# INTRODUCTION

## PERSONAL INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE LORD ON PRAYING SCRIPTURES

One morning during my Quiet Time (time set apart to spend with the Lord in Bible Study, prayer, and writing) the Holy Spirit told me that reading and decreeing/proclaiming Scripture that He had given me was like opening a portal over me so that He and I could connect there. He told me to do this every time I was under spiritual attack, discouraged, felt I was a victim, or needed encouragement. He said He would never leave me and that He would always talk to me. This is His way of strengthening me in the tough times. I am to do this each morning to start off my day. He said that doing this, and trusting and resting in Him, opened the way to allow Him to work out His plan in my life and His plan for what I am to do.

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## **THE SECRET OF PRAYING THE SCRIPTURES**

*(From the book *Secrets of the Secret Place* by Bob Sorge, pp. 80-83)*

The Bible is one massive Prayer Book. Virtually every page contains prayer prompts. As you take time to soak in His word, not only is your meditation sweet, but you find yourself spontaneously expressing your heart back to God in response to the text.

Praying God's word back to Him is powerful for several reasons:

- God's word itself "is living and powerful" (Hebrews 4:12) so when we pray with God's word on our lips, we know we are praying prayers that are living and powerful.
- When the language of our prayers is shaped by the Scriptures, we gain confidence in knowing that we are praying according to the will of God - a confidence that means "we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him" (1 John 5:15).
- As we pray God's word back to Him, the language of His word becomes the working language of our daily dialogue with Him. A powerful transformation begins in your soul when your everyday conversation starts to reflect God-language.
- We are equipped to pray according to the will of God in ways we would not have considered on our own. The word will tip us off to things we can pray, profoundly widening the breadth and diversity of our prayer life.
- Praying the Scriptures adds a dimension of creativity and surprise to our prayer life, which in turn makes prayer much more fascinating and enjoyable.

Prayer, in the true biblical sense, is the full spectrum of human expressions to God. Prayer is the all-encompassing title to describe the entire gamut of expressions we offer up to God. Therefore, prayer includes praise, thanksgiving, adoration, intercession, worship, supplication, shouts of joy, lifting of hands, bowing, honor, exaltation, intimate affection, repentance, surrender, dancing, mourning, contemplation, spiritual warfare, prophesying, etc.



# DEVOTIONALS



## 1. BLESSED IS THE MAN WHO LISTENS TO ME

Proverbs 8:33-34

**Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at my doorposts. For he who finds me finds life and obtains favor from the Lord.**

My prayer

Lord, it is my desire to listen to You each day in my Quiet Time as well as throughout the rest of the day. Thank You for this Scripture which shows me that You WANT me to come to you each day to listen, to watch, and to wait. That way I find You, and I find life, and I obtain favor from You. I praise You for showing this to me in Your precious Word.

## 2. WHAT YOU KEEP IN YOUR HEART

Proverbs 4:20-23

**My child, pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to my words. Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart, for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body. Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.**

From the book *Atonement* by Derek Prince: "Whatever you keep in your heart, in other words, will determine the course of your life. You cannot hold the wrong attitude in your heart and live right, nor can you have the right attitude in your heart and live wrong. The course of your life is determined by what fills your heart. God was saying to me, *If you will receive My Word through your ear gate, through your eye gate and admit it to your heart, it will do everything I have claimed.*"

My prayer

Dear Heavenly Father, I choose to pay attention to what You say. I choose to read Your words of life from the Bible and listen carefully to them. I also choose to listen carefully to what You speak into my mind and heart, and to write those words in my journals. Then I can review them and not lose sight of them. Penetrate Your words deep into my heart, Lord, so they will bring life and healing to me. I choose to guard my heart because it determines the course of my life.

### **3. WE HAVE TO LEARN TO FIGHT OUR OWN BATTLES**

**Judges 3:1-2, 4**

**These are the nations the Lord left to test all those Israelites who had not experienced any of the wars in Canaan (he did this only to teach warfare to the descendants of the Israelites who had not had previous battle experience)...they [the nations] were left to test the Israelites to see whether they would obey the Lord's commands, which he had given their forefathers through Moses.**

I saw through this Scripture that each generation must learn how to fight the battles needed for them to be tested. I had to learn to fight my own battles. My parents' battles were theirs, not mine. My children need to learn to fight their own battles also. We can learn from our parents' experiences and how they withstood what battles they faced, but we still have to fight our own. God doesn't seem to give any generation a 'free ride' or an easy life without battles based on what their parents did. He tests us to see if we will obey His commands. These commands are and can be passed down through our parents, but we need to be tested to see if we will obey them.

My prayer

Lord, I realize you test each of us to see whether we will obey Your commands. I pray today for the wisdom and understanding to stand firm when those tests come. I pray for Your help and guidance each day of my life. Instruct me and teach me in the way I should go. Guide me in what I read and what I listen to and watch so I will have Your commands reinforced in my life.

#### **4. WHAT GOD CALLS YOU IS WHAT YOU ARE**

**Judges 6:12**

**When the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, he said, "The Lord is with you, mighty warrior."**

*And I am with you, My child. When I call you "My child," then that is what you are - a child of the Lord God on High. What I call you is what you are. That tells you who you are and in what position you are - just as "mighty warrior" spoke to Gideon who he was (even though he didn't think he was!) and how I viewed him. You are a child of the King, a king who has everything belonging to Him and is willing to share it all with His children whom He loves.*

My prayer

Thank You, Lord, for calling me Your child, for that is what I am in Your sight - and therefore in my sight. You, God, have everything belonging to You, and You are willing to share it all with Your children whom You love. Thank You for sharing everything I need with me, and thank You for loving me and all Your children.

#### **5. SURROUNDED BY A HUGE CROWD OF WITNESSES**

**Hebrews 12:1-2**

**Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.**

My prayer

Dear Heavenly Father, Thank You for that huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith that surrounds me day by day. Thank You for all those people of faith who have gone before me and now wait in heaven for me to join them. I want to strip off any weight that might slow me down, and any sin that might trip me up. Show me anything that might do that in my life so I can confess those sins to You and be forgiven of them. I wait before You and listen to hear what You want to show me today. I will keep my eyes on You, Jesus, the author and finisher of my faith. Thank You for beginning my faith, Jesus, and I am trusting in You to finish that good work in me.

## **6. IN THE SAME WAY YOU JUDGE OTHERS, YOU WILL BE JUDGED**

**Matthew 7:1-2**

**Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.**

I am asking God: what are the standards we should use in judging others, since we will be judged by the same standards. He has been showing me that the standards we use are in our minds, and we use those to judge others. Then we also judge ourselves by those same standards and expect others to judge us by those standards also. So, in our thoughts and expectations, we ARE being judged by other people by those standards. We think they look at us the same way we look at them. In that sense we are being judged in the same way we judge others. If we don't measure up to those standards ourselves, we "feel" judged or looked down upon by others for not measuring up, even though they may not think that way at all. Still, in our own minds, we are being judged by others by those same standards of judgment.

When I asked Him what standards we should use to judge others, He said we were to look into their eyes and look at their hearts and judge by what we "see" in their hearts, as He does. We are not to judge by what kind of clothes they wear, or what kind of house they live in, or what kind of car they drive, or even if they drive a car, but by their hearts. God is the One who can give us the ability to see into people's hearts, and I am to ask Him to give me that ability.

My prayer

I asked Him for forgive me for judging by standards taught me by the world and not by His standards. I asked Him to put His mind and thoughts in me to judge/evaluate others by. Then he said:

*The gold standard, the gold standard, that is what I use to judge/evaluate who people are and where they are in their attitudes and relationships with others and Me. The gold standard is the one that is pure, very valuable, and has eternal value. That is part of what your dream was about - hearing about the gold standard and knowing that it was important to learn the value of it. You are forgiven, for judging most of your life by a standard taught to you by society which may not necessarily be My standard.*

## **7. THE RIGHTEOUS WILL FLOURISH LIKE A PALM TREE**

**Psalm 92:12-15**

**The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; planted in the house of the Lord, they will flourish in the courts of our God. They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green, proclaiming, "The Lord is upright; he is my Rock, and there is no wickedness in him.**

My prayer

Thank You, Lord, that I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. Thank You that Christ died for me and took my sins upon Himself, so that, in believing, I am forgiven of those sins and am righteous in Your sight. Thank You that, according to this Scripture, I will flourish like a palm tree, grow like a cedar of Lebanon and flourish in the courts of God. I am so glad you said I will still bear fruit in old age and stay fresh and green. I proclaim that You are upright and You are my Rock!

## **8. THE WORD OF GOD STANDS FOREVER**

**Isaiah 40:8**



**But the word of our God will stand forever.**

*You pray My Word onto someone and it stands forever. Even if they don't receive it, My Word stands forever and it waits with that person for him to receive it and believe it. So pray My Word onto your loved ones and prayer bundle, and it will stay with them until they die as an influence over them.*

My prayer

Oh, Lord, Your Word stands forever. Thank You for your precious Word. I pray Your Word upon my family today. Your Word says:

- **Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved - you and your household. (Acts 16:31)**
- **But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord. (Joshua 14:15)**
- **He who fears the Lord has a secure fortress, and for his children it will be a refuge. (Proverbs 14:26)**
- **All your sons will be taught by the Lord, and great will be your children's peace. (Isaiah 54:13)**

I pray these Scriptures over my family today in Your name, Jesus. According to Your Word my household (family) will be saved, they will serve the Lord, the fear of the Lord will be a refuge for them, they will be taught by You, Lord, and great will be their peace. I proclaim this in Your name, Jesus, and pray these Scriptures over them.

## **9. THOSE WHO SEEK ME FIND ME**

**Proverbs 8:17-21, 34**

**I love those who love me, and those who seek me find me. With me are riches and honor, enduring wealth and prosperity. My fruit is better than fine gold; what I yield surpasses choice silver. I walk in the way of righteousness, along the paths of justice, bestowing wealth on those who love me and making their treasuries full....Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my doors, waiting at my doorway.**

*You see, I am “yielding” something in you which surpasses choice silver and is better than fine gold. I am giving you My BEST gift, and it is BETTER than silver and gold. It is like silver and gold inside of you. Declare these Scriptures.*

My prayer

I declare righteousness and justice upon me and upon my finances. I declare wealth on me as I love You, Lord, and I declare You are making my treasuries full. These are natural and spiritual treasuries You are bestowing on me. Thank You, Lord!

## **10. THE LORD OPENS WHAT NO ONE CAN SHUT**

**Revelation 3:7-8**

**These are the words of him who is holy and true, who holds the key of David. What he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open. I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut.**

*I have opened what cannot be shut - your finances, your ministry, your writing, your good health. I have closed what cannot be opened - Satan cannot get to your finances any more, or to your health any more, or to your ministry, or to your writing. That is closed to him now and from now on.*

My prayer

Thank You, Lord, for this Scripture from You and for this Rhema Word from you. You have truly opened my finances, ministry, writing, and good health. You have brought good to me in each of these areas. I am so grateful that You are in charge of all of these, and of my whole life. I renew my pledge to You, Lord Jesus, and commit this day to You. Come, Holy Spirit, and guide me in Your way today. I love You, Lord!

## **11. JUDGE NOTHING BEFORE THE APPOINTED TIME**

**1 Corinthians 4:5**

**Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of men's hearts. At that time each will receive his praise from God.**

My prayer

This is an amazing Scripture, Lord! It tells me that I do not have all the facts and evidence to be able to judge or evaluate things rightly, but I need to wait until You come. You will bring to light and reveal what is hidden and will expose the motives in people's hearts. You know each of us inwardly, Lord, and what we think, and what we try to hide from others. Come, Lord Jesus, and reveal to me anything inside me that is hidden in darkness that You want me to see, understand, and confess before You. I want to be cleansed from any wrong motives in my heart so I can be clean and pure before You. Holy Spirit, You are the One who can do this in my life, so I invite You to do that today.

## **12. LIVING WITHOUT FEAR OF HARM**

**Proverbs 1:33**

**Whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm.**

My prayer

Lord, You say in this Scripture that if I listen to you I will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harm! Amazing! Fear is one thing I want to be freed from. The key is to listen to You. I choose to listen to You, Lord, every day, every hour, and every minute of my life. You are my safety. You are my strong tower. You are my refuge. Thank You for being all of these things to me, Lord, and much more.

### 13. THE FEAR OF THE LORD AND THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD

#### Proverbs 2:1-5 NLT

**My child, listen to what I say, and treasure my commands. Tune your ears to wisdom, and concentrate on understanding. Cry out for insight, and ask for understanding. Search for them as you would for silver; seek them like hidden treasures. Then you will understand what it means to fear the Lord, and you will gain knowledge of God.**

My prayer

Lord, this is a wonderful promise that You have given me in this Scripture! There are several things that are my part of this promise. They are the conditions I must meet to receive it. First I need to *be "Your child."* And I am, because I have given my life to You, Jesus. Then I must *listen* to what You say, *treasure* Your commands, *tune* my ears to wisdom, *concentrate* on understanding, *cry out* for insight, and *ask* for understanding. I am to search for and seek these like hidden treasures - which they are until You reveal them to me. I come to You today, Lord, and seek these hidden treasures. Then I will understand what it means to fear the Lord. And I know that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. This Scripture says I will gain knowledge of God. And I want to know You, God. So this is my prayer today. I come now to listen to what You say and treasure Your commands.

#### Proverbs 2:6-8

**For the Lord gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. He holds victory in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, for he guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones.**

My prayer

Thank You, Lord, for telling me in this Scripture that You guard my course and protect my way. I declare that, today, in Your name. I also thank You for the wisdom, knowledge, and understanding that comes from You as I wait before You right now. It's such a blessing to know You hold victory

in store for the upright who belong to You. I confess my sins before You right now as You reveal them to me. I want to be clean before You. I declare that my walk is blameless through the forgiveness of my sins through You, Jesus. Therefore You are also my shield.

## **15. THE LORD RESCUES THOSE WHO LOVE HIM**

**Psalm 91:14**

**"Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name."**

My prayer

Heavenly Father, thank You for this promise in Your Word...that You will rescue me because I love You, and you will protect me because I acknowledge Your name. What a wonderful promise! I do love You, Lord, and I do acknowledge Your name! Your name, Jesus, is above all other names. I praise You this morning and all the rest of this day. **Exodus 33:13-14**

**If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you. The Lord said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."**

Dear Lord, teach me Your ways. I want to know You more, and I desire to continue to find favor with you. So, if You are pleased with me, Lord, teach me Your ways. Thank You for doing this, Lord. I believe this is what You want to do. Thank You for Your presence with me, and thank You for Your rest. I rest in You, Lord, all the days of my life.

## **17. THE LORD IS MY TOWER OF SAFETY**

**Psalm 144:1-2 NLT**

**Praise the Lord, who is my rock. He trains my hands for war and gives my fingers skill for battle. He is my loving ally and my fortress, my tower of safety, my rescuer. He is my shield, and I take refuge in him.**

My prayer

I praise you, God, for You are my rock! And I need a rock to stand on today so I can stand firmly and safely. Thank You for training my hands for war and giving my fingers skill for battle. Be with me in any battle or difficulty that might come my way this day. You already know what that battle might be, since You know all things. Thank You that You already have trained me to face that. I'm so thankful that You love me and are my loving ally. That means to me that You will walk by my side and go with me throughout anything that this day holds. I declare that, according to Your Word, You are my fortress, my tower of safety and my rescuer. You are my shield also and that means You shield me from the words and looks and thoughts sent against me today. I take refuge in You, Lord! I declare, Lord, that *You are my rock!*

## **18. BATTLE FOR YOUR INHERITANCE**

**Joshua 11:25**

**So Joshua took the entire land, just as the Lord had directed Moses, and he gave it as an inheritance to Israel according to their tribal divisions. Then the land had rest from war.**

*My child, you have a battle to fight to get your inheritance too. As Joshua fought his battle under My instructions to Moses, so you must fight My battles for Me also in your time of living on this earth. You are about finished with the battle to get your inheritance from Me for you on this earth. It's health and finances - the two areas for which Satan has fought so hard against you, and tried to keep My provision from you.*

*Keep fighting day after day. By that I mean keep praying and declaring what I have promised you. My word is right and will be fulfilled, but you must fight the battle for Me. You fight it by speaking forth My Word as you were taught yesterday at church by Carol and Walter. Now speak forth My Word today about provision, the words I've given you. Don't give up the fight; the new is coming!*

My prayer

Dear Lord, just as You gave Joshua and the Israelites the inheritance You had for them in their time of living on this earth, so You also have an inheritance You want to give me in the areas of finance and health. I declare in Your name, Jesus, that You have provided the inheritance of good health for me while living on this earth. And I also declare in Your name, Jesus, that You have already provided an inheritance of abundant provision for me while living on this earth. Thy kingdom come and Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven - right now in my life. Thank You, Lord, for the provision and the rest You give me.

## **19. MEDITATE ON THE BOOK OF THE LAW**

**Joshua 1:8**

**This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.**

What does it mean to meditate in God's word? It means to slow way down the reading pace, and to contemplate every word and phrase, looking for deeper and fuller meanings. We uncover various layers of rich understanding as we go deeper and deeper. Meditation is the art of digging out the

most that we can from each and every word. The written word of God is revealed by the Living Word, through the power of the Holy Spirit. (Bob Sorge, *Secrets of the Secret Place* page 72)

## **20. ALL SCRIPTURE IS INSPIRED BY GOD**

### **2 Timothy 3:16-17 NLT**

**All Scripture is inspired by God, and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.**

My prayer

Dear Lord, I believe that all Scripture is inspired by You. So when I read the Scripture, I am reading what You had someone write for us to learn from. Guide me, Lord, to learn from Your Word what is true. I want to learn the truth and You, Jesus, are the Truth. Show me from the Scripture what is wrong in my life as I read it. Correct me when I am wrong and teach me to do what is right. Prepare me, Lord, and equip me to do every good work You have for me to do. Thank You for Your Word.

## **21. GIVE AND IT WILL BE GIVEN UNTO YOU**



## **Luke 6:38**

**Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.**

What I "give" can refer to money, but it also can refer to thoughts and attitudes I "give" towards others. The Lord is teaching me that we are taught by society and our families what is ok and what is not ok. We are taught what is good and acceptable according to them. This includes what looks good in clothes, hairdos, makeup, houses, cleanliness, styles, colors, etc. We are taught that things that are outside this "acceptable" box, are not as good. But the real truth about what is good and not good comes to us from Your Word, Lord.

My prayer

Lord, I believe Your Word for today that as I give it will be given to me. You tell me that with the measure I use, it will be measured to me. Lead me today, Lord, in what You want me to give to others - money, time, caring, loving, help, teaching, etc.

## **22. LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF**

**Matthew 22:39 NIV**

**Love your neighbor as yourself.**

**Matthew 7:12 NIV**

**So in everything, do to others what you would have them do to you.**

My prayer

Today the Lord led me to ask Him to give me His love for the people in the small group I belong to. It is in preparation to participate in the Agape Reformation. He reminded me that I am to do unto others as I want them to do unto me. Also I am to love my neighbor as myself. And I can expect to be judged in the same way I judge others. So I am asking for His love to fill me for others so I can love them as myself. I know I really care about myself, so I want to really care about others too. But I surely don't have that within me as part of my human nature. It has to be something given to me supernaturally by the Lord. I cannot confer it upon myself or grow it myself. But I can ask, believing I will receive. How did You love others so much, Jesus?

*The Father, God, gave it to Me daily as I asked Him daily for it. It is surely not something humans are born with or grow into naturally. You are right. It is supernatural and comes out of My kingdom. So it is near. But you must seek it daily and sometimes even moment by moment. Keep doing this and keep working on this all the rest of your days on earth. I will help you and remind you. Even if someone really irritates you, ask Me to give you My love towards them. This will change you profoundly. Yes, it is part of the Agape Reformation you heard about. It is what I am doing right now on earth...bringing My people into a profound God-given love for one another and for others outside the Church. This will display My glory. Remember, they will know you are Christians by your love. They will know you are My disciples by your love. Keep seeking to be filled with My love daily. This is My desire and task for you right now. This is My best for you right now. This is My goal for you right now. This is My goal for your church too...to be filled with and led by My love.*

Father, today I ask You to give me love for others as I meet them. Guide me in caring for them as I care for myself. Fill me with Your love and lead me with Your love. Thy kingdom come and Thy will be done in me today. Let this love display Your glory today, Lord.

### **23. THE LORD WILL MAKE YOU WELL**

**James 5:14-15 NLT**

**Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord. Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well.**

My prayer

Thank You, Lord, for this Scripture that You led me to back in 1990 when I was diagnosed with cancer. You quickened this Scripture to me then, so I asked my church elders to anoint me and pray for my healing. Later, sometime after the surgery for cancer, the doctor told me they could hardly find any cancer cells in the tissue removed. She said that if there were any cancer cells, it was one or two at the most. I realize now that You really healed me when the elders prayed for me! Thank You for Your Word and the power of its promises!

## **24. GOD KNEW ME AND CHOSE ME**

**1 Peter 1:2**

Thank You, God, for knowing me and choosing me long ago! Thank You, Holy Spirit for making me holy and set apart unto God! Thank You, Jesus, that I am cleansed by Your blood given for me!

## **25. GOD SPEAKS IN MANY WAYS INCLUDING DREAMS AND VISIONS**

**Job 33:14-16**

**Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because he who has suffered in his body is done with sin. As a result, he does not live the rest of his earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God. (NIV)**

*Just keep going day after day listening to Me and obeying Me and trusting Me to provide everything needed to accomplish My purpose for you (and that includes writing this book, but much more also). I will be with you and I will do it all - if you let Me by waiting for Me and trusting in Me...faith. Your faith will please Me and I will act in response to it. Keep having faith.*

#### My prayer

Heavenly Father, I choose to keep on obeying You and trusting You to provide everything I need to accomplish Your purpose for me. Thank You that You will be with me and You will do it all if I let You. I want to live out my days free to pursue what You want, God, instead of being tyrannized by what I want. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.**

**Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.**

The Spiritual Armor is what we use as protection for ourselves and our loved ones. We use it as protection against those spiritual forces of darkness in the heavenly realms. Did you know there was a "heavenly realm?" It is a spiritual realm that exists right along with the natural realm in which we function daily. It has in it the forces of evil and the forces of good. We can influence that heavenly realm with our prayers, petitions, and declarations.

The Apostle Paul tells us about it in this passage from Ephesians. He tells us that our struggle is not against people, but against this spiritual realm which has in it rulers, authorities, powers, and forces

of evil. And he tells us that our armor of protection consists of salvation, righteousness, truth, the gospel of peace, faith, and the Word of God. He tells us to “put this on.” Why? So that “when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground.” Do we each have “a day of evil” come in our lives? Oh, yes! That is what he is teaching us. Do we want to “stand our ground” and not lose these battles? Well, I do, don’t you?

So I need to put on this spiritual armor and so do you. How do we put it on? I put it on in prayer by speaking out loud each piece of the armor and declaring it over myself and my loved ones whom I also want protected. I say something like this in my prayer:

#### My prayer

Lord, I place the helmet of salvation on mind. I declare that I belong to You and I have your salvation from sin and sickness because of Your body and blood given for that on the cross. I ask for Your mind to be in me today.

Lord, I place the breastplate of righteousness on myself. I declare by Your Word that “I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.” You, Jesus, became sin and took my sin upon Yourself that I might be free from it. If there is any sin in my life, please show it to me right now, that I may confess it before You and be cleansed.

Lord, I place the belt of truth on myself. I declare You are the truth and that Your Word is truth, and I stand on those because I belong to You. Guide me in speaking truth today.

Lord, I place the gospel of peace on my feet. Everywhere I go today, I declare peace will go with me. Guide me to those whom You want me to share the gospel of peace with this day.

Lord, I place the shield of faith in my hand as a shield from all the fiery darts of the evil one. I declare faith in You, Jesus, and in Your victory over that evil one. Guide me in recognizing any fiery darts sent to me from the enemy, that I might deflect them with the shield of faith. My faith is in You, Jesus.

Lord, I take up the Sword of the Spirit that is the Word of God. I declare Your Word as true and alive and active and powerful. I use Your Word to fight against the evil one. I ask You to place that Word in my mind and heart throughout this day that I may speak it forth as the Sword of the Spirit.

Lord, I pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and petitions. I ask You, and I declare that You, Holy Spirit, will put those prayers in my heart and mind as I go throughout this day.

Thank You, Lord, for this spiritual armor which You have given us to put on for protection against the forces of evil in the spiritual realm that we may be able to stand.

# HELPS FOR YOUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY

## HOW TO GIVE YOUR LIFE TO CHRIST

(Ideas from message by Ben Hogue on TBN)

The purpose of this is to give people an opportunity to receive Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior. This is about telling you of the gospel of Jesus Christ. It is a very specific and wonderful message.

And this is the message: that 2000 years ago in real human history, God came. He came in the person of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, so that you and I could know Him as our personal Lord and Savior.

The Scripture teaches that all of us have sinned, every one of us. Because of that we're separated from God. But because Jesus came 2000 years ago, because of who He was, the Son of God, and because of what He did on the cross--pay for our sin, enter into hell, be raised from the dead, ascend to the Father--because of what he did, you and I can know Him as our own Lord and Savior.

Now, think of what that means. That means that regardless of who you are, regardless of what you've done, regardless of the mistakes you've made, regardless of what you've been like, Jesus Christ can come into your life, He can forgive you for all those sins, and you can become a child of God. That's the gospel, the good news, that regardless of what you've done in your life, you can be forgiven, and Jesus can now be Lord and Savior of your life.

I want to invite you to receive Jesus Christ as your own personal Lord and Savior. And I want you to pray this prayer. If you will pray this specific prayer, according to the Word of God, the Lord will come into your life, He will forgive you of your sin, and you can become a Christian.

How do I know that? Here's how. The Scripture says in Romans 10:13 that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. That means if you'll pray and you'll invite Jesus to come into your life, and you're willing to genuinely surrender your life over to Him, and receive Him as Lord and Savior of your life, that means you can be saved right now, right where you are.

So I'm going to write here a prayer which you can pray. If you'll pray this and mean it, upon the authority of the Word of God, you can be a Christian right now, so pray this prayer now:

Dear Heavenly Father,  
I ask You to come into my life;  
I ask you to forgive me of my sin;  
And I ask You to make me a Christian.

Father, I believe Jesus is Your Son;  
I believe He came to this earth;  
I believe He died on the cross;  
I believe He was raised from the dead;  
And I believe You would forgive me of my sin if I would ask You to do it.  
So right now, in Jesus' name, I ask You to forgive me of my sin,  
And make me a Christian. Amen.

And if you prayed that prayer, and you meant it, I promise you, on the authority of the Word of God, that God just came into your life, and your sin has just been forgiven, and you've just been made a Christian.

If you prayed that prayer, and you invited Jesus to come in to your life, call the telephone number for Trinity Broadcasting Network telephone counselors at 1-888-731-1000. Call that number and behind that number, answering that phone, there will be some wonderful folks who will love you and pray with you and minister to you as long as it takes until you get all your questions settled. The reason they are there is so that you can receive the ministry that you need 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Now if you are a Christian, and you're away from the Lord, and you need to return to the Lord today, then you call that number also. Those folks know how to help you to get back into a real powerful relationship with the Lord Jesus.

## **Four Things To Know In Regard To The Gospel of Jesus Christ**

1. God loves you and has a wonderful purpose and plan for your life.

**“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.” (John 3:16)**

**“I have come that they may have life, and might have it to the full.” (John 10:10)**

2. We have all sinned and fallen short of God's plan for us, so we deserve death and hell This separates us from God so we cannot know and experience His love and plan for our lives.

**“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” (Romans 3:23)**

**“For the wages of sin is death.” (Romans 6:23)**

3. God made a provision for us to be free from sin through Jesus giving His life on the cross to pay the penalty for that sin. He is the only provision for man's sin.

**“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” (Romans 5:8)**

**“Christ died for our sins...that he was buried...that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.” (1 Cor. 15:3-4)**

**“Jesus answered: “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” (John 14:6)**

4. Our response to what Jesus did is to repent of our sin, ask Jesus to take away our sin, and have faith in Jesus and what He did. We must do this individually. Then we can know and experience God’s love and plan for our lives.

### **A prayer we can pray to receive Jesus into our hearts:**

**“Lord Jesus, I need You. I open the door of my life and receive You as my Savior and Lord. I know I am a sinner. Please forgive me of my sins and come into my life right now. Take control of my life and make me the kind of person You want me to be.”**

**“To all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.” (John 1:1)**

**“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.” (Revelation 3:20)**

**“And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.” (1 John 5:11-13)**

**“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--not by works, so that no one can boast.” (Ephesians 2:8-9)**

### **FOR YOUR CHRISTIAN GROWTH**

1. Go to God in prayer daily
2. Read God’s Word daily - begin with the Gospel of John
3. Find a church where God is honored and His Word is preached.
4. Obey God, moment by moment
5. Witness for Christ by your life and words
6. Trust God for every detail of your life



## HOW TO HAVE A QUIET TIME

For a believer Christ needs to be at the center of your life. Spending time with Him in your daily Quiet Time will help keep Him there. In my own “Spiritual Journey” I know of nothing else that has been as important to me as the daily Quiet Time for keeping my life focused, for giving me strength for each new day, for encouraging me when I am weary, and for developing over my lifetime a personal intimate relationship with Jesus. So, because I believe it is so important to my own “Spiritual Journey,” I want to share with you how to have a personal Quiet Time in your life too.

1. Set aside about 15 minutes (or as much as you wish) each morning. (I like to do an hour) This is more than a discipline, it is a personal appointment with Jesus. If you look at it that way, you will be more likely to keep that appointment.
2. Prepare for it the night before by setting the alarm to get up in time for that extra time. After I get up I find it helps me to do some things to wake up more fully... things like putting on my makeup, dressing, etc.
3. The place is important so find a place where you can be alone and not interrupted. Make this a special prepared place with your Bible there, a notebook and pen for writing ideas that come, and good lighting.
4. Ask God to be with you and guide you in this time.
5. Read the Bible according to the plan that suits you. There are some plans listed later in this Quiet Time article. As you read, ponder what you are reading, and possibly read it over more than once.
6. As you read, talk to Jesus, ask Him questions, write down your questions and the ideas He brings to your mind, and listen for His answers. Your purpose is to be with Jesus, so focus on Him. It's a time of communication and connection. You want that connection to continue all throughout your day. So talking and listening is an important part of growing that relationship.
7. Pray in relation to the Scripture you just read. The Word of God is powerful, so pray it out loud back to God.
8. Bring before him anything else that is on your heart but intersperse it with thanking Him, loving Him, telling Him about who He is to you and what He means to you. That's what you would do with a loved one, right? And He loves you more than anyone else!
9. Be sure to write down in your journal:
  - The date
  - The Scripture you read
  - What you said to God
  - What God said to you
10. Do this each day in the morning. Don't feel terrible if you miss a day, but return to having the Quiet Time the next day.
11. This will develop a habit in your life that will reap great rewards, new understandings, and the friendship with your Best Friend, Jesus.
12. God's love for us is not affected by our failure to return it; but our love for Him is. If we don't keep our communication with Him fresh, it may diminish or grow stale. The daily Quiet Time nourishes that fellowship.

13. We receive direction and guidance in our Quiet Times. This is a time and place where we learn God's will for us through His Word and communing with Him. It is important for us to present our needs to Him and receive His wisdom and direction. It was in my Quiet Time that He guided me to write this book for you.

## **BIBLE READING PLANS**

1. Start at the beginning of the Bible and read it straight through about a chapter a day.
2. Read Old Testament on Monday & Tuesday, Psalms and Proverbs on Wednesday, New Testament on Thursday and Friday, your Sunday School lesson on Saturday
3. Divide your Bible into sections and read a portion from each section each day: (e.g. a chapter or portion from the Old Testament, a portion from Psalms and Proverbs, and a portion from the New Testament). This way takes a longer Quiet Time, but helps keep your reading balanced.
4. I have had many different Bible reading plans through my years of Quiet Times. Right now I am using a plan whereby I divide the Bible into 4 sections: Old Testament, Psalms and Proverbs, Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John), and the rest of the New Testament. I read from the Old Testament one day, Psalms and Proverbs the next day, the Gospels the next day, and the rest of the New Testament the 4th day, then I begin again with the Old Testament the 5th day, etc.
5. It might be helpful to list the books of the Bible and the chapters in each book, then cross off each chapter as you read it.
6. Some publications may have a suggested plan printed in them.
7. There is a Bible that is divided into daily readings in such a way that you cover the whole Bible in a year. If you want to see this ask at your local Christian bookstore.

## **SPIRITUAL JOURNEY**

Before you give your life to Christ you are traveling the pathway of life as an unbeliever, on your own. After you hear the good news of what Jesus did for you (that He died on the cross for your sins), and after you give your life to Him, you become a believer at the beginning stage of your "Spiritual Journey."

You might think of yourself as a little baby who starts getting nourishment by drinking milk. The milk of God's Word is what nourishes you daily. This milk can come through your daily Quiet Time, and through learning at church from the Pastor and from Sunday School classes. It might come through participating in a fellowship group or Bible Study group. Growth can come through watching Christian television, through reading Christian books, through sharing and praying with other Christians. If you are not helped with your growth, you could remain as a spiritual baby as long as you live. So it is very important to do things for your own growth.

In the Scripture it mentions the spiritual baby in 1 Corinthians 3:1-2 where it says: "Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly--mere infants in Christ. I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it."

During this stage you need people to teach you and mentor you. I had wonderful mentoring during this stage from my sister, Joyce, and from many books and tapes she loaned me to listen to. The apostle Paul said we are like babies who need to grow or like a field in which seeds are planted or like a foundation for a holy temple.

During your “Spiritual Journey” it is important to have contacts with people ahead of you on the pathway who can mentor and teach you. It is also important to have contacts with others who are about the same distance along the spiritual pathway as you are. These are people with whom you can share, and pray, and with whom you can grow together. There are also people who will be behind you on the journey. They are those you can help and witness to about things which you have learned. When you begin your journey, you can witness to others who are still unbelievers and tell them about how you gave your life to Jesus. As you grow you can share what you have already been taught with others to help them grow too.

Eventually, as you grow and mature, you could become a discipler or mentor to someone else. Then your ministry could begin to multiply others into disciplers also. Perhaps you could become a Bible teacher, or have a helping ministry, or minister to the poor, depending on the gifting God gives you. You will find that your interests will coincide with your gifting. God will begin to build a passion in you for that which He purposes for you to do in serving Him. Your church may have a class or way of identifying your spiritual gifting. Seek this and learn all you can about ways God might want to use you.

Think about ways you could grow as a Christian. Be sure to include these ways in your daily life so you won't become stagnate. Here are some things to consider doing:

- Have a daily Quiet Time, read the Word, pray
- Attend church regularly and learn from the pastor and teachers there
- Participate in a Bible Study group
- Listen to Christian television and learn from leaders there
- Read good Christian books
- Attend special conferences or camps where you spend an extended time learning
- Ask another Christian to be your prayer partner, then learn and pray together
- Ask someone to be your mentor and teach you what they have already learned
- Listen to Christian videos, cassette tapes, or CD's
- Receive emails from Christian contacts such as [ElijahList.com](http://ElijahList.com), etc

Keep stirring up your enthusiasm for growing as a Christian. Don't expect someone else to do it for you, even though they can help. The main thing to do is read the Bible and do what it says.
