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SHARING WITH OTHERS ABOUT GOD AND JESUS


From Bill Hybels' book *Just Walk Across The Room* page 135-145 illustrations:

THE BRIDGE

The Bridge--God loved you so much that he asked his Son to serve as a bridge to span the chasm that separated you from him.

Draw 4 pictures:

- 1. Us and God separated by a chasm
- 2. Write death due to sin in the chasm in between us
- 3. Christ came to earth to be our bridge (put cross between us and God, cross out death)
- 4. Draw arrow from us to God with cross in between



The Bible says that each one of us will face death. It's inevitable. But as Christ-followers know, death is just the stepping-over into eternal union with God, if we so choose. (John 3:16) When the appropriate time comes, I'm convinced you're going to grab that friend...and begin inching your way through the explanation of the great chasm that exists between people and God...the access, called grace, is available to anyone who will accept it and walk across God's bridge. The choice is theirs.

DO VERSUS DONE

Do versus Done--You don't have to earn your way into God's favor; the work that Christ accomplished on the cross declared payment for your sin "done."

Write: DO/DONE

I tell people who are on the Earning-Grace Plan that "religion" is spelled D-O. At the end of the day, it's all about whether you *do* enough right things to earn God's favor. To get in God's good graces, the thinking goes, you have to *do* this and *do* that and strive and sacrifice and clean up your act and make all sorts of promises.

"But *Christianity*, on the other hand," I say to people, "is spelled D-O-N-E. the Bible says that what Christ did on the cross is *enough*. He did what you could never do--he uniquely satisfied God's requirement for a perfect sacrifice to take care of our past, present, and future sin--and if you receive what he accomplished, then not only will you be 'in God's good graces,' but your life will be made brand new. Because of what Christ did on the cross, your sins can be forgiven and you can find favor in God's eyes right here, right now."

THE MORALITY LADDER

The Morality Ladder--Despite how good you are, you are far from perfect. The only way to make up your "morality gap," the gap between your standard of living and God's perfect and holy standard, is by relying on the person of Christ.

The "Morality Ladder" illustration expresses the universal need for God...envision morality as escalating rungs on a ladder. God sits at the top of the ladder because he is holy--he's *perfectly* moral...really evil people are at the bottom. The rest of humanity is somewhere in between...I ask them to put a mark somewhere on the ladder that represents where they believe they are, based on what kind of morals they keep.

I put in Mother Teresa and Billy Graham and myself.

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Believe in the power of the gospel, friends. And then commit yourself to learning a few illustrations so that you can tell God's story with passion. The stakes are too high to neglect your role in communicating God's lifegiving story to a dying world.

Remind the person he can take his time. This is a huge decision. I'm available to help you sort it all out.

#1 Bridge the Chasm

Find people where they live Relate to them as they are Walk by their side toward the Father.

#2 Ask the Question

Ask a simple question to test the waters and see if he is willing to keep talking...rely on the answer to tell how quickly or slowly to move in the conversation.

Possible questions:

- Why do you think there are so many religions in the world?
- Do you think it's possible for anyone to really know if there is a God?
- What do you think are the most common misconceptions people have about God?
- Do you think there's really such a thing as "unconditional love"?
- How has your belief or disbelief in God affected your life?
- Do you believe God is actively involved in our world?
- Is there such a thing as destiny?
- What do you hope is true about God?

#3 Practice Patience

#4 Beware of rabbit trails

Ask God supernaturally to reveal the needs of people in your life, and then find a way to tell them with confidence that there is a God in heaven who created them, who loves them, who has already gone before them, and who will be their everlasting Peacemaker if they so choose.

I asked the Lord: "What <u>are</u> You doing in the world right now, Lord?"

He answered:

- I'm preparing the earth for the tribulation to soon come. That's why I had you read all those books about it recently to remind you.
- I'm preparing My people to soon be raptured and to take the Restrainer out of the way so the tribulation events can come about.
- I'm sending My people all over the world to share My good news mostly via TV and the internet, just before the Rapture.
- I'm getting you and your daughters and son-in-law ready to "Come up here" (Revelation 4:1) and giving you the experiences you need while still on earth.
- Since the Rapture takes all of Mine in one moment, that means some will have their full years to grow (like you) and some will only have a little/few. But that's ok. I know all about it. It's part of My plan.

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A DREAM ABOUT SHEETS OF STICKERS OVER MY SHOES

In my dream I had sheets of stickers which I had over my pairs of shoes...a sheet for each pair. These sheets were about $8\ 1/2\ x\ 11$ or about $6\ x\ 11$. The sheets were each different bright metallic colors. I would grasp each sheet with tongs when I picked them up. I was in the process of picking up each sheet and putting them in a file folder to keep them protected and in good shape.

Shoes can mean words, Gospel, covenant, preparation, and/or peace. A shoe usually indicates how one's path is traveled. This dream indicates I had many pairs of shoes, so that could mean I have traveled in many different ways in my lifetime.

The sheets of stickers covering my shoes/words/path traveled may indicate there has been a covering over me during all that time, even though it varied in color and size. Metallic stickers mean something pretty and eye catching to me. The dream shows me picking all these up very carefully and storing them in a file folder for protection and preservation. Perhaps that could refer to my writings (words) which I am carefully storing for others to use after I'm not here.

TEST QUESTIONS FOR THE JUDGMENT SEAT OF CHRIST

(Quote from book by Mark Hitchcock called 55 Answers to Questions About Life After Death)

From chapter 29 "Are There Rewards in Heaven?" p. 148

The preparation for the judgment seat

The Bible tells us that the great test day for our lives as God's children is coming. But like a kind, gracious teacher, God has given us the "test questions" for the judgment seat of Christ beforehand. It's our job to study these test questions so we can be prepared, and make an "A" on the final exam. Here is a list of some of the main areas in our lives that will be tested when we stand before the Lord:

1. How we treat other believers (Hebrews 6:10; Matthew 10:41-42)

Hebrews 6:10

For God is not unjust. He will not forget how hard you have worked for him and how you have shown your love to him by caring for other believers, as you still do.

Matthew 10:41-42

If you receive a prophet as one who speaks for God, you will be given the same reward as a prophet. And if you receive righteous people because of their righteousness, you will be given a reward like theirs. And if you give even a cup of cold water to one of the least of my followers, you will surely be rewarded."

2. How we employ our God-given talents and abilities (Matthew 25:14-29; Luke 19:11-26; 1 Corinthians 12:4; 2 Timothy 1:6; 1 Peter 4:10)

Matthew 25:14-29

"Again, the Kingdom of Heaven can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. He called together his servants and entrusted his money to them while he was gone. He gave five bags of silver to one, two bags of silver to another, and one bag of silver to the last—dividing it in proportion to their abilities. He then left on his trip.

"The servant who received the five bags of silver began to invest the money and earned five more. The servant with two bags of silver also went to work and earned two more. But the servant who received the one bag of silver dug a hole in the ground and hid the master's money.

"After a long time their master returned from his trip and called them to give an account of how they had used his money. The servant to whom he had entrusted the five bags of silver came forward with five more and said, 'Master, you gave me five bags of silver to invest, and I have earned five more.'

"The master was full of praise. 'Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let's celebrate together!'

"The servant who had received the two bags of silver came forward and said, 'Master, you gave me two bags of silver to invest, and I have earned two more.'

"The master said, 'Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let's celebrate together!'

"Then the servant with the one bag of silver came and said, 'Master, I knew you were a harsh man, harvesting crops you didn't plant and gathering crops you didn't cultivate. I was afraid I would lose your money, so I hid it in the earth. Look, here is your money back.'

"But the master replied, 'You wicked and lazy servant! If you knew I harvested crops I didn't plant and gathered crops I didn't cultivate, why didn't you deposit my money in the bank? At least I could have gotten some interest on it.'

"Then he ordered, 'Take the money from this servant, and give it to the one with the ten bags of silver. To those who use well what they are given, even more will be given, and they will have an abundance. But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away.

Luke 19:11-26

The crowd was listening to everything Jesus said. And because he was nearing Jerusalem, he told them a story to correct the impression that the Kingdom of God would begin right away. He said, "A nobleman was called away to a distant empire to be crowned king and then return. Before he left, he called together ten of his servants and divided among them ten pounds of silver, saying, 'Invest this for me while I am gone.' But his people hated him and sent a delegation after him to say, 'We do not want him to be our king.'

"After he was crowned king, he returned and called in the servants to whom he had given the money. He wanted to find out what their profits were. The first servant reported, 'Master, I invested your money and made ten times the original amount!'

"Well done!' the king exclaimed. 'You are a good servant. You have been faithful with the little I entrusted to you, so you will be governor of ten cities as your reward.'

"The next servant reported, 'Master, I invested your money and made five times the original amount.'

"'Well done!' the king said. 'You will be governor over five cities.'

"But the third servant brought back only the original amount of money and said, 'Master, I hid your money and kept it safe. I was afraid because you are a hard man to deal with, taking what isn't yours and harvesting crops you didn't plant.'

"'You wicked servant!' the king roared. 'Your own words condemn you. If you knew that I'm a hard man who takes what isn't mine and harvests crops I didn't plant, why didn't you deposit my money in the bank? At least I could have gotten some interest on it.'

"Then, turning to the others standing nearby, the king ordered, 'Take the money from this servant, and give it to the one who has ten pounds.'

"But, master,' they said, 'he already has ten pounds!"

"'Yes,' the king replied, 'and to those who use well what they are given, even more will be given. But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away.

1 Corinthians 12:4

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all.

2 Timothy 1:6

This is why I remind you to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you when I laid my hands on you.

1 Peter 4:10

God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another.

3. How we use our money (Matthew 6:1-4; 1 Timothy 6:17-19)

Matthew 6:1-4

"Watch out! Don't do your good deeds publicly, to be admired by others, for you will lose the reward from your Father in heaven. When you give to someone in need, don't do as the hypocrites do—blowing trumpets in the synagogues and streets to call attention to their acts of charity! I tell you the truth, they have received all the reward they will ever get. But when you give to someone in need, don't let your left hand know what your right hand is doing. Give your gifts in private, and your Father, who sees everything, will reward you.

1 Timothy 6:17-19

Teach those who are rich in this world not to be proud and not to trust in their money, which is so unreliable. Their trust should be in God, who richly gives us all we need for our enjoyment. Tell them to use their money to do good. They should be rich in good works and generous to those in need, always being ready to share with others. By doing this they will be storing up their treasure as a good foundation for the future so that they may experience true life.

4. How well we accept mistreatment and injustice (Matthew 5:11-12; Mark 10:29-30; Luke 6:27-28, 35; Romans 8:18; 2 Corinthians 4:17; 1 Peter 4:12-13)

Matthew 5:11-12

"God blesses you when people mock you and persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you because you are my followers. Be happy about it! Be very glad! For a great reward awaits you in heaven. And remember, the ancient prophets were persecuted in the same way.

Mark 10:29-30

"Yes," Jesus replied, "and I assure you that everyone who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or property, for my sake and for the Good News, will receive now in return a hundred times as many houses, brothers, sisters, mothers, children, and property—along with persecution. And in the world to come that person will have eternal life.

Luke 6:27-28, 35

"But to you who are willing to listen, I say, love your enemies! Do good to those who hate you. Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you.

Romans 8:18

Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later.

2 Corinthians 4:17

For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!

1 Peter 4:12-13

Dear friends, don't be surprised at the fiery trials you are going through, as if something strange were happening to you. Instead, be very glad—for these trials make you partners with Christ in his suffering, so that you will have the wonderful joy of seeing his glory when it is revealed to all the world.

5. How we endure suffering and trials (James 1:12; Revelation 2:10)

James 1:12

God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

Revelation 2:10

Don't be afraid of what you are about to suffer. The devil will throw some of you into prison to test you. You will suffer for ten days. But if you remain faithful even when facing death, I will give you the crown of life.

6. How we spend our time (Psalm 90:9-12; Ephesians 5:16; Colossians 4:5; 1 Peter 1:17)

Psalm 90:9-12

We live our lives beneath your wrath, ending our years with a groan. Seventy years are given to us! Some even live to eighty. But even the best years are filled with pain and trouble; soon they disappear, and we fly away. Who can comprehend the power of your anger? Your wrath is as awesome as the fear you deserve. Teach us to realize the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom.

Ephesians 5:16

Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days.

Colossians 4:5

Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity.

1 Peter 1:17

And remember that the heavenly Father to whom you pray has no favorites. He will judge or reward you according to what you do. So you must live in reverent fear of him during your time as "foreigners in the land."

7. How we run the particular race God has given us (1 Corinthians 9:24; Philippians 2:16; 3:13-14; Hebrews 12:1)

1 Corinthians 9:24

Don't you realize that in a race everyone runs, but only one person gets the prize? So run to win!

Philippians 2:16

Hold firmly to the word of life; then, on the day of Christ's return, I will be proud that I did not run the race in vain and that my work was not useless.

Philippians 3:13-14

No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.

Hebrews 12:1

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us.

8. How effectively we control our fleshly appetites (1 Corinthians 9:25-27).

1 Corinthians 9:25-27

All athletes are disciplined in their training. They do it to win a prize that will fade away, but we do it for an eternal prize. So I run with purpose in every step. I am not just shadowboxing. I discipline my body like an athlete, training it to do what it should. Otherwise, I fear that after preaching to others I myself might be disqualified.

9. How many souls we witness to and win for Christ (Proverbs 11:30; Daniel 12:3; 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20)

Proverbs 11:30

The seeds of good deeds become a tree of life; a wise person wins friends.

Daniel 12:3

Those who are wise will shine as bright as the sky, and those who lead many to righteousness will shine like the stars forever.

1 Thessalonians 2:19-20

After all, what gives us hope and joy, and what will be our proud reward and crown as we stand before our Lord Jesus when he returns? It is you! Yes, you are our pride and joy.

10. How much the doctrine of the Rapture means to us (2 Timothy 4:8)

2 Timothy 4:8

And now the prize awaits me—the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return. And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to his appearing.

11. How faithful we are to God's Word and God's people (Acts 20:26-28; 2 Timothy 4:1-2; Hebrews 13:17; James 3:1; 1 Peter 5:1-2; 2 John 1:7-8)

Acts 20:26-28

I declare today that I have been faithful. If anyone suffers eternal death, it's not my fault, for I didn't shrink from declaring all that God wants you to know. "So guard yourselves and God's people. Feed and shepherd God's flock—his church, purchased with his own blood over which the Holy Spirit has appointed you as elders.

2 Timothy 4:1-2

I solemnly urge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he appears to set up his Kingdom: Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching.

Hebrews 13:17

Obey your spiritual leaders, and do what they say. Their work is to watch over your souls, and they are accountable to God. Give them reason to do this with joy and not with sorrow. That would certainly not be for your benefit.

James 3:1

Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly.

1 Peter 5:1-2

And now, a word to you who are elders in the churches. I, too, am an elder and a witness to the sufferings of Christ. And I, too, will share in his glory when he is revealed to the whole world. As a fellow elder, I appeal to you: Care for the flock that God has entrusted to you. Watch over it willingly, not grudgingly—not for what you will get out of it, but because you are eager to serve God.

2 John 1:7-8

I say this because many deceivers have gone out into the world. They deny that Jesus Christ came in a real body. Such a person is a deceiver and an antichrist. Watch out that you do not lose what we have worked so hard to achieve. Be diligent so that you receive your full reward.

12. How hospitable we are to strangers (Matthew 25:35-36; Luke 14:13-14)

Matthew 25:35-36

For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.'

Luke 14:12-14

Then he turned to his host. "When you put on a luncheon or a banquet," he said, "don't invite your friends, brothers, relatives, and rich neighbors. For they will invite you back, and that will be your only reward. Instead, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind. Then at the resurrection of the righteous, God will reward you for inviting those who could not repay you."

13. How faithful we are in our vocation (Colossians 3:22-24)

Colossians 3:22-24

Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything you do. Try to please them all the time, not just when they are watching you. Serve them sincerely because of your reverent fear of the Lord. Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

14. How we use our tongue (Matthew 12:36; James 3:1-12)

Matthew 12:36

And I tell you this, you must give an account on judgment day for every idle word you speak.

James 3:1-12

Dear brothers and sisters, not many of you should become teachers in the church, for we who teach will be judged more strictly. Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For if we could control our tongues, we would be perfect and could also control ourselves in every other way.

We can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth. And a small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong. In the same way, the tongue is a small thing that makes grand speeches.

But a tiny spark can set a great forest on fire. And the tongue is a flame of fire. It is a whole world of wickedness, corrupting your entire body. It can set your whole life on fire, for it is set on fire by hell itself.

People can tame all kinds of animals, birds, reptiles, and fish, but no one can tame the tongue. It is restless and evil, full of deadly poison. Sometimes it praises our Lord and Father, and sometimes it curses those who have been made in the image of God. And so blessing and cursing come pouring out of the same mouth. Surely, my brothers and sisters, this is not right! Does a spring of water bubble out with both fresh water and bitter water? Does a fig tree produce olives, or a grapevine produce figs? No, and you can't draw fresh water from a salty spring.

Carefully consider this list. Read the verses. Develop and grow in these areas of your life so that when you stand before the Lord someday, you can hear those words, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21 NIV).

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THIS PLEASES GOD

B will be part of your provision for you to live. And you will be part of your provision. And someone/something else will provide the rest. I want her to help you. She is your daughter. I bless her through her blessing you. So let her. I'm not expecting you to provide for yourself in your elder years. I make families to help each other, and I bless them for doing it. It will all work out rightly in My time. I'm blessing B for keeping you here. She learns a lot from you.

A Scripture I read this morning from 1 Timothy 5:3-4

Take care of any widow who has no one else to care for her. But if she has children or grandchildren, their first responsibility is to show godliness at home and repay their parents by taking care of them. This is something that pleases God. (1 Timothy 5:3-4)

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APPROACHING GOD

(Quotes from Juanita Bynum's book *The Threshing Floor*, p 12ff)

We must be taught how to effectually approach God so that we can receive answers to our prayers.

First of all, we learn to approach God by worshiping at the Beautiful Gate. There are four colors represented here: white, blue, purple, and scarlet. (white = righteousness of Jesus, blue = Christ as Heavenly One, purple = royalty/kingship, scarlet = shedding His blood)...when you enter into prayer through the East Gate, you are acknowledging the four works of Jesus Christ as expressed in the Gospels. You cannot approach God correctly unless you go through His works!...To pass through the gate, you must accept His works as part of your life...must be thankful for what He has done.

John 10:24-27

So the Jews surrounded Him and began asking Him, How long are You going to keep us in doubt and suspense? If You are really the Christ (the Messiah), tell us so plainly and openly. Jesus answered them, I have told you so, yet you do not believe Me [you do not trust Me and rely on Me]. The very works that I do by the power of My Father and in My Father's name bear witness concerning Me [they are My credentials and evidence in support of Me]. But you do not believe and trust and rely on Me because you do not belong to My fold [you are no sheep of Mine]. The sheep that are My own hear and are listening to My voice; and I know them, and they follow Me.

You can boldly approach God's throne, but only through the pattern of the finished, perfect works of Jesus Christ. When Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life," He was marking the path to effective prayer. The *gate* is "the way"; the *holy place* (inner court) is "the truth"; and "the life" shines through God's perfected light in the *most holy place*.

You come to Me each morning when you come through the "gate" of My name, My works, and your relationship with Me. That gate stays open as you go through your day, and I fill you with truth and life from Me and through Me.

I want to put in my journal the "Proposed chronology of the end times" by Mark Hitchcock from his book *Iran: The Coming Crisis*, page 201ff

1. Events in heaven

- A. The Rapture of the Church (1 Cor. 15:51-58; 1 Thess. 4:13-18; Rev. 3:10)
- B. The Judgment seat of Christ (Rev. 14.10: 1 Cor. 3:9-15; 4:1-5; 9:24-27; 2 Cor. 5:10)
- C. The Marriage of the Lamb (2 Cor. 11:2; Rev. 19:6-8)
- D. The Singing of two special songs (Rev. 4-5)
- E. The Lamb receiving the seven-sealed scroll (Rev. 5)

2. Events on earth

- A. Seven-year tribulation
 - 1. Beginning of the tribulation
 - a. Seven-year tribulation begins when the Antichrist signs a covenant with Israel, bringing peace to Israel and Jerusalem (Dan. 9:27; Ezekiel 38:8.11)
 - b. The Jewish temple in Jerusalem is rebuilt (Dan. 9:27; Rev. 11:1)
 - c. The reunited Roman Empire emerges in a ten-leader configuration (Dan. 2:40-44; 7:7; Rev. 17:12)
 - 2. First Half (3 1/2 years) of the Tribulation
 - a. The seven seal judgments are opened (Rev.6)
 - b. The 144,000 Jewish believers begin their great evangelistic ministry (Rev.7)
 - c. Gog and his allies invade Israel and are decimated by God (Dan. 11:40-45; Ezekiel 38-39)
 - 3. The midpoint of the tribulation
 - a. Antichrist breaks his covenant with Israel and invades the land. (Dan. 9:27;11:40-41)
 - b. Antichrist begins to consolidate his empire by plundering Egypt, Sudan, and Libya, whose armies have just been destroyed by God in Israel.(Dan. 11:42-43; Eze. 38-39)
 - c. While in North Africa, Antichrist hears disturbing news of insurrection in Israel and immediately returns there to destroy and annihilate many. (Dan. 11:44)
 - d. Antichrist sets up the abomination of desolation in the rebuilt temple of Jerusalem. (Dan. 9:27; 22:45a; Matt. 24:15; 2 Thess. 2:4; Rev. 13:5, 15-18)
 - e. Sometime during these events, the Antichrist is violently killed, possibly as a result of a war or assassination. (Dan. 11:45; Rev. 13:3, 12, 14; 17:8)
 - f. Satan is cast down from heaven and begins to make war with Israel. (Rev. 12:7-13) The chief means he uses to persecute Israel is the two beasts in Revelation 13.
 - g. The faithful Jewish remnant flee to Petra in modern Jordan, where they are divinely protected for the remainder of the tribulation. (Matt. 24:16-20; Rev. 12:15-17)
 - h. The Antichrist is miraculously raised from the dead to the awestruck amazement of the entire world. (Rev. 13:3)
 - i. After his resurrection from the dead, the Antichrist gains political control over the ten kings of the reunited Roman Empire. Three of these kings will be killed by the Antichrist, and the other seven will submit. Dan. 7:24; Rev. 17:12-13)

- j. The Two Witnesses begin their three-and-a-half-year ministry. (Rev. 11:3-6)
- k. Antichrist and the ten kings destroy the religious system of Babylon and set up their religious capital in the city. (Rev. 17:16-17)
- 4. Last half (3 1/2 years) of the Tribulation
 - a. Antichrist blasphemes God and the false prophet performs great signs and wonders and promotes false worship of the Antichrist. (Rev. 13:5, 11-15)
 - b. The mark of the beast (666) is introduced and enforced by the false prophet. (Rev. 13:16-18)
 - c. Totally energized by Satan, the Antichrist dominates the world politically, religiously, and economically. (Rev. 13:4-5, 15-18)
 - d. The trumpet judgments are unleashed throughout the final half of the Tribulation. (Rev. 8-9)
 - e. Knowing he has only a short time left, Satan intensifies his relentless, merciless persecution of the Jewish people and Gentile believers on earth. (Dan. 7:25; Rev. 12:12; 13:15; 20:4)
- 5. The end of the Tribulation
 - a. The bowl judgments are poured out in rapid succession (Rev 16)
 - b. The campaign of Armageddon begins (Rev. 16:16)
 - c. Commercial Babylon is destroyed (Rev. 18)
 - d. The two witnesses are killed by Antichrist and are resurrected by God three and a half days later (Rev. 11:7-12)
 - e. Christ returns to the Mount of Olives and slays the armies gathered against Him throughout the land, from Megiddo to Petra (Rev. 19:11-16; Isaiah 34:1-6; 63:1-6)
 - f. The birds gather to feed on the carnage. (Rev. 19:17-18)

B. After the Tribulation

- 1. Interval or Transition period of seventy-five days (Daniel 12:12)
 - a. The Antichrist and false prophet are cast in the lake of fire (Rev. 19:20-21)
 - b. The abomination of desolation is removed from the temple (Daniel 12:11)

- Dreaming that you are dreaming: message, a message within a message, aspiration, vision
- Double dream: very important, usually destiny, life call, things God doesn't want you to miss

For God may speak in one way, or in another, yet man does not perceive it. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falls upon men, while slumbering on their beds, then He opens the ears of men, and seals their instruction. (Job 33:14-16)

This seems to be a revelation dream. God is revealing to me that He has a dream for me with 3 pictures in it. I am being shown as a person pondering the meaning of the dream within a dream.

All 3 pictures reveal spiritual realities because of the blue involved. In the one dream I remember, He shows me as a person who is being held by Him. The canoe also can show me as a person who can float tranquilly in the River of Life which He takes me on.

The three pictures can refer to my being conformed to and obedient to Him, the Trinity. It's a very positive dream to inform me and comfort me that the way my life is going is good, and He is leading it and in control of it - it is what He wants from my life, my "boat"...which can mean my self and/or my personal ministry.

GOD'S CHOSEN AND CALLED

Today I was reading **Proverbs 16:4** which says:

The Lord has made everything for his own purposes, even the wicked for a day of disaster.

The idea which came to me was one I had wondered about many times: Did the Lord make the wicked for a day of disaster and make His own for learning and pruning while on this earth using the wicked to help do this. I began looking up Scriptures, which might apply to this idea...

SCRIPTURES ON OBJECTS OF WRATH AND OBJECTS OF GLORY--

GOD MADE SOME FOR MERCY AND SOME FOR DESTRUCTION

Isaiah 43:1-13

But now, O Jacob, listen to the Lord who created you. O Israel, the one who formed you says, "Do not be afraid, for I have ransomed you. I have called you by name; you are mine. When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you. For I am the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.

I gave Egypt as a ransom for your freedom; I gave Ethiopia and Seba in your place. Others were given in exchange for you. I traded their lives for yours because you are precious to me. You are honored, and I love you.

"Do not be afraid, for I am with you. I will gather you and your children from east and west. I will say to the north and south, 'Bring my sons and daughters back to Israel from the distant corners of the earth. Bring all who claim me as their God, for I have made them for my glory. It was I who created them."

Bring out the people who have eyes but are blind, who have ears but are deaf. Gather the nations together! Assemble the peoples of the world! Which of their idols has ever foretold such things? Which can predict what will happen tomorrow? Where are the witnesses of such predictions? Who can verify that they spoke the truth?

"But you are my witnesses, O Israel!" says the Lord. "You are my servant. You have been chosen to know me, believe in me, and understand that I alone am God. There is no other God—there never has been, and there never will be. I, yes I, am the Lord, and there is no other Savior.

"First I predicted your rescue, then I saved you and proclaimed it to the world. No foreign god has ever done this. You are witnesses that I am the only God," says the Lord. "From eternity to eternity I am God. No one can snatch anyone out of my hand. No one can undo what I have done."

Isaiah 43:25

"I—yes, I alone—will blot out your sins for my own sake and will never think of them again.

Romans 9:22

In the same way, even though God has the right to show his anger and his power, he is very patient with those on whom his anger falls, who are destined for destruction.

Romans 11:33-36 33

Oh, how great are God's riches and wisdom and knowledge! How impossible it is for us to understand his decisions and his ways! For who can know the Lord's thoughts? Who knows enough to give him advice? And who has given him so much that he needs to pay it back? For everything comes from him and exists by his power and is intended for his glory. All glory to him forever! Amen.

Galatians 4:21-31

Tell me, you who want to live under the law, do you know what the law actually says? The Scriptures say that Abraham had two sons, one from his slave wife and one from his freeborn wife. The son of the slave wife was born in a human attempt to bring about the fulfillment of God's promise. But the son of the freeborn wife was born as God's own fulfillment of his promise.

These two women serve as an illustration of God's two covenants. The first woman, Hagar, represents Mount Sinai where people received the law that enslaved them. And now Jerusalem is just like Mount Sinai in Arabia, because she and her children live in slavery to the law.

But the other woman, Sarah, represents the heavenly Jerusalem. She is the free woman, and she is our mother. As Isaiah said, "Rejoice, O childless woman, you who have never given birth! Break into a joyful shout, you who have never been in labor! For the desolate woman now has more children than the woman who lives with her husband!"

And you, dear brothers and sisters, are children of the promise, just like Isaac. But you are now being persecuted by those who want you to keep the law, just as Ishmael, the child born by human effort, persecuted Isaac, the child born by the power of the Spirit. But what do the Scriptures say about that? "Get rid of the slave and her son, for the son of the slave woman will not share the inheritance with the free woman's son." So, dear brothers and sisters, we are not children of the slave woman; we are children of the free woman.

Matthew 13:24-30, 37-43

Here is another story Jesus told: "The Kingdom of Heaven is like a farmer who planted good seed in his field. But that night as the workers slept, his enemy came and planted weeds among the wheat, then slipped away.

When the crop began to grow and produce grain, the weeds also grew. "The farmer's workers went to him and said, 'Sir, the field where you planted that good seed is full of weeds! Where did they come from?'

"An enemy has done this!' the farmer exclaimed. "Should we pull out the weeds?' they asked. "No,' he replied, 'you'll uproot the wheat if you do. Let both grow together until the harvest. Then I will tell the harvesters to sort out the weeds, tie them into bundles, and burn them, and to put the wheat in the barn."

... Jesus replied, "The Son of Man is the farmer who plants the good seed. The field is the world, and the good seed represents the people of the Kingdom. The weeds are the people who belong to the evil one. The enemy who planted the weeds among the wheat is the devil. The harvest is the end of the world, and the harvesters are the angels.

"Just as the weeds are sorted out and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the world. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will remove from his Kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. And the angels will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in their Father's Kingdom. Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand!

Ephesians 1:3-14

All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ. Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure.

So we praise God for the glorious grace he has poured out on us who belong to his dear Son. He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins. He has showered his kindness on us, along with all wisdom and understanding.

God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own good pleasure. And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ—everything in heaven and on earth.

Furthermore, because we are united with Christ, we have received an inheritance from God, for he chose us in advance, and he makes everything work out according to his plan. God's purpose was that we Jews who were the first to trust in Christ would bring praise and glory to God.

And now you Gentiles have also heard the truth, the Good News that God saves you. And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago. The Spirit is God's guarantee that he will give us the inheritance he promised and that he has purchased us to be his own people. He did this so we would praise and glorify him.

2 Timothy 2:20-21

In a wealthy home some utensils are made of gold and silver, and some are made of wood and clay. The expensive utensils are used for special occasions, and the cheap ones are for everyday use. If you keep yourself pure, you will be a special utensil for honorable use. Your life will be clean, and you will be ready for the Master to use you for every good work.

Romans 8:28-30

And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory.

No, don't say that. Who are you, a mere human being, to argue with God? Should the thing that was created say to the one who created it, "Why have you made me like this?"

When a potter makes jars out of clay, doesn't he have a right to use the same lump of clay to make one jar for decoration and another to throw garbage into? In the same way, even though God has the right to show his anger and his power, he is very patient with those on whom his anger falls, who are destined for destruction.

He does this to make the riches of his glory shine even brighter on those to whom he shows mercy, who were prepared in advance for glory. And we are among those whom he selected, both from the Jews and from the Gentiles.

Romans 9:10-16

This son was our ancestor Isaac. When he married Rebekah, she gave birth to twins. But before they were born, before they had done anything good or bad, she received a message from God. (This message shows that God chooses people according to his own purposes; he calls people, but not according to their good or bad works.) She was told, "Your older son will serve your younger son." In the words of the Scriptures, "I loved Jacob, but I rejected Esau."

Are we saying, then, that God was unfair? Of course not! For God said to Moses, "I will show mercy to anyone I choose, and I will show compassion to anyone I choose."

So it is God who decides to show mercy. We can neither choose it nor work for it.

Romans 11:1-7

I ask, then, has God rejected his own people, the nation of Israel? Of course not! I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham and a member of the tribe of Benjamin.

No, God has not rejected his own people, whom he chose from the very beginning. Do you realize what the Scriptures say about this? Elijah the prophet complained to God about the people of Israel and said, "Lord, they have killed your prophets and torn down your altars. I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me, too."

And do you remember God's reply? He said, "No, I have 7,000 others who have never bowed down to Baal!"

It is the same today, for a few of the people of Israel have remained faithful because of God's grace—his undeserved kindness in choosing them. And since it is through God's kindness, then it is not by their good works. For in that case, God's grace would not be what it really is—free and undeserved.

So this is the situation: Most of the people of Israel have not found the favor of God they are looking for so earnestly. A few have—the ones God has chosen—but the hearts of the rest were hardened.

Romans 11:22

Notice how God is both kind and severe. He is severe toward those who disobeyed, but kind to you if you continue to trust in his kindness. But if you stop trusting, you also will be cut off.

John 6:44-45

For no one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them to me, and at the last day I will raise them up. As it is written in the Scriptures, 'They will all be taught by God.' Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me.

Acts 2:38-39

Peter replied, "Each of you must repent of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. This promise is to you, and to your children, and even to the Gentiles—all who have been called by the Lord our God."

1 Thess. 1:4

We know, dear brothers and sisters, that God loves you and has chosen you to be his own people.

2 Peter 1:10

So, dear brothers and sisters, work hard to prove that you really are among those God has called and chosen. Do these things, and you will never fall away.

Mark 13:20

In fact, unless the Lord shortens that time of calamity, not a single person will survive. But for the sake of his chosen ones he has shortened those days.

1 Cor. 1:26-28

Remember, dear brothers and sisters, that few of you were wise in the world's eyes or powerful or wealthy when God called you. Instead, God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful. God chose things despised by the world, things counted as nothing at all, and used them to bring to nothing what the world considers important.

Acts 13:48

When the Gentiles heard this, they were very glad and thanked the Lord for his message; and all who were chosen for eternal life became believers.

Today Pastor A taught us part 3 of his series on "Contending for the Prophetic". One Scripture He had us look up was Isaiah 1:2 which says:

Listen, O heavens! Pay attention, earth! This is what the Lord says..."

Pastor used that as an example of how we are to proclaim/declare to the heavens and earth what the Lord says to us - as a prophetic word He has given us.

FINDING PEACE

Today I scanned the book by Charles Stanley called *Finding Peace*. I want to put in my journal the outline of some of the things he wrote there:

Why We Lose Our Peace

(46)

There is only one way to experience an abiding peace that transcends circumstances. The answer is "by faith." By faith we ask and then trust God to be present in our lives....We have asked God to accept and forgive us and to be present in our lives with His abiding peace, and then we go out and live expecting Him to do the very thing we trust Him to do.

There are certain issues that can rob us of our peace:

- 1. Sudden fear
- 2. The enemy
- 3. Sin
- 4. Giving up peace
- 5. Losing focus (not thanking and praising, limiting God by my thoughts, dwelling on negatives)

(64) Five essential beliefs for a peaceful heart

- 1. God is absolutely sovereign (Psalm 91)
- 2. God is your provider
- 3. God made you the way you are for a purpose
- 4. God has a place where you truly belong
- 5. God has a plan for your fulfillment

(260) Overcoming fear: the nature of our fears

- 1. fear of sin's consequences
- 2. fear of danger and harm
- 3. fear of evil
- 4. fear of disobeying God

(275) Seven steps to overcoming fear

- 1. Acknowledge the fear you experience
- 2. Ask immediately for God's help
- 3. Determine the root fear
- 4. Go to God's Word
- 5. Praise the Lord
- 6. Take a positive step as part of your deliverance or healing
- 7. Make a decision that you are not going to live in fear

(297) Four keys to living in contentment

- 1. Cut the "conditional" bonds. Recognize that there is nothing you can do to make another person love you unconditionally.
- 2. Cast all your cares on the Lord
- 3. Stay in the Word
- 4. Take charge of your thinking. Maintain your focus on the Lord

Yes, it is amazing, but it's true. I am a God of love, and I set apart a people whom I love. My love encompasses everything regarding those whom I love - from healing, to forgiveness, to prosperity, to protection, to rewards in heaven and eternal life living with Me.

Hasn't God chosen the poor in this world to be rich in faith? Aren't they the ones who will inherit the Kingdom he promised to those who love him? (James 2:5 NLT)

You see, Joan, when you made the choice to be poor in this world by telling Me you didn't want a bunch of money to have to invest, handle, etc, but just enough to live on daily, you made a very important choice. You made the right choice. It pleased Me, and I have taken care of your daily needs for all the rest of your life. You are depending on Me and not on your money.

But the wisdom from above is first of all pure. Its is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no favoritism and is always sincere. And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness. (James 3:17-18 NLT)

I asked the Lord about my motives for asking Him to provide for something. He asked me a series of questions regarding it:

Are you seeking it because I want you to? (yes)

Are you pushing to get it in your own power or letting Me decide about it? (letting You decide it)

Are you willing to let it go and go somewhere else if I say so? (yes) Are you trying to steal it from someone else? (no)

Then don't worry about having wrong motives. You are not trying to get it on your own power and ways, but purely by My power and ways. You do not have wrong motives.

So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come close to God, and God will come close to you....humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor. (James 4:7-8, 10 NLT)

Dear brothers and sisters, be patient as you wait for the Lord's return. Consider the farmers who patiently wait for the rains in the fall and in the spring. They eagerly look for the valuable harvest to ripen. You, too, must be patient. Take courage, for the coming of the Lord is near. (James 5:7-8 NLT)

Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord. Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well. And if you have committed any sins, you will be forgiven. Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results. (James 5:14-16 NLT)

CO-LABORERS

Today I have been reading from David Jeremiah's book called *Prayer Matrix*. I want to quote here a very meaningful section pages 49-52

THE MYSTERY OF THE MATRIX

So it is that God has made certain things dependent upon prayer, things that will never be done unless we pray. Could God do whatever He chooses without our prayer? Of course. But God has determined that He will use the prayers of His people to accomplish His purposes of salvation and redemption on this earth, and His purpose of bringing glory to His name for all eternity.

When Jesus tells us in Matthew 7 to ask and to seek and to knock, it wasn't the first time in the Sermon on the Mount that He'd spoken about prayer. Earlier (in Matthew 6:5-8) He taught us not to pray publicly to impress others and not to pray with "vain repetitions" of words to impress God (He doesn't want mere language from us; He wants real communication). Jesus then went on to give us an outline for prayer's content (Matthew 6:9-13), an outline we commonly call the Lord's Prayer. And in that outline we see more of the mystery of the prayer matrix:

The God who has made it perfectly clear in the pages of the Bible that He's in control of every detail in this universe, and who promises that He will reign as King for all eternity, still asks us to pray, "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10).

The God who has lovingly promised throughout Scripture to be our faithful Father and Provider still asks us to daily pray, "Give us this day our daily bread" (6:11).

The God who has given us the priceless gift of forgiveness through the death of His Son still asks us to pray, "And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors" (6:12).

The God who is our Good Shepherd, who promises to lead us in paths of righteousness, who has pledged to protect us from Satan's power and to not let us be tempted beyond what we can bear, still asks us to pray, "And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one" (6:13).

And so in obedience to His commands and to the spiritual laws of this universe, we pray. And as we pray, the kingdom and the power and the glory are indeed His forever!

YOUR BEST WORK

"Prayer is everything," Oswald Chambers wrote. Whatever's happening in this world for God, prayer is always at the critical center.

Andrew Murray seemed to understand this about as well as anybody, as evidenced in *With Christ in the School of Prayer*. He declared this about prayer: "The powers of the eternal world have been placed at its disposal." He describes prayer as "the very essence of true religion, the channel of all blessings, the secret of power and life." Murray looked at the commands and promises Jesus gave us about prayer in Matthew 7:7-8 and called them "the fixed eternal law of the kingdom." And he added, "Though in its beginnings prayer is so simple that the feeblest child can pray, yet it is at the same time the highest and holiest work to which man can rise."

Prayer is the greatest and best thing for God you'll ever do. "Prayer does not fit us for the greater works," writes Oswald Chambers; "prayer *is* the greater work." Murray speaks of prayer as "the highest part of the work entrusted to us, the root and strength of all other work."

You can commit your life to a ministry of prayer, and thereby touch the world. You can go to Africa, to China, to India, to Russia, to the Middle East, to South America--anywhere, by going to the throne of God in prayer for those men and women who serve the kingdom's work out among all of those places. You can literally affect what is going on throughout this world by praying. But you've got to pray.

Listen again to Andrew Murray: "Christ has opened the school of prayer specially to train intercessors for the great work of bringing down, by their faith, and prayer, the blessings of His work and love on the world around."

It ought to take away our breath to realize that our almighty God invites us to have such a huge part in the work of bringing in His kingdom for all eternity.

You see, My purpose is not just to do things. I could do those on My own. My purpose is to build a relationship with My people, a co-laboring relationship, a fellowship of fellow workers. So My greater purpose - to build this relationship - would not be accomplished if I just did all "things" by Myself.

I want to know you, and want you to know Me. I want to relate with you and communicate with you, and I want you to do that with Me also. So we work on things together to accomplish much more than accomplishing those things. I created you to have fellowship with you and I will accomplish My purpose.

So you see, your work here at B's house of communicating with Me every day is the greater work I have for you. As KB told you last Sunday: "Embrace the season of life you are in right now." That is because it is your greater work that I have been training you for.

I made you like you are, quiet and introverted and able to hear Me, so you could do this greater work. Now I want you to recognize the importance of it and do it every day...not

just for your usual prayer bundle, but for all things I guide you to pray for. Are you willing? (Yes) Then we will continue the training and practice of prayer together - as a team...as co-laborers.

THE DYNAMIC OF FAITH

(Quotes from book *How To Be Good Without Really Trying* by Mike Flynn)

(33) God has decided that He and you collaborate through the primary dynamic of faith. And while He has decided that you take action on what He says as an act of your will, He does not speak to your will when He is talking. Rather, He talks to your spirit. From there you must translate His words to your mind and your emotions. Your will must assess what He has said while taking input from your mind and emotions, and then finally you decide to take action or inaction.

The difficulty comes in the strength with which He speaks. God's *modus operandi* for us is stated in Hebrews: "Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him" (Hebrews 11:6). What that means is that you do not get to be sure of what He is saying prior to the need to take action on what He has said. You operate

either in faith or certainty but not both at the same time. If you are positive about something, you do not need faith, do you? Faith is needed when it is possible and even probable that God is saying to do something, but you are not sure about it.

If God spoke so loudly that there was no doubt about something, faith would not be necessary. But He wants us to have faith. Faith is the coin of His realm. It is what frees Him to work. This is not mechanical—He is not a vending machine--but personal. Faith is being persuaded that He wants you to do something, but persuasion is not certainty.

So God's problem is how to speak loudly enough that we hear but not so loudly that we have no doubt. Do not ask me why He works this way. I do not particularly like it, but I am resigned that it is the way that God's business goes. I am never completely at ease when I am hearing and obeying Him. But this forces me into a greater dependence on Him, and I have found that dependence on Him is always profitable.

(55) God has designed things so that the *how* is lived before it is understood. In fact, it is the living that allows the understanding to occur. You *do* it, and that enables you to *understand* it; but even then, the doing exceeds the understanding. How do you do it? You act--in thought and attitude and action--as if the thing were true. You act as if the sinful you died when Jesus died and the obedient you was raised when He was raised. You act as if the Spirit will back up your no to the flesh and keep you from behaving in accord with its wishes. You act as if you are following Jesus the Pure, Jesus the Mature.

You act as if He is in you and you are in Him. You act as if He knows how to live His own life in you. You act as if He is who He says He is and you are who He says you are.

"Well, isn't that just an act?" you might exclaim. Sure it is. But do not let your opinion of "just an act" sabotage the biblical view that *acting as if* is exactly what faith is. Jesus provides the clue in John 7:17: "If anyone chooses to do God's will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own." In other words, doing precedes comprehending. This is not acting as if something false were true. It is releasing the truth into actuality by taking steps that prove its truthfulness.

(56) As I seek to contain and give forth the Lord Jesus, somehow He mobilizes the best of me-in-Him and sends both of us forth from me for others. It is the most amazing free-flow collaboration. As I try to give Him forth, He likes sounding like me. It is not that I diminish in the act of giving forth Jesus. Rather, it is that He enlarges me or intensifies what it is to be me and gladly wears me--my body, my personality, my vocabulary--as I seek to relate with others in Him. I cannot die to self fast enough to stay dead, for He is too quick in the raising of me. He likes me alive!

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever, as the Book says (Hebrews 13:8). But He is infinitely unique and modulated as He expresses Himself in each of us, for we all are different. He likes sounding like me and He likes sounding like you *when* each of us is seeking to contain and give Him forth to others. This is not only great fun. It is what is called maturity.

I awoke during the night with words of part of a song in my mind. I felt they might be a message from the Lord, so I wrote them in the dark to remind me of them this morning. These were the words:

The Holy Spirit said it was not my job to judge her. It's my job to love her and share the truth with her.

(Matthew 7:12-27 NLT)

NEAR DEATH EXPERIENCES

I have been reading a number of books lately regarding near death experiences and what happened to people during the time they "died" and the time they were resuscitated. So many, if not all, of the illustrations were positive, good experiences. I wondered why the authors weren't telling about the experiences that were bad. Then I read this quote from Betty Malz' book *Heaven*, pg. 82:

I spent some time with Dr. Maurice Rawlings, a heart specialist and author of *Beyond Death's Door*. He told me that of the patients whose death he witnessed, eighty percent had a horrible experience and only twenty percent had a peaceful experience. The Bible says that "strait is the gate, narrow the way that leads to life, and few there be that find it."

He also said that while people described hellish experiences immediately upon returning to life, they later seemed to forget them or put them out of their minds. Dr. Rawlings said, "The evil God of this world, Satan, has blinded their eyes so they cannot remember and warn others."

But some have had their lives changed by the experience and have warned us. Dr. George Ritchie has written of the desolation he felt at being asked: "What did you do with your life?" The deeds he had thought to be so important seemed minuscule under the scrutiny of that question.

He saw miserable people writhing in agony trying to make up to their living loved ones for hurts they had caused, particularly from suicide. He saw people chained to the consequences of their behaviors, for all eternity powerless to satisfy themselves. He saw people fighting, gouging each other, but never dying, howling with despair.

Then in the distance he saw a light - Jesus, the light of the world. He returned to life and had a second chance to tell others about Jesus.

Goal: to live for, look for, move in, and anticipate continually the move of the Holy Spirit in my spirit, so that I might communicate the life of the Spirit to those with whom I come in contact daily.

A DREAM ABOUT FINDING THE STAIRWAY BETWEEN THE UPPER AND LOWER PARTS OF A CAMPUS

I was thinking about calling my Mom and telling her where and when to come and pick me up.

- Stairway: steps as in a process-sometimes including the concept of time, promotion, ambition, procedure, transition, higher levels/lower levels, ability to move to different spiritual levels, possibly a portal
- College campus: place of learning and testing and advancing in knowledge
- Lower level: possibly learning here on earth
- Upper level: possibly learning in spiritual/heavenly realm
- Mom: source, church, spiritual or natural mother

This dream was so exciting to review because it showed I had finally found the way to transition from one level (the earthly, familiar, lower level) to the other level (higher, spiritual, heavenly, not very familiar). I had been learning in previous dreams in the upper level of campus, but then couldn't find the way back to the lower, more familiar level of campus. This dream can refer to a portal for transition back and forth. The part about calling Mom and having her come and pick me up may refer to having my Source, God, come and get me to bring me to heaven at some point in time and place.

Confess these as sins to Me and repent - turn and do the opposite - faith instead of fear, belief instead of unbelief, confidence instead of doubt.

In quietness and confidence is your strength: faith, belief, confidence.

"FLATLINERS" WHO WERE MEDICALLY RETRIEVED FROM ACTUAL CLINICAL DEATH

Today I want to quote some things written in the book *To Hell and Back* by Dr. Maurice Rawlings (a specialist in cardiovascular diseases):

(pp. 10-11)

Americans have already reported near-death experiences, the majority strangely visualizing a veritable glimpse of glory. The typical description involves a beautiful light at the end of a very dark tunnel. Many Christians were convinced that the figure of light they encountered was Jesus because they saw him on a cross, the exuberant experience forever changing their lives. Some others perceived a possible heaven conforming to their own particular faith. Remarkably, others saw the same tunnel and the apparent light turn into a horrible ring of fire, the light becoming inexplicably evil, convincing them that they had been to hell and back...

Of the numerous authors investigating near-death experiences, almost none of them report negative or unpleasant cases. Instead, they insist that all cases are positive and glorious, thus promoting the confident assumption that heaven's gates are open wide for everyone who dies regardless of religion or belief.

The resulting conclusions of these authors seem clear. No longer do these investigators consider death as oblivion or the end of it all. And none of them seem to believe in a place called hell. Because they see only the "good" experiences for the next life--that all near-death experiences report a common glimpse of glory--the birth of a new religion and philosophy has emerged. Some of them call it the "Omega Point," since near-death observations in their experiences indicate that heaven is a free ride for everyone who dies, and this becomes the glorious counseling now given at the bedside of many dying patients...

The purpose of this book is simply to expose the negative cases, those secreted, embarrassing cases found primarily during resuscitative procedures, during the heat of the battle for survival, the time when nothing is concealed...

If negative cases can be readily demonstrated, cases disturbing enough to permanently change lives, then a place like hell would seem reasonable. And if hell is possible, then it may not be safe to die. And if it may not be safe to die, then we better look further into the negative reports of those who found glimpses other than glory beyond death's door before we make our own decisions.

To accomplish this, we shall travel through the familiar "out-of-the-body experiences" (OBEs) and beyond the numerous "near-death experiences" (NDEs), examining those cases where extreme circumstances may literally have scared the hell out of the individual involved, without the loss of consciousness or heartbeat at all. We will focus primarily upon "flatliners" who were medically

retrieved from actual clinical death and describe the glimpses they experienced after prolonged periods of absent heartbeat, absent breathing, and absent vital functions. These are the cases that report more than a glimpse--usually a full sequence of analytical events--many of them occurring in very unpleasant environments.

(pp. 35-37)

The whole thing occurred late one day in 1977 when the other doctors had left Diagnostic Center to finish rounds elsewhere. Pam Charlesworth was finishing an EKG on a patient with chest pain.

"It's normal," she said.

I shook my head. "Hook him up again and this time exercise him enough to reproduce the pain. A smoldering heart attack could still be there."

The treadmill rumbled to life, moving Charlie McKaig, a forty-eight-year-old mail carrier from LaFayette, Georgia, at a progressively rapid rate. Pain reappeared along with sweating and breathlessness. An unusual humming noise from the monitor caused us to look up to see an unexpected run of ventricular tachycardia (rapid, dangerous heartbeat). This was followed by a very long pause in the beat and then followed by slow, widened beats and then by a flatline.

Surprisingly, Charlie continued to talk for a while, unaware that his heart had stopped. Four or five seconds later, he looked suddenly dumbfounded. It was as if he were about to ask a question. Then his eyes rolled up in his head and he fell...

With Charlie's head sharply extended, chin toward the ceiling, one of the nurses breathed "the kiss of life." Another nurse started the IV for medicines. By then an underlying block in the heartbeat had appeared on the monitor. That means the heart was not conducting the beat properly and a temporary pacemaker would be needed for the heart to respond to the CPR.

Using a large-bore needle, I entered the big vein under the collar bone, then threaded the pacemaker wire in the right side of the heart and attached the wire to a pulse-generator box to initiate every beat, not missing a stroke.

...Whenever I stopped pushing on his chest in order to adjust the pacemaker, the heart would stop, and Charlie's eyes would roll up, he again would sputter, turn blue, and begin to convulse.

With bare hands...I would reach over and start him up again. But this time he was screaming the words, "Don't stop! I'm in hell! I'm in hell!"

Hallucinations, I thought. Most victims say, "Take your big hands off me, you're breaking my ribs." But he was saying the opposite: "For God's sake, don't stop! Don't you understand? Every time you let go I'm back in hell!"

When he asked me to pray for him, I felt downright insulted. In fact, I told him to shut up. I said I was a doctor, not a minister and not a psychiatrist. But the nurses gave me that expectant look. What would you do? That's when I composed a make-believe prayer.

I made him repeat the make-believe prayer word for word to keep him off my back. ... "Say it! Jesus Christ is the Son of God, go on and say it!" I said. "Keep me out of hell, and if I live, I'm on the hook. I'm yours. Go on, say it!"

And then a very strange thing happened that changed our lives. A religious conversion experience took place. I had never witnessed one before. He was no longer the wild-eyed, screaming, combative lunatic who had been fighting me for his life. He was relaxed and calm and cooperative. It frightened me. I was shaken by the events. Not only had that make-believe prayer blown out the soul of Charlie McKaig, but it backfired and got me too. It was a conviction I cannot express even to this day.

Since then, Charlie has outlived three permanent pacemakers, and it has been difficult to believe that this miserable prayer of mine had opened the road to my own salvation. A spiritual bonus for

the simpleminded. The lesson? Don't say make-believe prayers. They can work. And they can dissect your soul like a surgeon's scalpel.

And that's what stimulated me to search for the mysteriously missing hell cases.

And that presented another problem. Why did the hell cases never question where they were or why they were sent there? And why did the heavenly cases, on the other hand, wonder if their experiences were bona fide? The quest for answers would prove to be my holy grail--to question those who were about to shake hands with death and those who had been beyond death's door.

A DREAM OF MY BICYCLE'S PEDALS FALLING OFF IN A WHEAT FIELD

I was riding a bicycle in a city area like maybe a campus. I knew I had a library book that I needed to return to the library before I left town to return home that day. So I was trying to find my way to the library to see where to return the book. It seemed like I started out in a car, but later it seemed to be a bicycle I was on. I came to a 5-way intersection and took the street which I thought was the right one to the library. After a bit I saw the building that I thought was correct, and I stopped along the street near it. I asked someone and was told that I could try that building and someone inside might be able to direct me to the right place.

So I turned around and started back home and needed to again drive through the 5-way intersection. I took the road that I thought was the correct way back to the campus where I had been staying awhile.

Shortly, though, the road turned to a field of stubble, like a wheat field after the wheat was cut down. The road disappeared and there was just stubble.

I slowed down and turned around to go back to the city to try to find the correct way back home. There were two people behind me in their vehicle...I don't know whether it was a bicycle also or a car

As I turned, my pedals came loose and fell off, only the pedals seemed to be one large pedal about 18" long. I could see the parts and picked them up. I called out to the two people behind me to stop and help me. I thought I needed a screwdriver to replace screws that had come out, but they said they didn't have any screwdriver. I didn't either. I was standing there with the pieces of this large pedal in my hands when the dream ended.

- Bicycle: works. Level of ministry/work doing today, personal ministry, requires human effort
- Road: (dead end) a point at which you must review the way you are going or what you are doing and make the necessary changes in direction
- Street or Highway: way, the Christian faith, truth, way of life
- Library: knowledge, education, learning, research

- Field: world, God's work, harvest, opportunity, mixed multitude
- Pedals: (not in book) that used to make the vehicle move
- 5-way intersection: decision or change
- 5: grace, redemption, serve, works, service

The bicycle represents personal ministry which goes along slowly and is using knowledge. Now there is a change coming, a different road to travel, which goes into the wheat harvest. You are standing in that field with a computer keyboard in your hands which needs to be put back together again. To get to that new road/pathway you must go through a change of direction through a grace and service intersection. It's not a dead-end road but a new and unknown way to go and you need help to travel there.

I am your Help. I know the way to go and you don't. It is at the end of your "camp" or retreat time at B's house where you read lots of library books. That time is changing, although it will be a slow change and take some effort of your part. It is continuing in your personal ministry, but going an unknown, different way than before.

I'm not saying you're doing something wrong or going the wrong way. I'm saying, in this dream, that a change in direction is coming, It's by My grace, and it involves your personal service and ministry. It will be "into" the harvested field. It will involve a changing of your computer usage - to work in the future happenings instead of the past events of your life.

No, you can't make your vehicle move in this next event in the harvest. You are entirely dependent on Me to move you in this harvest field. You will keep working in it until the harvest is done (as in your dream picture of stubble). Only stubble will be left after the harvest and it will be burned up with the fire of My wrath. I'm not saying you personally will be present on earth during the whole harvest, but your influence will be (through your writings).

Today is the day of change, the day to start down the new and unknown road into the harvest of the wheat. I will fix the computer keyboard (pedal) so you can maneuver where I want you to go and do the writing I want you to do during this new road trip. It is a good one. Do not fear it. I will always be present with you on this trip even though you don't know the way right now. Just follow Me. I am your guide and I am your pathway, your road. Follow Me and I will get you "there."

The five refers to grace and redemption for many in this next ministry of yours. When this next road is done, then you will come back "home" to Me.

THE DEVIL'S DOOR

(From John Bevere's book: *The Devil's Door*)

(p. 9)

There is a door to our souls, a passage where our enemy can gain access. The presence of this portal goes undetected by many, but it is known widely in the realm of the spirit. This door stands ajar between light and darkness, with a history as ancient as the sons of Adam.

Under the divine law of God, our enemy is restricted to the realm of darkness. As believers, we are delivered from these powers of darkness. But if this door is opened, Satan and his cohorts are granted legal entrance. Their objective: to control areas of our lives.

Jesus called these doors "gates." His exact words were "the gates of hell" (Matt. 16:18). He also said He had won the keys which locked them tight (Rev. 1:18)

(p. 19)

It must be settled in your heart that there is nothing good outside the realm of God's will. James shows that (James 1:16-17) you can be deceived if you believe there is good outside of God's provision. No matter how good it looks, tastes or feels, no matter how rich, abundant, wise or successful it will make you, if it is not from God, it will eventually lead to intense sorrow and end in death. Each and every perfect and good gift is from God. There is no other source. Embrace this truth and settle it in your heart. Don't let looks deceive you! If Eve had followed this admonition she never would have been swayed. But instead, she looked beyond the realm of God's provision to fulfill her desires.

(p. 31)

Do you think you know more than God? Of course not! But when we are disobedient, that is exactly the message we communicate to God and those around us....yet we exalt our wisdom above His when we ignore His counsel!

(p. 44)

To view God as subject to our will is backward thinking. We do not lead while God follows. No, God leads, and we follow - if we are wise (John 12:26). As we follow, He instructs us.

We have mistakenly thought that if we laid hands on the sick, independent of the Spirit's leading, God was obligated to heal and confirm our lead by following with His signs. If this were true, we should go empty the hospitals. We get discouraged when God does not follow our lead with His healing and miracles. God will heal and perform miracles, but it is as He leads and we follow.

(p. 65)

When a person walks in obedience to God, witchcraft has no power over him. Satan is confined to darkness (Jude 6), so he has no access to us when we are joined with God, in whom is no darkness at all (1 John 1:5).

(p. 70)

Now let me make this point clear: we come under bewitchment when we disobey what God has made clear to us - not when we disobey what has not been revealed to us.

(p. 80)

The rebellious see God's Word as a restraining law rather than as protection and life.

(p. 85)

This is a principle that every believer should grasp and understand. When we pester the Lord after He has already clearly shown His will, He may step back and allow us to have our way even though it does not correspond with His original plan. When our hearts are set on a course of action, God will grant us permission, though He knows we will later answer for the course we choose.

(p. 111)

In the Scriptures we find *believe* means not only to acknowledge the existence of Jesus but also to obey His will and His Word. Hebrews 5:9 says Jesus became "the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him." To believe is to obey.

(p. 196-200)

The final thought I'd like to leave with you is in regard to this door. We can choose one of four responses when sin comes knocking.

- 1. Blatant disobedience
- 2. Reasoning yourself into disobedience
- 3. Obedience with a bad attitude
- 4. Obedience with a willing heart

If they obey and serve Him [God], they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures (Job 36:11).

The prosperity and pleasures enjoyed by God's obedient children are for the present and yet endure and expand into eternity. They cannot be taken away by man since they have been given by God.

God also promised as we fulfilled our obedience by casting down all reasoning and thoughts which exalt themselves against our obedience to God, we would be equipped and ready to punish all disobedience (2 Cor. 10:3-6). In other words, our authority against the enemy would increase. Glory to God!

It is my hope and prayer that you now have developed an appetite for obeying God. You will be disappointed by all but His perfect will. In conclusion I would like to pray with you and agree to see Jesus glorified in your life and family.

Father, in the name of Jesus, thank You for Your truth and word revealed in this book. I embrace Your wisdom and welcome it into my heart. Let me not only understand but also empower me to live this life You've called me to. Under Your grace I humble myself and acknowledge Jesus Christ as more than just my Savior but as my Lord and Master. Give me Your grace to live an obedient life. By this grace may I love, fear and serve You more perfectly. May Your will alone stand in my life and not my own or the will of any other. Keep me strong that I may be found blameless when I stand before You. Glorify Your name in my life, family and church. Thank You, Lord, for Your faithfulness. Amen.

INTERCESSORS

(Quotes from *Prayer Shield* by C. Peter Wagner)

Crisis intercession: (p. 54) A crisis intercessor prays almost exclusively on assignment, and the assignment comes from the Father. They do not respond well to random requests for prayer from individual people, and most of them would be bored to tears with a prayer list. They like to go into their prayer time with worship and praise, draw near to the Father, and hear directly from Him what they are to pray for. Some assignments are short term, some long term. Once God tells them to pray through a crisis situation they will hang on to it like a bulldog until it is resolved or until God "releases" them from the assignment.

Prophetic Intercession: (p. 168) All true intercessors hear from God on a regular basis and most from time to time will move into prophetic intercession. For some, prophetic intercession is an ongoing ministry under their gift of intercession.

Cindy Jacobs defines prophetic intercession as "an urging to pray given by the Holy Spirit for situations or circumstances about which you have very little knowledge in the natural. You pray for the prayer requests that are on the heart of God."

Quiet people: (p. 169) Although there are several notable exceptions to this, the great majority of intercessors are quiet people. They do not like to be up front. They do not desire their names to be widely known.

Colleen Townsend Evans says that "aloneness" is one of the prices intercessors regularly pay. She says that as an intercessor you should be prepared to spend some very quiet alone hours. Other people will not always know or even understand what an intercessor is praying about. She says God will seal our lips so that we are not to boast or talk about what we are doing.

Needing a tune-up: (p. 173) Alice Smith says: "I am in the midst of a very difficult time of dryness before the Lord. This is not uncommon to experience because intercessors have to have a spiritual 'tune up' every once in awhile to see if they are praying for the benefits, or really praying and enjoying the Lord because of who He is." Here again is the heart of a true intercessor who has no greater desire than a close relationship with God. She says: "Especially after a very high spiritual experience such as I encountered in Israel, there is often the tendency to press into the Lord for a 'bigger high,' while He is more interested in the quiet, still fellowship of knowing His presence....These times always spark a fresh gratitude for when I do hear Him speak once again."

Rewards: (p 176) We need to understand that intercessors do feel they are amply rewarded for their ministry. I believe their greatest reward awaits them in heaven. If believers in heaven are in concentric circles around God's throne, the intercessors will be in the middle, right behind the 24 elders and the 4 living creatures.

In the here and now, a substantial reward for intercessors is to watch their prayers birth the purposes of God in the lives and ministries of the pastors for whom they are praying. Experienced intercessors see many things happening in their churches that even the pastors have no idea they are praying through. It is a true thrill for the intercessors.

But the consistent testimony I get from intercessors is that by far their greatest reward is their close relationship with the Father. More than most Christians ever do, they experience the fullness of the love of God day in and day out.

A RENDEZVOUS DURING THE NIGHT

(3:45 a.m.) The Lord began speaking to me when I awoke during the night, so I began writing:

You look at your purpose, your goal, And how to get there –

And you call forth those goals from Me.

You send out My spiritual forces to carry out those goals.

It's a shift,

It's a shift,

It's a shift,

From demonic forces being in charge,

To My forces being in charge.

That's the shift that's taken place.

Now My forces are ready to be commanded

And I am their Commander, the Commander of the Lord's Armies.

I command them, but you and I co-labor together to send them out.

From now on let's do this together.

First you find out My heart/purpose.

Then you speak forth verbally the words of command I give you –

the words of command we decide together.

My generals do this who are under My command.

Song in my head: "Up, up and away in my beautiful balloon."

I'm testing the Spirit speaking to me, and He says:

Jesus is Lord,

Jesus is Lord,

Jesus is Lord!

My time is Your time, Lord.

If I say I want to do something, some project, then we (you and I) will set out to do that together.

It's like I sense a project for us to accomplish – to practice how to do this together, and then watch it happen.

My peace is with you. When My peace is with you, then you/we can advance with the project – together. "Let peace be your governor/ruler." Don't set out or advance without My peace. It gives you My perfect timing. You've been practicing waiting for My peace regarding where you live for over a year now. This was to teach/train you how to wait for/follow My peace.

Now we are ready to use that training for more than your place of residence. That was just to practice on - like a drill to teach you to do something.

Song: "Up, up and away in My beautiful balloon."

From that perspective (up there) we can look down and see what's happening – then decide/set our plans on what to do about it. Then you will speak the words we choose and decide on to carry out our goal(s).

Ask B if you can use her pillow lap writer up here in your bedroom. We will consult and write – often during the night. This is just for you and Me. Don't worry about Satan/the enemy seeing the words you write. I can keep them hidden.

Ok, I'll trust You to keep them hidden, Lord.

Don't worry about your health. I'm in charge of your health.

Song: "Up, up and away in my beautiful balloon."

This will be (this time and episode) like our balloon ride – whenever we do this. I'll talk more about this at other times, but the mid-night time is so good for your undivided attention! So we will often use it.

Mid-night — "midnight" in the parable of the 10 virgins, is the time I come for the 5 virgins with oil. So one-half My virgins have oil and one-half don't have "enough." You are one of the one-half who has enough oil to hear Me and see Me come at "mid-night."

Song: "Up, up and away in My beautiful balloon."

That song appearing in your mind will be My signal, like a bell ringing, to alert you to come apart with Me for instructions. Like the book title "Come Away, My Beloved" from Song of Solomon. Look that up and write the Scripture reference here: Song of Songs 8:14.

You may go back to sleep now. It's been a good time together.

THE HIGHWAY OF HOLINESS

This is the way I want you to have your Quiet Times - with your computer Journal open and ready to write whatever I tell you, even as I speak it into your heart. You may do this from now on at B's house whenever it works out ok with her plans. It's her house, so you continually need to work around her plans and needs.

I like the way you spent time with Me this morning and talked to Me even before you got up from your bed. I like to have us (you and Me) connected just as soon as you awaken. Now read My Word...

(1 Kings 3:1) Solomon made an alliance with Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, and married one of his daughters. He brought her to live in the City of David until he could finish building his palace and the Temple of the Lord and the wall around the city.

You see the three things he did? He was building his palace (a place for him to live) and the Temple of the Lord (a place to worship Me) and the wall around the city (protection around it all). This is what I have been building in your life - a place for you to live daily with Me, a place within you to worship Me continuously, and protection around these places - My blood.

(1 Kings 3:5, 7) That night the Lord appeared to Solomon in a dream and God said, "What do you want? Ask, and I will give it to you."

"Now, O Lord my God, you have made me king instead of my father, David, but I am like a little child who doesn't know his way around...Give me an understanding heart so that I can govern your people well and know the difference between right and wrong. For who by himself is able to govern this great people of yours?"

Lord, I also am like a little child who doesn't know his way around. I don't have full understanding of what You are doing on earth, and what my part is in that, and how to relate to You and others in the way You desire me to. Please give me wisdom and an understanding heart so I may know this and please You. As Moses said to you: "Teach me Your way so that I may know You and continue to find favor with you." Is it ok for me to ask You for this?

Yes, My child, for that is what I have put in your heart to ask Me. Therefore it is what I want you to know - about Me, about the world, about My purpose and plan, and about how you fit into that. It is a good question and request. I want to give that answer to you. And I will. Seek Me and you will find Me.

And I will give you extra wisdom in your old age. And people will come to you for advice. And you will give Me the credit and glory for the wisdom that I speak through you. You will honor Me all the days of your life in this way...Because you have humbled yourself before Me and others and asked for My wisdom, not your own. And I will be pleased to honor you in this way.

(Isaiah 35:4-9) Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, and do not fear, for your God is coming to destroy your enemies. He is coming to save you."

And when he comes he will open the eyes of the blind and unplug the ears of the deaf. The lame will leap like a deer, and those who cannot speak will sing for joy! Springs will gush forth in the wilderness, and streams will water the wasteland.

The parched ground will become a pool, and springs of water will satisfy the thirsty land. Marsh grass and reeds and rushes will flourish where desert jackals once lived.

And a great road will go through that once deserted land. It will be named the Highway of Holiness. Evil-minded people will never travel on it. It will be only for those who walk in God's ways; fools will never walk there. Lions will not lurk along its course, nor any other ferocious beasts. There will be no other dangers. Only the redeemed will walk on it.

That's My purpose, Joan, to separate out My redeemed - and bring them into the place I have reserved for them. Then we can all fellowship together and love each other.

(2 Cor. 3:6) He has enabled us to be ministers of his new covenant. This is a covenant not of written laws, but of the Spirit. The old written covenant ends in death; but under the new covenant, the Spirit gives life.

That's what I'm doing, Joan, bringing My new covenant into the world to give life to all who will receive it, through My Spirit. You are part of that new covenant, and so are many others. I am gathering all of you together now even while those who don't belong to Me are separating themselves farther and farther from Me. It is becoming more and more clear who belong to Me and who don't. The justice of My decisions will be clear and able to be seen by all.

And this is also what I am doing:

(2 Cor. 3:14, 16-18) But the people's minds were hardened, and to this day whenever the old covenant is being read, the same veil covers their minds so they cannot understand the truth. And this veil can be removed only by believing in Christ.

But whenever someone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord--who is the Spirit--makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

A DREAM ABOUT PREPARING TO FEED A LITTLE BABY

I was getting ready to teach a small child how to eat with a baby spoon. I could see the spoon and the substance I would feed her. It looked like yogurt and seemed very tasty and good to eat. She had not yet learned to eat that way, so I was planning to first feed her with the spoon, and then let her try to use the spoon herself.

I was making plans to do this, so it's about my doing this in the future. I think this is a dream to encourage me about what is soon to come - feeding baby Christians their first food with a spoon and helping them learn how to feed themselves - soft tasty food like made from milk.

(Isaiah 41:10) Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.

After I read this scripture, He brought to my memory the dream regarding seeing a right hand and arm coming out toward me. I said: "So You showed me Your victorious right hand, Lord, in my dream?"

Yes, it was a prophetic dream to encourage you that your whole life would be victorious, that you would truly be an "overcomer" (Revelation 1-3) as you desired(d) to be. Count on it!

PROPHETIC MINISTRY

At a conference I went for prophetic ministry to a team with P, J, and A. They were of great encouragement to me as they said I was (1) a teacher and mentor, (2) was used prophetically in "prophetic conversations" which gave out wisdom to others in an unassuming and almost hidden

way, but was very powerful, (3) was an encourager and intercessor, and (4) was gifted for decorating houses/rooms. I will transcribe from the tape and put that in this journal. The Spirit said to me:

I want you to listen to the prophetic messages and know that every word there is true. Transcribe and read it often as a true word from Me.

Here is the transcription from the cassette tape of what the prophetic ministry team told me:

PROPHETIC MINISTRY TO ME AT MIRACLE SUMMIT CONFERENCE THROUGH P, JG, AND A

P: I just got one word, and I'm gonna go with that. I'm gonna open my mouth and say TEACHER. I hear "teacher" over you. And it's more than just teacher in a classroom. I see you as a mentor. Once again, I see you as one that people look up to, your wisdom is there, and people are just attracted. You seem unassuming, but you're God's secret weapon. You know, because words of wisdom just flow out of your mouth. And you do "conversational prophetic." You don't even know what it's called, but I'm putting a name on it, the Lord's saying. It's called "conversation prophetic." And what that is, is in your conversation I (God) just come through and I'm saying prophetic words to people to encourage, edify, build up - and you may not even know that it's coming forth, but it's coming from your innermost being, you know, it's just out of your belly shall come living water. So I see that living water being sprinkled on people as you make conversation. It seems unassuming but, girl, you are a weapon in the arsenal of God. A: I just want to affirm what she was saying, and say that, like Wow! There's something really deep within you. It might not necessarily be...it's not evident on the surface who you are. People don't necessarily know it when they look at you, but like God has done something deep within you, and that is of great value. You are that pearl of great price that He saw and that He came for, and that He's bringing beauty out of. Were you (to P) talking about a sword in her hand?

P: Well, I think I need to put that sword in her hand.

A: I do too!

P: Then I'll do it. (Then Pat prayed over me the sword of the spirit)

A: And that sword is the Word of God, and you know that. I just want to encourage you, even more than you have been, to keep using that because that is unleashing very, very powerful things in the spirit, breaking down strongholds. And also building up. TYPES OF INTERCESSION

(Quotes from C. Peter Wagner's book *Prayer Shield*)

p. 54-55

1. General Intercession

Those who have a ministry of general intercession will spend long hours praying over prayer lists, prayer guides and any number of miscellaneous prayer requests given to them.

2. Crisis Intercession

A crisis intercessor prays almost exclusively on assignment, and the assignment comes from the Father. They do not respond well to random requests for prayer from individual people, and most of them would be bored to tears with a prayer list. They like to go into their prayer time with worship and praise, draw near to the Father, and hear directly from Him what they are to pray for. Some assignments are short

term, some long term. Once God tells them to pray through a crisis situation they will hang on to it like a bulldog until it is resolved or until God "releases" them from the assignment.

3. Personal Intercession

Some intercessors receive a special calling to pray on a regular and intense basis for a specific person or persons. Usually these are pastors and other Christian leaders.

4. Warfare Intercession

Some intercessors are called especially to engage the enemy in high-level spiritual warfare.

DIFFERENT LEVELS OF INTERCESSORS

(Quotes from C. Peter Wagner's book *Prayer Shield*)

p. 122-130

I-3 intercessors

I-3 intercessors can be quite remote from the pastor or leader they pray for. Most I-3 intercession is a one-way relationship. The leader often does not know who the I-3 intercessor is or that he or she is praying for them and their ministry.

I-2 intercessors

Typical I-2 intercessors will have a regular, but somewhat casual, contact with the pastor or leader they pray for. Pastors' I-2 intercessors will see them in the pulpit every Sunday and shake hands when they go out the church door after the service. They may cross paths from time to time in other church-related events. But for many, this is about the extent of the personal contact...

A well-developed team of I-2 intercessors enjoys a two-way contact with the pastor. It is therefore essential to know who the I-2 intercessors are.

I-1 intercessors

God calls I-1 intercessors to have a special close relationship with the pastor or other leader. Sometimes this involves a close social relationship, sometimes it is a largely spiritual relationship. Most, if not all, of the I-1 intercessors I know have the spiritual gift of intercession. Through it they have developed an intimacy with the Father that allows them to hear the Father's voice and know His purposes more clearly than most.

THE THREE STEPS

(Quotes from C. Peter Wagner's book *Prayer Shield*)

p. 161-162

I recall one particular morning when I was struggling with this matter before God in prayer. I said, "Father, please give me intimacy with you like I am seeing in these intercessors. I want to be like them."

Then came one of those moments that are few and far between for me, but daily bread for true intercessors, when I clearly heard God speaking to me in response to my petition. He first told me to take my pencil and draw three steps, which I promptly did.

God then showed me that the intercessors are on the top step, and I am on the middle step. Multitudes are on the bottom step. He said that the intercessors are too high to reach down and help many who are on the bottom step. He told me that He wanted me to be one of His middle-step people who are in close touch with the intercessors, but who also will help many people move up the stairway. He said that many whom I do help from the lower step to the middle step will then move on and pass me.

I sensed that I heard God say my task was not to minister in His throne room, but to be outside the throne room helping others to come nearer. Those who are already in the throne room will be a major link in bringing me closer to God.

God assured me that I do have clear access to Him. He affirmed the priesthood of all believers. Access to Him is not the question, but the degree of intimacy is. He showed me that His family is large and that He loves all His children. His perfect desire and calling for each child is to be in the place where they will be the greatest blessing to all. Not all of His children are as yet in the place He wants them, but He seemed to assure me that I was in exactly the place where I was supposed to be, and that I was to rejoice in it rather than to fret over it.

That's where you were when you taught Discipleship Training - outside the throne room (with only occasional times in the throne room). Then, in 2000 I told you to stop Discipleship Training so you could spend your time coming closer to Me. Now you have been doing that for over 7 years, and you are much nearer to Me now than you were then.

Now is the time for you to be an intercessor before Me, in My throne room, bringing before Me those I assign you to. That's what this 7 years has been primarily about - preparing you to come into My throne room, into My Presence, and to bring your requests before Me. That is the closest you will get while on this earth. It is My best for you, Joan. Walk thankfully and steadily in your new role as intercessor before Me.

That you will be devoted to prayer, your minds alert and your hearts thankful. (Colossians 4:2)

That you will act with justice, will love mercy and will walk humbly with the Lord. (Micah 6:8)

That you will never fear bad news, keeping your hearts steadfast and trusting in the Lord in every situation. (Psalm 112:7)

CO-CREATE BY SPEAKING HIS WORD

Today the Holy Spirit/Jesus is telling me:

You see, I am doing a lot of work in the Spirit through your prayers - and you are to believe this by faith. It might take several months to be fully accomplished on earth. You are to wait (how often I said, "wait on the Lord") in great expectation.

Ezek. 22:30 You are a "stand in the gap" person, Joan. You gave yourself to Me and this is what I've chosen for you. And I'm having you practice on yourself to build your confidence and "teach you My ways."

On page 27 of Cindy Jacob's book *Possessing the Gates of the Enemy*, she said God said to her: "Cindy, I want you to lay your ministry down and learn to intercede."

Isn't that what I had you do...lay your ministry down and learn to intercede? The first step was to come closer to Me and form a greater intimacy with Me. The next step was to form prayer bundles I wanted you to bring before Me daily or weekly as I led.

Have I received a legacy from "pray-ers" in my life, Lord?

No, My child. That is why I must start you out on the beginning levels and teach/show you the way to grow as an intercessor. But I, the Holy Spirit, am your teacher, and I am a good teacher. I will show you what I want you to know and when I want you to know it. Your part is to listen to Me and obey Me/follow Me.

Cindy's call was to be a national and international intercessor, so I gave her personal teachers who prayed together with her and taught her how. My purpose for you is different, so I am teaching you Myself a little at a time - just enough so you can pray what I want prayed by you, and when I want it prayed.

PRAISE THE LORD

(Psalm 106:1-2) Praise the Lord! Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever. Who can list the glorious miracles of the Lord? Who can ever praise him enough?

I seek Your counsel for every day of my life, Lord, that I might do what is pleasing in your sight.

You are doing what is pleasing in My sight, Joan - seeking Me, praising Me, and coming near Me. Do this every day and I will see to it that you continue to please Me.

- Give them ears to hear what you say to them. (Rev. 2:7)
- Guide them into all truth (John 14:26; 16:13)
- Reveal things of Christ (John 16:14)
- Bring them to the new birth (John 3:5-6, 1 John 5:4)
- Witness. (Hebrews 10:15, 1 John 5:9)
- Teach. (John 14:26, Eph. 1:16-17)

But the word of our God will stand forever. (Isaiah 40:8)

You pray My Word onto someone and it stands forever. Even if they don't receive it, My Word stands forever and it waits with that person for him to receive it and believe it. So pray My Word onto your loved ones and prayer bundle, and it will stay with them until they die as an influence over them

INTERCESSION BY JESUS AND THE HOLY SPIRIT

Today the Lord is guiding me to learn more about prayer and deepen and extend my prayer life. He reminded me that Jesus intercedes, and the Holy Spirit intercedes. I am therefore doing a Scripture search on times when it mentions their intercession or prayers, to learn from those Scriptures and to keep that information in my prayer notebook.

Intercession of Christ

Luke 23:34 Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

Romans 8:34 Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

1 John 2:1 My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One.

Intercession Predicted

Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Intercession of the Holy Spirit

Romans 8:26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express.

Intercession to be made for all men

1Timothy 2:1-2 I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

Ephesians 6:18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.

Intercession asked for by Paul

Romans 15:30 I urge you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me.

2 Corinthians 1:11 As you help us by your prayers. Then many will give thanks on our behalf for the gracious favor granted us in answer to the prayers of many.

Col 4:3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.

1 Thess. 5:25 Brothers, pray for us.

2 Thess. 3:1 Finally, brothers, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you.

Hebrews 13:18 Pray for us. We are sure that we have a clear conscience and desire to live honorably in every way.

MY OLD LIFE IS GONE. WHAT DO I DO NOW?

(Quotes from *Heaven Is Real* by Don Piper)

(p. 82)

People talk to me and say things such as, "I seem to have crossed some kind of threshold in life. There's no turning back. My old life is gone. But I don't know what to do now. People tell me I have to move on, find a new direction, and I realize that, but I'm still mourning my old life, and right now, I just don't know what else to do."

I often respond with something like this: "Every transition begins with an ending. We have to let go of the old before we start the new. But it's not as easy as hitting a switch. It's a process, and we have to go through the darkness before we emerge on the other side. The key is to use the time well, shifting our focus so instead of looking inward, bemoaning what we've lost and trying to figure out how we can deal with it, we begin to look outward, to someone who can heal us, guide us, and give us strength for our journey. Instead of asking, 'How am I going to live without my old life?' we begin to ask, 'How am I going to live with my new life?' and in doing so, we will discover the path God is laying before us, the purpose He has for our lives."

LIFE IS ABOUT GIVING AND SHARING OF OURSELVES

(Quotes from *Heaven Is Real* by Don Piper)

(p. 159)

That strength - that desire to help - was also my weakness. I liked being a helper; I didn't like being helped. If anyone in need called or asked for me, I was there. Again I think that's typical of most of us in the helping profession....

When I protested that I didn't want them to do anything, that's when he really let me have it. "It's not your call...It's the only thing they have to offer you, and you're taking that gift away from them." I finally learned: I *allowed* others to help...I realize that if I withhold from them, I cheat them out of the opportunity to minister to me. I deprive them of the ability to prove their love by their actions.

There's a second way I grasped this truth of being open to others wanting to help....The people who met me at the gate (of heaven) were people who had influenced my life and had died. Because of them, I had lived as a Christian...I allowed those people to influence me. That means they helped me. They were all joy filled at the gate because they had impacted my life in some way.

As I have slowly learned to accept my responsibility to receive help, I'm in a stronger position to say it both ways to people. Be helpers of those in need, be recipients of their help when you're in need

Paul said in Phil 4:17

"Even when I was in Thessalonica you sent help more than once. I don't say this because I want a gift from you. Rather, I want you to receive a reward for your kindness." (Philippines 4:17)

(p. 165-6)

If we want to help, we'll find ways. And to those who, like me, didn't want people to help them, my advice comes in two words: *Let them.* Let them help you because they want to or they wouldn't have asked. Just smile and thank them and let them.

A final word here: Pride may be the problem of refusing help. Most people - including Don Piper - like to think of themselves as able to take care of their own needs and not to depend on someone else. To receive help humbles us and some of us don't like that.

Philippians 2:4 "Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others."

If I refuse to let someone help me, I'm disobeying the command of God right here: I refuse to allow them to look out for me or to help me.

I've come to the conclusion that humility is a quality God loves. The more we're aware of our needs, the more we depend on God and God uses people to minister to our needs. Life is about giving and sharing of ourselves.

The message the Holy Spirit gave me today was to "hold on" for I am still in transition. This is what Don Piper recommended to those going through transitions - to hold on and let God bring you through and teach and train you as you go. Then, at the right time, He will use you for the ministry He has for you using what you learned during the transition.

A SIGN OF HUMILITY

(Quotes from *Good to Great in God's Eyes* by Chip Ingram)

p. 44-45

I learned to pray; and I learned that the most accurate barometer of my humility and sense of dependency is not what I think about myself or what other people think about me. It's the reality of the actual praying I do.

When we ask God to intervene in our lives or in someone else's life, we're actually admitting our own weakness. We come to God because we know we can't handle whatever situation we're in. we need help with our marriage, our kids, our future, our job, our decisions, or whatever else we seek his help for. On the other hand, when we don't pray very much, we're really saying that even though the Lord created the universe, we think we can handle our problems and guide ourselves through life. It means that we are putting a lot of stock in our own intelligence and resources, quietly claiming our own sufficiency. Genuine prayer acknowledges who God is and our need for him. That's a sign of humility.

p. 90

The dream will cost us our life and appear to others as the height of folly just before God accomplishes the impossible through us. There will be a time in the process of God fulfilling his dream placed in your heart when he will take you all the way to the edge, and you must die.

Every dream passes through the cross. Every dream takes you to where you let go of everything and everyone, every agenda and expectation, and then it is only as the Lord resurrects you and your dream that you can go on.

We spend much of our time and energy trying to avoid that place. We want just enough of Jesus to make us happy, just enough to give us peace, and just enough to make things go our way to fulfill our dreams and our agenda. Meanwhile, he wants to take us to the cross, where our own selfish dreams, egos, and plans for "great accomplishments" have to die. The cross brings you to a place of total and absolute surrender of all you have and all you are. Greatness comes through building others up, by aiming for their greatness more than we aim for our own...In God's economy, someone else's gain is our gain, and someone else's loss is our loss. The best way to greatness in an economy like that is to pursue greatness - for someone else.

Good Christians live the Christian life. They love God, walk in integrity, demonstrate faithfulness to their mates, spend time in the Bible because they want to hear from God, make the effort to discover their spiritual gifts, use those gifts in their local church, give their tithes and offerings, go on mission trips, and help their kids grow up to be godly men and women. p. 190-193

Help many, train a few. You have to invest wisely...You can contribute to the lives of many, but you can't invest deeply in everyone. You have to choose....The first step is to pray..."Lord, I want to focus and invest my life in a few people, so I need to be discerning. Please guide me in this. And God, who is more interested in your becoming a great Christian than even you are, has promised to answer. (James 1:5)

Look under your own roof. Empowering great people starts with those for whom you are morally responsible...begin with those who live with you.

After praying and looking under your own roof, look for F.A.T. people: Faithful, Available, and Teachable...Faithful people are the ones who complete an assignment, who actually take care of a problem when they say they'll take care of it, and who call you later because they promised they would....He [God] looks at the heart. Those who are faithful have put themselves in a position to grow in maturity. Instead of listening to what people say, watch what they do with their responsibilities. When you see faithfulness, you see potential.

To invest your life wisely, you'll want to choose people who are available in addition to being faithful.

Look also for people who are *teachable*. A person who thinks he or she has already mastered certain aspects of life is not going to be open to instruction or even subtle suggestions. There's no point in investing in

someone who isn't aware that the investment is beneficial. People who are teachable are in position to grow and bear fruit.

You discover whether people are teachable by how they respond when confronted with hard things to hear. Do they hear constructive criticism with humility? Do they respond with character and demonstrate surrender and perseverance?...God chooses the lowly things of this world in order to shame our worldly standards (1 Cor. 1:27-29)...I encourage you to look beyond people's history and look at their heart....if they are faithful, available, and teachable, they can become who God really wants them to be.

p. 207

WAITING AND PERSEVERING

(From an article by C. Peter Wagner on Elijah List about waiting and persevering for the Lord's promises to come.)

"WAITING" from the book *Understanding Financial Prosperity*, by David Oyedepo:

"For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, 'Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you.' And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise." Hebrews 6:13-15

This is the eagle's secret. God swore to Abraham, yet he needed patience to obtain that promise. The Bible said, "after he had patiently endured" not after he had subjected himself to rigorous senseless fasting, not after he had struggled and sweated it out; but after he had patiently endured.

Abraham needed to have endured. Indeed, every man, every "eagle Christian," requires a degree of covenant patience. The covenant of prosperity is not a magic wand; it's an adventure of faith. "After he had patiently endured...." not after he had wept aloud. We are not called to weep, but to wait.

In Habakkuk 2:3, God said that every vision is for an appointed time, so though it tarries, wait for it. Did He say weep for it? Did He say run around for it? No! Wait! "Wait for it; Because it will surely come, It will not tarry."

The reason we are wasting is because we don't like to wait. In 1981, God spoke to me, saying, "The hour has come to liberate the world from all the oppressions of the devil, through the preaching of the Word of Faith."

That was a revelation for a world-wide ministry, but the mandate to go into Africa never came until 1994! Can you see the waiting period? "But at the end it shall speak." When you run with it, it will speak at the end. Very many people miss that end, so it looks as if the vision or revelation is not true.

Please understand this: quick prosperity will always end in grievous austerity, because it lacks the required foundation for lasting results.

Why Wait? Your lifting with God is for appointed times and due seasons, and He's the only One who knows when your due season has come. If you strive to lay a hold of something before you're due, you'll be doomed.

"And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart." Galatians 6:9

Don't be tired in covenant walk because there is a due season. If you're on your feet when that season comes, you will reap your harvest, but if you faint, you fall.

"If it will work, it ought to have worked by now." That's murmuring. When you murmur, you destroy your seed down, and then you will have to begin all over again. God runs a due season calendar on each one of us. When you are due, He will not deny you. But if you faint before you are due, you lose it all. It's better to wait or you waste. Abraham heard from God directly, yet he needed patience to obtain the promise. If you will not be patient, you may end up a patient in the hospital.

I caught the revelation that I cannot be poor in 1981, but that was not equal to automatic prosperity. But because I know what it takes, I never had occasion to beg, nor was I ever tempted to borrow.

"But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience." Luke 8:15

Though the seed fell on good ground, it could only bring forth fruit with patience. In a society that's ever in a hurry as we live in today, we need an understanding of God that will keep us above the system. God said, "I know you're honest, but you need patience. The day you are due, I will not deny you. Wait! Wait! The day you are due, you will see Me at work. Wait!"

God cannot deny Himself. Haven't you heard what He said in Psalm 89:34? "My covenant I will not break, Nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips."

So we can count on Him in the morning, we can count on Him in the afternoon, and we can count on Him in the night. Everyone in this covenant has a future, but that future is continually being contested by the enemy. It takes covenant intelligence to beat him hollow. Waiting without staggering--that's the secret of all high-flying Christians.

The rain and snow come down from the heavens and stay on the ground to water the earth. They cause the grain to grow, producing seed for the farmer and bread for the hungry. It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it. (Isaiah 55:10-11)

Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever. Amen.

When we pray "thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven," His angels can come into the earth and work there.

The Lord has said He would teach me "new things." I see this revelation as one of those new things. Thank You, Lord!

KEEP A CLEAR MIND IN EVERY SITUATION

I want you to know that I want you to sit in front of this computer each day that you can, and ask Me if there is anything I want to speak to you and have you write...from now on. Will you do that for Me?

I want you to read your Bible now and see what I tell you about My words.

For the time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. They will reject the truth and chase after myths. (2 Tim. 4:3-4 NLT)

You're seeing a lot of that, Joan. Know that the time is NOW that Paul talked about.

But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you. (2 Tim. 4:5 NLT)

Know that this is for you, Joan, and all My people now. Keep a clear mind in every situation. What is a clear mind? It is a mind focused/stayed on Me and My Word. When difficulties come, focus on Me and My Word - looking for what I want to tell you in that situation.

...Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he appears to set up his Kingdom...And now the prize awaits me - the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me on the day of his return. And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to his appearing. (2 Tim. 4:1, 8 NLT)

THE FIRE

(From the book by Bob Sorge: *The Fire of Delayed Answers*)

(Introduction)

Sometimes God delays the answers to our prayers in order to produce a greater maturity and fruitfulness in us.

If you are ever to mature into greater dimensions of fruitfulness in the kingdom of God, then you must commit yourself to understanding how God uses delay to refine His chosen ones.

It's a beautiful thing when we invoke this refining fire in our lives, but it's also a very serious thing. If you're willing to embrace His fire, then prepare yourself for some pain. Christ calls us to the cross because we'll never become like Him apart from pain.

God's first priority in our lives is to make us fruitful - it is not first and foremost to make us comfortable.

In His infinite grace, God personalizes some troubles with our name on them, in order to help us toward His design for our lives.

The focus of this book is to explore the reasons *why* He sometimes delays His answers.

When God begins to reveal His purposes to our searching hearts, and we begin to understand His ways, it helps to keep us from crawling off the altar. We find grace to persevere in tribulation because we understand that the present pain will produce a future harvest (see Heb. 12:10).

(pg. 13ff)

Nothing sinful can survive the fire of God's immediate presence. (13)

God is a holy fire, and He burns away impurities from our lives so that we might stand completely purified in His presence. (13)

I can't come closer to you, Joan, unless you become purer. My fiery presence would destroy you if I did. I can only come as close as your sinful nature will allow Me. Remember "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God."

Jesus is both a Refiner and an Assayer. We see Jesus functioning as Assayer when He confronted the Pharisees. He weighed and judged their hearts and then dealt with them accordingly. Jesus still does the same thing with us today. He examines our hearts, evaluates our true spiritual condition, and then brings His fire to effect a greater purity and usefulness. (14)

God's fire resides among His people...God is intensely passionate over Zion (His Church), so He has placed His fiery residence in the midst of His chosen ones. Which means if you live in Zion, you will get away with nothing. God's fire will burn in your life. [It] accomplishes three things among God's people: (1) It forces the hypocrite to a decision (Isa. 33:14); (2) It purges the sincere from sin (Isa. 6:6-7); (3) And it inflames the heart with fresh passions for the Son of God (Acts 2:3-4). The Lord will never remove this fire from Zion. We live in a furnace of holy fire. (14-15)

God intends for His fire to so envelope the local church that hypocrites will not be able to stay, and the devout will not be able to remain unchanged. (15)

When the heat is first turned up in our lives, initially we feel like the Lord has abandoned us. But as we persevere in faithfulness, we'll begin to see more and more how close Jesus has been to us all along. (15)

When Jesus visits us, His face is always preceded by His fire. He knows we won't be prepared for His face until we've been purified by His fire. (15)

The fire is His assurance that you are being drawn into a place of greater intimacy and knowledge of God!

There are two ways we receive from God. Some things are **given** to us, and some things are **bought.** Given: eternal life, Holy Spirit, peace, joy, etc. (15)

There are certain things in the Kingdom, however, that are not given; they must be bought. (Rev. 3:18) Gold refined in the fire (Rev. 3:18) = purified faith and refined character (Christlikeness) (15-16)

Notice this gold is bought. We do not earn or deserve it, but we do pay a price for it. - great personal pain. This gold is bought in the fire and is attained only as we persevere and endure through the fiery trials that God sends us...when the crisis explodes, God wants us to

- fix our focus on Him,
- find Him in the adversity, and
- discover the Spirit's pathway to renewed victory. (16)

God is the one who must give us the opportunity to have our faith tested. It is all of His initiative...He alone knows when we are ready. (16)

When the time of testing comes, you have a choice:

- You can give up
- You can go for the gold (press into the Lord more than ever)

Yes, it deals with your divorce and raising the children practically alone, it deals with your financial crisis which I directly led you into (2 times), and it deals with the physical difficulties you had between 1990 and 1997 predominantly.

Yes, God delivers us from all affliction, but sometimes He **delays** His provision in order to try us by fire. The delay itself is a fire ordained by God to produce a deep work in our hearts. God has a design for our deliverance, but He also has a purpose for the fiery delay. Make no mistake, delayed answers are a fire. When you're in crisis and have His promise of deliverance, but there's no change in sight, the heat can become very hot indeed! His purpose in the delay is to strengthen our faith, kindle our love to new depths of passion and maturity, and impart the heart and character of Christ to us - all in order to make us a more useful vessel. (18)
