob Jones was ill and died and went to heaven. He met the Lord and was asked to return to earth. At first he did not want to return when the Lord asked him about that. But the Lord talked to him, and he agreed to come back to earth to help bring about the salvation of a billion souls. He returned and lived for many years after that.

This is the revelation I got about the words "Not dead but asleep."

This refers to anyone who dies who belongs to Christ. They are "not dead" because they are alive in Christ. They are not dead spiritually. They will be resurrected eventually as they are alive in Christ.

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me <u>will live, even though he dies;</u> and whoever lives and believes in me <u>will never die</u>." (John 11:24)

#### **Revelation 20:4**

I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Jesus and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his image and had not received his mark on their foreheads or their hands.

I find it very interesting that God will put His name on the forehead of His servants, and Satan will put his "mark" (666) on the forehead or hand of those who follow him.

God gives his mark to those who choose Him. But Satan forces his mark upon people.

You see, he always tries to copy Me. He wants to be Me, but he can't. So he tries to copy Me.

#### Revelation 13:16-18

He also forced everyone, small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on his right hand or on his forehead, so that no one could buy or sell unless he had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of his name.

This calls for wisdom. If anyone has insight, let him calculate the number of the beast, for it is man's number. His number is 666.

#### FAMINES AND EARTHQUAKES

There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. (Matthew 24:7)

#### PERSECUTION

Then you will be handed over to be persecuted and put to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of me. (Matthew 24:9)

#### TURNING AWAY FROM THE FAITH

At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other. (Matthew 24:10)

#### FALSE PROPHETS

Many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. (Matthew 24:10)

#### INCREASE OF WICKEDNESS

Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold. (Matthew 24:12)

GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM PREACHED IN THE WHOLE WORLD

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)

#### SCOFFERS

First of all, you must understand that in the last days scoffers will come, scoffing and following their own evil desires. They will say, "Where is this 'coming' he promised? Ever since our fathers died, everything goes on as it has since the beginning of creation." (2 Peter 3:3-4)

#### APOSTASY

When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth? (Luke 18:8)

#### INCREASE IN KNOWLEDGE AND TRAVEL

But you, Daniel, keep this prophecy a secret; seal up the book until the time of the end, when many will rush here and there, and knowledge will increase. (Daniel 12:4)

#### MANY PURIFIED, MANY WICKED

Many will be purified, made spotless and refined, but the wicked will continue to be wicked. None of the wicked will understand, but those who are wise will understand. (Daniel 12:10)

# THE LORD IS GOD OF THE LIVING, NOT THE DEAD

Now about the dead rising - have you not read in the book of Moses, in the account of the bush, how God said to him, 'I am the God of

# Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? He is not the God of the dead, but of the living. (Mark 12:26-27 NIV)

Wow! This really hits me today. This scripture. The Lord is NOT the God of the dead.

#### Look that up in other translations and see what they say.

But now, as to whether the dead will be raised - haven't you ever read about this in the writings of Moses, in the story of the burning bush? Long after Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob had died, God said to Moses, 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' So he is the God of the living, not the dead. (Mark 12:26-27 NLT)

And as for the dead being raised, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the passage about the bush, how God said to him, 'I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? He is not God of the dead, but of the living. (Mark 12:27 RSV)

God was telling Moses that these men, though dead for hundreds of years, were still very much alive, for he would not have said, 'I am the God' of those who don't exist! (Mark 12:26-27 TLB)

And regarding the dead, whether or not they are raised, don't you ever read the Bible? How God at the bush said to Moses, 'I am - not *was* - the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? The living God is God of the living, not the dead. (Mark 12:26-27 THE MESSAGE BIBLE)

But concerning the dead being raised - have you not read in the book of Moses, in the passage about the burning bush, how God said to him, I am the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob? He is not the God of the dead, but of the living! (Mark 12:26-27 AMP)

What does that really mean, Lord, that You are NOT the God of the dead?

It means that I am not responsible for them and what happens to them. THEY are responsible. They chose to live life without Me. They chose to be independent of Me, even though they could know Me through what I created and how I created it. So they are on their own. They are the masters of their own destinies. And what do I do with those who are worthless to Me? As I mention in John 15 -

He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit. (John 15:2)

If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. (John 15:7)

# PEACE TO THIS HOUSE

Charles Stanley on TV mentioned this scripture and how he now prays for the peace of the house he is about to enter.

When you enter a house, first say, "Peace to this house." If a man of peace is there, your peace will rest on him; if not, it will return to you. (Luke 10:5-6 NIV)

Study this scripture in several Bible translations. See how it translates about your peace being on the house or returning.

Whenever you enter someone's home, first say, "May God's peace be on this house." If those who live there are peaceful, the blessing will stand; if they are not, the blessing will return to you. (Luke 10:5-6 NLT)

Whatever house you enter, first say, "Peace be to this house!" And if a son of peace is there, your peace shall rest upon him; but if not, it shall return to you. (Luke 10:5-6 RSV)

And into whatsoever house ye enter, first say, "Peace be to this house." And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it; if not, it shall turn to you again. (Luke 10:5-6 KJV)

When you enter a home, greet the family, "Peace." If your greeting is received, then it's a good place to stay. But if it's not received, take it back and get out. Don't impose yourself. (Luke 10:5-6 THE MESSAGE)

Whenever you enter a home, give it your blessing. If it is worthy of the blessing, the blessing will stand; if not, the blessing will return to you. (Luke 10:5-6 TLB)

Whatever house you enter, first say, "Peace be to this household!" [Freedom from all the distresses that result from sin be with this family]. And if anyone [worthy] of peace and blessedness is there, the peace and blessedness you wish shall come upon them; but if not, it shall come back to you. (Luke 10:5-6 AMP)

A person of peace will receive it and it will stay on and with him. If there is no person of peace in that house the blessing will not rest on anyone there...because there IS NO PEACE for the wicked.

"There is no peace," says the Lord, "for the wicked." (Isaiah 48:22)

Therefore, peace is only for those who are not wicked, and those are the people who belong to Me.

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. (John 14:27)

Since you don't know for sure if anyone of peace is in that home, you may pray a blessing of peace on the house - and leave it up to Me to place it on a person of peace or return it back to you.

It's not something you FEEL, it's something you KNOW.

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. (Colossians 3:15)

God has called us to live in peace. (1 Corinthians 7:15)

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests. (Luke 2:14)

Seek peace and pursue it. (Psalm 34:14)

(Deuteronomy 30:19-20) LIFE is a path which the Lord makes known to us.

#### You have made known to me the path of life. (Psalm 16:11)

LIFE is found in the words of the Lord.

My son, pay attention to what I say, turn your ear to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to one's whole body. (Proverbs 4:20-22)

LIFE is found by the one who pursues righteousness and love.

He who pursues righteousness and love finds life, prosperity and honor. (Proverbs 21:21)

LIFE - comes through humility and the fear of the Lord.

Humility and the fear of the Lord bring wealth and honor and life. (Proverbs 22:4)

LIFE was in Jesus Christ and it was the light of men.

#### In him was life, and that life was the light of men. John 1:4)

LIFE was what God gave to those who believed in His only Son.

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

LIFE is given to those who drink the water Jesus gives them.

Whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life. (John 4:14)

LIFE is in the Father and in His Son, Jesus. It is for those who hear His word and believe in Him.

I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live. For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself. (John 5:24-26)

LIFE - Jesus is the bread of life.

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)

LIFE - Jesus has the words of eternal life.

Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." (John 6:68)

LIFE - is given by Jesus.

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

LIFE - Jesus is the Life. It is for those who believe in Him.

Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. (John 20:30-31)

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him. (John 3:36)

LIFE - is given to all who are appointed for it and believe.

When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed. (Acts 13:48)

LIFE is a gift of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:22-23)

LIFE - is given by the Spirit.

He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life. (2 Corinthians 3:6)

LIFE - His divine power has given us everything we need for life.

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. (2 Peter 1:3)

LIFE - the names of those who have life are written in the Book of Life.

All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world. (Revelation 13:8)

Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it...And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. (Revelation 20:11-12)

Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life. (Revelation 21:27)

As the Father has loved me; so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I

# have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. (John 15:9-11)

Remain in My love. If you obey My commands you will remain in My love. I have told you this so that My joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. Do you see this, My daughter?
