I Am The Lord, The Author And Perfecter Of Your Faith

Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith. (Hebrews 12:2)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God. (Ephesians 2:8)

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will. (Ephesians 1:4)

That's how I elect you, Joan, how I choose you. I give you the grace to have faith in Me and believe in Me. Then you choose whether to receive that grace and faith, and live by it. It is by grace you are saved, and that is a gift of God. Thank Me for the grace to have faith, and ask Me for more grace to believe more and have greater faith.

The righteous will live by his faith. (Habakkuk 2:4)

For whatever does not originate and proceed from faith is sin [whatever is done without a conviction of its approval by God is sinful]. (Romans 14:23 AMP)

Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith will it be done to you"; and their sight was restored. (Matthew 9:29)

He replied, "Because you have so little faith. I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from hear to there' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." (Matthew 17:20)

"Have faith in God," Jesus answered. "I tell you the truth, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart but believes that what he says will happen, it will be done for him. Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours." (Mark 11:22-24)

I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge - that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3:17-19)

Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. (2 Corinthians 4:16-17)

To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of his mystery, which is Christ in you the hope of glory. (Colossians 1:27)

But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they may be like his glorious body. (Philippians 3:20-21) So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God. (1 Corinthians 10:31)

You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being. (Revelation 4:11)

Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples. (Psalm 96:3)

Ascribe to the Lord glory and strength. Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name (Psalm 96:7-8)

I Am The God Of Heaven

INHABITANTS OF HEAVEN

GOD: Hear from heaven, your dwelling place. (1 Kings 8:30)

CHRIST: He entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood. He entered heaven itself now to appear for us in God's presence. (Hebrews 9:12, 27)

HOLY SPIRIT: Where can I go from your Spirit? If I go up to the heavens, you are there. (Psalm 139:7-8)

ANGELS: For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven. (Matthew 18:10)

GOD'S PEOPLE: But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the judge of all men, to the spirits of righteous men made perfect. (Hebrews 12:22-23)

NEGATIVE CHARACTERISTICS

NO MARRIAGE: At the resurrection people will neither marry nor be given in marriage. (Matthew 22:30)

NO DEATH: Those who are considered worthy of taking part in that age and in the resurrection from the dead...can no longer die, for they are like the angels.

NO FLESH AND BLOOD: I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. (1 Corinthians 15:50)

NO CORRUPTION: So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. (1 Corinthians 15:42-44)

NO WEARINESS: For we know that when this earthly tent we live in is taken down (that is, when we die and leave this earthly body), we will have a house in heaven, an eternal body made for us by God himself and not by human hands. We grow weary in our present bodies, and we long to put on our heavenly bodies like new clothing. (2 Corinthians 5:1-2)

NO SORROW: And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes. (Revelation 7:17)

NO PAIN: There will be no death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away. (Revelation 21:4)

NO CURSE: No longer will there be any curse. (Revelation 22:3)

NO NIGHT: There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light. (Revelation 22:5)

NO WICKED PEOPLE: Outside (heaven) are the dogs, those who practice magic arts, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idolaters and everyone who loves and practices falsehood. (Revelation 22:15)

NO END: Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life. (Matthew 25:46) And they will reign forever and ever. (Revelation 22:5)

POSITIVE CHARACTERISTICS

JOY: I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents. (Luke 15:10)

REST: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on...They will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them. (Revelation 14:13)

PEACE: Remember that in your lifetime you received good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here. (Luke 16:25)

RIGHTEOUSNESS: But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness. (2 Peter 3:13)

SERVICE: They are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple. (Revelation 7:15)

REWARD: Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven. (Matthew 5:11, 12)

INHERITANCE: He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade--kept in heaven for you. (1 Peter 1:3-4)

GLORY: Now if we are children, then we are heirs - heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. (Romans 8:17-18)

ENTRANCE INTO FOR

RIGHTEOUS: Then the King will say to those on his right, "Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world...Then the righteous will answer him. (Matthew 25:34, 37)

CHANGED: Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed - in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will all be changed. (1 Corinthians 15:51-52)

SAVED: I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God. (John 3:5, 18, 21)

CALLED: Therefore, my brothers, be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fall, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 1:10-11)

OVERCOMERS: To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God. (Revelation 2:7)

THOSE ENROLLED: Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven. (Luke 10:20)

OBEDIENT: Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. (Revelation 22:14)

HOLY: The wedding supper of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear. (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.) (Revelation 19:8)

| Am The Lord Who Overshadows You

I am the Lord, your Covering, Joan. I overshadow you with My wings and protect you. I keep you safe from all things that I don't allow to come into your life. If I allow them to come into your life, it is for a purpose I want to perform in you, and that is always good.

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28)

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Psalm 91:1 KJV)

He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge. (Psalm 91: 4)

I want you to understand more of what it means for Me to overshadow you. So study My Word and see how I did this in the past. What I did before I can do again when it is My purpose and plan.

There he was transfigured before them. A bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!" (Matthew 17:2, 5)

"How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?" The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you." (Luke 1:34-35)

When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the Lord filled the temple. The priests could not enter the temple of the Lord because the glory of the Lord filled it. When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the Lord above the temple, they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave thanks to the Lord, saying, "He is good; his love endures forever." (2 Chronicles 7:1-3)

The priests then brought the ark of the Lord's covenant to its place in the inner sanctuary of the temple, the Most Holy Place, and put it beneath the wings of the cherubim. The cherubim spread their wings over the place of the ark and overshadowed the ark and its carrying poles. When the priests withdrew from the Holy Place, the cloud filled the temple of the Lord. And the priests could not perform their service because of the cloud, for the glory of the Lord filled his temple. (1 Kings 8:6--6,10-11)

Both high and low among men find refuge in the shadow of your wings. (Psalm 36:7)

May the Lord repay you for what you have done. May you be richly rewarded by the Lord, under whose wings you have come to take refuge. (Ruth 2:12)

Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings. (Psalm 17:8)

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, how often have I longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings. (Luke 13:34)

I will be your cloud and fire all the days of your life. I did it for the Israelites; would I do any less for you?

By day the Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people. (Exodus 13:21)

Then the angel of God, who had been traveling in front of Israel's army, withdrew and went behind them. The pillar of cloud also moved from in front and stood behind them, coming between the armies of Egypt and Israel. Throughout the night the cloud brought darkness to the one side and light to the other side; so neither went near the other all night long. (Exodus14:19-20)

By day you led them with a pillar of cloud, and by night with a pillar of fire to give them light on the way they were to take. Because of your great compassion you did not abandon them in the desert. By day the pillar of cloud did not cease to guide them on their path, nor the pillar of fire by night to shine on the way they were to take. (Nehemiah 9:12, 19)

On the day the tabernacle, the Tent of the Testimony, was set up, the cloud covered it. From evening till morning the cloud above the tabernacle looked like fire. Whenever the cloud lifted from above the Tent, the Israelites set out; whenever the cloud settled, the Israelites encamped. At the Lord's command the Israelites set out, and at his command they encamped. (Numbers 9:15-17)

He guided them with the cloud by day and with light from the fire all night. (Psalm 78:14)

He spread out a cloud as a covering, and a fire to give light at night. (Psalm 105:39)

I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. (1 Corinthians 10:1-2)

Think about these things and know that I am the Lord who overshadows YOU.

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. (Psalm 91:1)

I Am The Creator Of The Heavens And The Earth

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)

And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. (Genesis 1:3)

And God said, "Let there be an expanse between the waters to separate water from water." God called the expanse "sky." (Genesis 1:6, 8)

(Proverbs 8:22-29)

It is I who made the earth and created mankind upon it. My own hands stretched out the heavens; I marshaled their starry hosts. (Isaiah 45:12)

For this is what the Lord says - he who created the heavens, he is God; he who fashioned and made the earth, he founded it; he did not create it to be empty, but formed it to be inhabited - he says: "I am the Lord, and there is no other. (Isaiah 45:18)

I Am The Lord God To Whom Vengeance Belongs.

O Lord God, You to Whom vengeance belongs... shine forth! Rise up, O Judge of the earth; render to the proud a fit compensation! (Psalm 94:1-2)

For the Lord has a day of vengeance, a year of retribution, to uphold Zion's cause. (Isaiah 34:8)

Say to those with fearful hearts, "Be strong, do not fear; your God will come, he will come with vengeance; with divine retribution he will come to save you." (Isaiah 35:4)

It is mine to avenge; I will repay. (Deuteronomy 32:35)

See now that I myself am He! There is no god besides me. I put to death and I bring to life. I have wounded and I will heal, and no one can deliver out of my hand. (Deuteronomy 32:39)

I will take vengeance on my adversaries and repay those who hate me. (Deuteronomy 32:41)

The Lord watches over all who love him. (Psalm 145:20)

Turn to me and have mercy on me, as you always do to those who love your name. (Psalm 119:132) O Lord, God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of love with those who love him and obey his commands. (Nehemiah 1:5)

I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations, of those who love me and keep my commandments. (Exodus 20:6)

God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. (1 John 4:16)

Who among the gods is like you, O Lord? Who is like you - majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders? (Exodus 15:11)

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. (Psalm 19:1)

I will not yield my glory to another. (Isaiah 48:11)

It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, to search out a matter is the glory of kings. (Proverbs 25:2)

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)

The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. (Hebrews 1:3)

If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels. (Mark 8:38)

For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any doubleedged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. (Hebrews 4:12)

There is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known (Matthew 10:26)

If we had forgotten the name of our God or spread out our hands to a foreign god, would not God have discovered it, since he knows the secrets of the heart? (Psalm 44:20-21)

Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commands. (Deuteronomy 7:9)

When Moses went and told the people all the Lord's words and laws, they responded with one voice. "Everything the Lord has said we will do." Moses then wrote down everything the Lord had said. He got up the next morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain and set up twelve stone pillars representing the twelve tribes of Israel. Then he sent young Israelite men, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed young bulls as fellowship offerings to the Lord. Moses took half of the blood and put it in bowls, and the other half he sprinkled on the altar. Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it to the people They responded, "We will do everything the Lord has said; we will obey."

Moses then took the blood, sprinkled it on the people and said, "This is the blood of the covenant that the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words." (Exe 24:3-8)

Then the king called together all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem. He went up to the temple of the Lord with the men of Judah, the people of Jerusalem, the priests and the prophets - all the people from the least to the greatest. He read in their hearing all the words of the Book of the Covenant, which had been found in the temple of the Lord.

The king stood by the pillar and renewed the covenant in the presence of the Lord - to follow the Lord and keep his commands, regulations and decrees with all his heart and all his soul, thus confirming the words of the covenant written in this book. The all the people pledged themselves to the covenant. (2 Kings 23:1-3)

I will make an everlasting covenant with them; I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, so that they will never turn away from me. (Jeremiah 32:40)

Give ear and come to me; hear me, that your soul may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David. (Isaiah 55:3)

So I will establish my covenant with you, and you will know that I am the Lord. (Ezekiel 16:62)

The Lord confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them. (Psalm 25:14)

"The time is coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them," declares the Lord.

This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the Lord. "I will put my law in their minds and write in on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people." (Jeremiah 31:31)

When the hour came, Jesus and his apostles reclined at the table. And he said to the, "I have eagerly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds fulfillment in the kingdom of God."

After taking the cup, he gave thanks and said, "Take this and divide it among you. For I tell you I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." And he took the bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me."

In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you." (Luke 22:14-20)

In the case of a will, it is necessary to prove the death of the one who made it, because a will is in force only when somebody has died; it never takes effect while the one who made it is living. This is why even the first covenant was not put into effect without blood.

When Moses had proclaimed every commandment of the law to all the people, he took the blood of calves, together with water, scarlet wool and branches of hyssop, and sprinkled the scroll and all the people. He said, "This is the blood of the covenant, which God has commanded you to keep." In the same way, he sprinkled with the blood both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies.

In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and with out the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. (Hebrews 9:16-22)

May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (Heb 13:20)

I Am Lord Of The Millennium, My Kingdom On Earth

Yes, Joan, it IS amazing when you study about the Millennium, My thousand year reign upon the earth. It IS the time I fulfill all My promises to Israel. They had not worshiped the beast or his image and had not received his mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ a thousand years. (Revelation20:4-7)

(The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended.) This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with him for a thousand years. (Revelation 20:5-6)

Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits before his throne, and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. (Revelation 1:5)

For unto us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. (Isaiah 9:6-7)

See a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice. (Isaiah 32:1)

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks.

For he (David) says, "The Lord said to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet." (Matthew 22:41)

You will be with child and give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father, David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end. (Luke 1:31-33)

We do have such a high priest, who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven. (Hebrews 8:1) Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, singing: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!" To him who overcomes and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations - "He will rule them with an iron scepter; he will dash them to pieces like pottery" - just as I have received authority from my Father. (Revelation 2:26-28)

To him who overcomes, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I overcame and sat down with my Father on his throne. (Revelation 3:21)

Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations. No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him. (Revelation 22:3)

I am the God of Heaven and Hell. I am the God of Paradise and Hades. I created both. I bring those who belong to Me to Heaven to be with Me, and I place those who do not belong to Me in Hell, separated forever from Me.

There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores, and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.

The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. In hell, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. So he called to him, "Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire."

But Abraham replied, "Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony. And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us." (Luke 16:19-26)

One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"

But the other criminal rebuked him, "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong."

Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:39-43)

I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know - God knows. And I know that this man...was caught up to paradise. He heard inexpressible things, things that man is not permitted to tell. (2 Corinthians 12:2-4)

We are always confident and know that as long as we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord...We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord. So we make it our goal to please him whether we are at home in the body or away from it. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad. (2 Corinthians 5:6-10)

For to me to live is Christ and to die is gain. If I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labor for me. Yet what shall I choose? I do not know! I am torn between the two; I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far, but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body. (Philippians 1:21-24)

For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)

Then he will say to those on his left, "Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels...Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life. (Matthew 25:41, 46)

If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, shake the dust off your feet when you leave that home or town. I tell you the truth, it will be more bearable for Sodom and Gomorrah on the day of judgment than for that town. (Matthew 10:14-15)

If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body than for your whole body to be thrown into hell. Matthew 5:29-30

Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell. (Matthew 10:28)

God is just; He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you, and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power. (2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)

He will be tormented with burning sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment rises for ever and ever. There is no rest day or night for those who worship the beast and his image, or for anyone who receives the mark of his name. (Revelation 14:9-11) Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping. For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but sent them to hell, putting them into gloomy dungeons to be held for judgment; if he did not spare the ancient world when he brought the flood on its ungodly people, but protected Noah, a preacher of righteousness, and seven others; if he condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by burning them to ashes, and made them an example of what is going to happen to the ungodly; and if he rescued Lot, a righteous man...if this is so, then the Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials and to hold the unrighteous for the day of judgment, while continuing their punishment. (2 Peter 2:3-9)

The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus. (Acts 8:32-35)

You know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. (1 Peter 1:18-19)

Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth. (Revelation 5:6)

I watched as the Lamb opened the first of the seven seals. (Revelation 6:1)

You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, O Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you. (2 Chronicles 20:17)

I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what he will say to me, and what answer I am to give. (Habakkuk 2:1)

All men will hate you because of me, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved. (Matthew 10:22)

By standing firm you will gain life. (Luke 21:19)

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it. (1 Corinthians 10:12-13)

And he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand. (Romans 14:4)

Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. (1 Corinthians 15:58) Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be men of courage; be strong. (1 Corinthians 16:13)

Who may ascend the hill of the Lord? Who may stand in his holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to an idol or swear by what is false. He will receive blessing from the Lord and vindication from God his Savior. Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, O God of Jacob. (Psalm 24:3-6)

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. (Galatians 5:1)

Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then. (Ephesians 6:13-14)

So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the teachings we passed on to you. (2 Thessalonians 2:15)

## I Am The Lord Who Counsels You To Wait For Me

I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I put my hope. My soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen wait for the morning. (Psalm 130:5-6)

Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my doors, waiting at my doorway. For whoever finds me finds life, and receives favor from the Lord. (Proverbs 8:34-35)

If you do not stand firm in your faith, you will not stand at all. (Isaiah 7:9b)

Yet the Lord longs to be gracious to you; he rises to show you compassion. For the Lord is a God of justice. Blessed are all who wait for him. (Isaiah) 30:18)

I say to myself, "The Lord is my portion; therefore I will wait for him." (Lamentations 3:24)

Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. (Acts 1:4)

Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him. (Psalm 37:7)

Be patient, then, brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop and how patient he is for the autumn and spring rains. You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near. (James 5:7-8)

# I Am The Lord Who Calls You To Believe In Me

If you believe, Joan. Those are precious words - if you believe. I came to save all people who will come to Me and believe in Me. So I call all to believe in Me so they will be saved from death and have eternal life in Me. But they must believe. Some do and some don't believe. All who believe in Me will have eternal life, because believing means obeying Me and following Me. It is not just some head knowledge, but it is believing with your whole heart and soul. For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16 NLT)

God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. (John 3:17-18)

Anyone who believes in the Son of God has this testimony in his heart. Anyone who does not believe God has made him out to be a liar, because he has not believed the testimony God has given about his Son. (1 John 5:10)

For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time. God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus. (Romans 3:25)

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. (Romans 10:9)

But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? (Romans 10:14)

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. (Hebrews 11:6)

Since God in his wisdom saw to it that the world would never know him through human wisdom, He has used our foolish preaching to save those who believe. (1 Corinthians 1:21)

It is this Good News that saves you if you continue to believe the message I told you. (1 Corinthians 15:2)

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago. (Ephesians 2:8 NLT)

This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee was the first time Jesus revealed his glory. And his disciples believed in him. (John 2:11 NLT)

But when Jesus said "this temple," he meant his own body. After he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered he had said this, and they believed both the Scriptures and what Jesus had said. (John 2:21 NLT)

We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God. (John 6:69)

Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?" (John 11:40)

I am telling you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe that I am He. (John 13:19)

They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved you and your household." (Acts 16:31)

For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the believers who have died. (1 Thessalonians 4:14)

Now to him who is able to establish you by my gospel and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery hidden for long ages past, but now revealed and made known through the prophetic writings by the command of the eternal God, so that all nations might believe and obey him. (Romans 16:26)

## I Am The Lord Who Wants You To Be Content

Contentment is very important in a godly life. When I was on earth I was content with having very little in the way of earthly goods. I was content to not have a home of My own to live in. I was content to live on whatever My Father brought to Me. I was content to be humble and not famous. I was content with My relationships with My Father and with others around Me. I want you to be content with what I give you also.

I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do everything through him who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:11-13)

Godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that. (1 Timothy 6:6-8)

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5)

Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes? (Matthew 6:25)

Some soldiers asked him (John), "And what should we do?" He replied, "Don't extort money and don't accuse people falsely - be content with your pay." (Luke 3:14)

Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen, and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord. I will be joyful in God my Savior. (Habakkuk 3:17-18)

## I Am The Lord Of Life And Death

It is very important to understand what death is, Joan. Death is the moment in time when your body ceases to live. That is the natural death. But there is a spiritual death also. Spiritual death is the condition where the soul is separated from God, unless that soul is saved by believing in Me, and that is eternal.

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. (John 3:16-18)

I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. (John 5:24)

Sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men (Romans 5:12) The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. (1 Corinthians 15:21-22)

Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades. (Revelation 1:17-18)

Blessed and holy are those who have part in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over them. (Revelation 20:6)

The lake of fire is the second death. If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:14-15)

Then he will say to those on his left, "Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels." Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life. (Matthew 25:41, 46)

A time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out - those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. (John 5:28-29)

I Am The Lord Who Gives You Comfort And Encouragement

People need lots of encouragement, Joan, and these scriptures help with that. I am a God of comfort and encouragement for those who belong to Me. I will never leave them or forsake them. I have every answer they need and I can communicate those answers to them as needed. I can communicate all things to you. I can always give you comfort as you look to Me and seek Me for that. I am the God of all comfort.

But as for you, be strong and do not give up, for your work will be rewarded. (2 Chronicles 15:7)

The joy of the Lord is your strength. (Nehemiah 8:10)

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you. (Psalm 32:8)

But the eyes of the Lord are on those who fear him, on those whose hope is in his unfailing love. (Psalm 33:18)

Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me. (Psalm 50:15)

For the Lord gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. (Proverbs 2:6)

He holds victory in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless, for he guards the course of the just and protects the way of his faithful ones. (Proverbs 2:7-8)
