How the Lord Can Know Everything at the Same Time

Today we're going to talk about Me - who I am, what I'm like, how I feel. Make notes of what I tell you so you can put it in the book. I want others to know Me better also through your books.

I am so different from what you think of Me, that you would be totally surprised if I told you. So I won't tell you everything, but just a few things I want you to note here. This revelation of who I am will continue for several weeks, so expect more revelation to come on other mornings and at various times when I speak about it. Start a new file called: "Revelation of what the Lord says He is like." Put all these bits and pieces together into that file as you receive them.

Today I just want to tell you about one area of who I am that you have pondered many times: how I can know everything at the same time. That continually astounds you, but it is very simple when you get outside the area/sphere of time. And you can hardly imagine or comprehend that. That's ok. You don't need to. Just know that I DO know everything, and that I see everything - past, present, and future. Know this, and take this into account as you commune with Me.

I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me. I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. (Isaiah 46:9-10)

The Lord knows the thoughts of man. (Psalm 94:11)

Your Father knows what you need before you ask him. (Matthew 6:8)

The Lord knows those who are his. (2 Timothy 2:19)

I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. (Revelation 22:13)

His eyes are on the ways of men; he sees their every step. (Job 34:21)

O Lord, you have searched me and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O Lord. (Psalm 139:1-4)

## lam God of the Treasures Hidden in Darkness

Whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God. (John 3:21)

When I came into the world as a human, I came as Light to show all people (who would listen and believe) the way to all light and life which is in My Father and in Me.

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

For you have delivered me from death and my feet from stumbling, that I may walk before God in the light of life. (Psalm 56:13)

I came to earth and brought My Father's light to mankind. He is Light.

God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. (1 Tim 6:14-16)

If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin. (1 John 1:7)

The people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned. (Matthew 4:16)

Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. (Isaiah 60:1-3)

The Lord is my light and my salvation. (Psalm 27:1)

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path. (Psalm 119:105)

The unfolding of your words gives light. (Psalm 119:130)

I am the Lord who afflicts AND heals, Joan.

I know, O Lord, that your laws are righteous, and in faithfulness you have afflicted me. (Psalm 119:75)

For you, O God, tested us; you refined us like silver. You brought us into prison and laid burdens on our backs. You let men ride over our heads; we went through fire and water, but you brought us to a place of abundance. (Psalm 66:10-12)

Just like that picture you are thinking of which depicts Jesus carrying a little lamb on His shoulders. You have heard the story of how Jesus would break the leg of the lamb and then carry it on His shoulders while it healed - and this allowed for a deep bonding between Him and the lamb - that brought the lamb into alignment with His ways.

I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me. (John 10:14)

If you listen carefully to the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, who heals you. (Jehovah-Rapha) (Exodus 15:26)

I afflict and I heal. I have a mighty purpose for this, which you don't know or understand, but it's true non-the-less.

Just as I watched over them to uproot and tear down, and to overthrow, destroy and bring disaster, so I will watch over them to build and to plant. (Jeremiah 31:28)

But now, this is what the Lord says—he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. (Isaiah 43:1-2)

My purposes are greater than you can even imagine, so you don't and can't understand all My ways of doing things. Therefore you must live by faith in My goodness.

The righteous will live by faith. (Galatians 3:11)

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen. (Ephesians 3:20)

I give and I take away. I give afflictions and I take them away. I do this for My great and unknowable purposes.

"See, it is I who created the blacksmith who fans the coals into flame and forges a weapon fit for its work. And it is I who have created the destroyer to work havoc; no weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and this is their vindication from me," declares the Lord.

See, I have refined you, though not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction. (Isaiah 48:10)

Although I have afflicted you, O Judah, I will afflict you no more. (Naham 1:12)

You must trust Me by faith as you walk through this life, not by understanding. If you walked by understanding, then your faith would not grow, and I want your faith to grow. So don't even try to walk by your own understanding.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding, in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Although the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, your teachers will be hidden no more; with your own eyes you will see them. Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "this is the way; walk in it." (Isaiah 30:20-21)

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world. (John 16:33)

The moon will shine like the sun, and the sunlight will be seven times brighter, like the light of seven full days, when the Lord binds up the bruises of his people and heals the wounds he inflicted. (Isaiah 30:26)

If you do not carefully follow all the words of this law, which are written in this book, and do not revere this glorious and awesome name - the Lord your God - the Lord will send fearful plagues on you and your descendants, harsh and prolonged disasters, and severe and lingering illnesses. (Deuteronomy 28:59)

I will assemble the exiles and those I have brought to grief (those whom I have afflicted). (Micah 4:6)

We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may be revealed in our mortal body. So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you. (2 Corinthians 4:8-12)

A righteous man may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all. (Psalm 34:19)

Do not eat it (Passover) with bread made with yeast, but for seven days eat unleavened bread, the bread of affliction. (Deuteronomy 16:3)

This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me. (1 Corinthians 11:24)

By his wounds you have been healed. (1 Peter 2:24)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

I, the Holy Spirit, fellowship with you, live in you, teach you, convict you, and do things to bring you into unity with Us.

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. (John 14:26)

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth. (John 14:15-16)

Judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment! (James 2:13)

I love to give mercy. It is part of who I am...mercy.

I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings. (Hosea 6:6)

Love and mercy go together.

Because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions - it is by grace you have been saved. (Ephesians 2:4)

But I get to choose to whom I give mercy.

I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. (Exodus 33:19)

I especially pour out mercy on those who choose Me and My Son, Jesus.

In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. (1 Peter 1:3)

Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. (Psalm 23:6)

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. (Matthew 5:7)

Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the Pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, who satisfies you with good as long as you live, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (Psalm 103:2-5 RSV)

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. (Romans 12:1)

Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. (Matthew 13:43)

The path of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, shining ever brighter till the full light of day. (Proverbs 4:18)

The days of the blameless are known to the Lord, and their inheritance will endure forever. (Psalm 37:18)

I know all your days, Joan, not only the total number of days you will live, but what each and every day will bring to you and hold for you. You are blameless in My sight, not by your own goodness, but because you are cleansed completely by My blood. Therefore you belong to Me, and I know the days for you and what they will bring. You are one I have chosen to live in My holy courts even now while you are on the earth, and you will do that also when the judgment time comes in heaven – you will live in My holy courts. Notice it's plural – courts.

Blessed are those you choose and bring near to live in your courts! We are filled with the good things of your house, of your holy temple. (Psalm 65:4)

Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked. For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. (Psalm 84:10-11)

He who sows righteousness reaps a sure reward. (Proverbs 11:18)

He who respects a command is rewarded. (Proverbs 13:13b)

Prosperity is the reward of the righteous. (Proverbs 13:21)

If your enemy is hungry, give him food to eat; if he is thirsty, give him water to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head, and the Lord will reward you. (Proverbs 25:21-22)

The ransomed of the Lord will return. They will enter Zion with singing; everlasting joy will crown their heads. Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away. (Isaiah 51:11)

You will be a crown of splendor in the Lord's hand, a royal diadem in the hand of your God. (Isaiah 62:3)

Then those who feared the Lord talked with each other, and the Lord listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the Lord and honored his name. "They will be mine," says the Lord Almighty, "in the day when I make up my treasured possession (jewels)." (Malachi 3:16-17)

Surely the day is coming; it will burn like a furnace...But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall. (Malachi 4:1-2)

Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you. (Matthew 5:12)

Be careful not to do your acts of righteousness before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven. So when you give to the needy, do not announce it with trumpets, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and on the streets, to be honored by men. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. But when you give to the needy, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. (Matthew 6:1-4)

But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. (Matthew 6:6)

But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to men that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. (Matthew 6:17-18)

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. (Matthew 6:19-21)

Anyone who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and anyone who receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward. I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Jesus and because of the word of God. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. They will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years. (Revelation 20:4, 6)

## 7. The Satanic revolt and its judgment

When the thousand years are over Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth to gather them for battle. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! (2 Cor. 5:17)

2. You are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (2 Cor. 5:21)

3. You are the salt of the earth.

"You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men." (Matt 5:13)

4. You are the light of the world.

"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." (Matt 5:14)

5. What you say in faith without doubt, you get.

"Have faith in God," Jesus answered. "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. 14. You will bear much fruit.

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5)

15. You are loved by Jesus.

As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love..." (John 15:9)

16. You are loved by the Father.

"The Father himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God." (John 16:27)

17. You belong to God.

"I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours." (John 17:9)

18. You have the full joy of Jesus.

"I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them." (John 17:13)

19. You am protected from the evil one.

"My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one." (John 17:15)

20. You are sanctified in the truth of God's Word.

"Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth." (John 17:17)

21. You have been sent into the world.

"As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world." (John 17:18)

22. You have God's glory.

"I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one..." (John 17:22)

23. You have forgiveness of sins through Christ.

Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. (Acts 13:38)

24. You have been freed from all sins.

Through him everyone who believes is justified from everything you could not be justified from by the law of Moses. (Acts 13:39)

25. You are among the called of Jesus Christ.

And you also are among those who are called to belong to Jesus Christ. (Romans 1:6)

26. You are loved by God, a saint.

To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints... (Romans 1:7)

27. You have been justified by faith and you have peace with God.

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ... (Romans 5:1)

28. You have grace through faith.

(Jesus Christ)...through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. (Romans 5:2)

29. You have perseverance, character, and hope.

We also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. (Romans 5:3-4)

30. The love of God has been poured out in your heart through the Holy Spirit.

And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us. (Romans 5:5)

31. You have been justified by His blood and saved from the wrath of God.

Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! (Romans 5:9)

32. You reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:17)

33. You have been made righteous through the obedience of Christ.

For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:19)

34. You have died to sin.

We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? (Romans 6:2)

35. You have been baptized into Christ's death.

Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? (Romans 6:3)

36. You have been raised from the dead to walk in newness of life.

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:4)

37. You are no longer a slave of sin.

For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. (Romans 6:6)

38. You are dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. (Romans 6:11)

39. You are not under law, but under grace.

For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace. (Romans 6:14)

40. You are a slave of righteousness.

You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. (Romans 6:18)

41. You have now no condemnation.

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2)

42. You have been set free from the law of sin and of death.

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2)

43. You have life in your mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in you.

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. (Romans 8:11)

44. You are a child of God.

47. You have all things.

He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? (Romans 8:32)

48. No power can separate you from the love of God.

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

49. You have a measure of faith.

For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you. (Romans 12:3)

50. You have been given gifts.

We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. (Romans 12:6)

51. Whether you live or die, you are the Lord's.

If we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. (Romans 14:8)

52. You are full of goodness and filled with all knowledge.

I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another. (Romans 15:14)

53. You are sanctified in Jesus Christ.

To the church of God in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be holy... (1 Corinthians 1:2)

54. You have been given the grace of God in Christ Jesus.

I always thank God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus. (1 Corinthians 1:4)

55. You do not lack any spiritual gift.

Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. (1 Corinthians 1:7)

56. You are called into fellowship with Jesus Christ your Lord.

God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful. (1 Corinthians 1:9)

57. You have the mind of Christ.

But we have the mind of Christ. (1 Corinthians 2:16)

58. You are God's fellow-worker; You are God's field, God's building.

For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building. (1 Corinthians 3:9)

59. You are a temple of God in which the Spirit of God dwells.

Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)

60. You have been bought with a price.

You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

61. You will be raised from the dead imperishable and put on immortality.

Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed--in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality. (1 Corinthians 15:51-53)

62. You are comforted by God so you can comfort others.

...God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God. (2 Corinthians 1:3-4)

63. You are delivered from the peril of death.

He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. (2 Corinthians 1:10)

68. You walk by faith, not by sight.

We live by faith, not by sight. (2 Corinthians 5:7)

69. You are a new creation in Christ, old things have gone, the new has come.

70. You have the ministry of reconciliation.

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8)

73. You are crucified with Christ.

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. (Galatians 2:20)

74. You have the fruit of the Spirit.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. (Galatians 5:23)

75. You are blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

76. You are chosen in Him, holy and blameless before Him.

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. (Ephesians 1:4)

77. You are a son through Jesus Christ.

In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will... (Ephesians 1:5)

78. You have been raised up and seated with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:6)

79. You are saved by grace through faith.

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God -- not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8)

81. You are confident that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion.

...being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)

82. God is at work in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.

...for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose. (Philippians 2:13)

83. The peace of God guards your heart and mind.

And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7)

84. You can do all things through Him who strengthens you.

I can do everything through him who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:13)

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful... (Hebrews 12:28)

98. God will never leave you or forsake you.

God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5)

99. You are a chosen person, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, belonging to God.

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9)

100. You are a part of the family of God and you have received mercy.

Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (1 Peter 2:10)

101. By His wounds you are healed.

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed. (1 Peter 2:24)

102. You are an overcomer because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world. (1 John 4:4)
