HABITATION

Figurative of:

Eternity

Isaiah 57:15 RSV

For thus says the high and lofty One who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite."

God's throne

Isaiah 63:15 RSV

Look down from heaven and see, from thy holy and glorious habitation.

But the men said to Saul, "Should Jonathan die - he who has brought about this great deliverance in Israel? Never! As surely as the Lord lives, not a hair of his head will fall to the ground, for he did this today with God's help." So the men rescued Jonathan, and he was not put to death.

Hammer: Word of God

Jeremiah 23:29

Is not my word like fire," declares the Lord, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?"

2 Corinthians 10:4-5

The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

And we do that with the hammer - the Word of God!

Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away... "The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of man. The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels."

Then, Jacob became angry, and upbraided Laban: Jacob said to Laban, "What is my offense? What is my sin, that you have hotly pursued me?"

Fatigue

Matthew 26:43

My father laid on you a heavy yoke; I will make it even heavier.

Sins

Isaiah 24:20

The earth reels like a drunkard, it sways like a hut in the wind; so heavy upon it is the guilt of its rebellion that it falls - never to rise again.

Sullenness

1 Kings 21:4 KJV

And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him.

Discouragement

Proverbs 31:6 KJV

Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.

Isaiah 59:1 KJV

Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear.

Judges 14:18

Because you rejoice and are glad, you who pillage my inheritance, because you frolic like a heifer threshing grain.

Obstinacy

Hosea 4:16

The Israelites are stubborn, like a stubborn heifer.

HELMET

Figurative of:

Salvation prepared

Isaiah 59:17

He put on righteousness as his breastplate, and the helmet of salvation on his head; he put of the garments of vengeance and wrapped himself in zeal as in a cloak.

Salvation provided

Ephesians 6:17

Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Salvation promised

1 Thessalonians 5:8

But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.

HIDE

Figurative of:

God's face

Deuteronomy 31:17-18

On that day I will become angry with them and forsake them; I will hide my face from them, and they will be destroyed...And I will certainly hide my face on that day because of all their wickedness in turning to other gods.

Protection

Isaiah 49:2

In the shadow of his hand he hid me.

God's Word

Psalm 119:11

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Darkness

Psalm 139:11-12

If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," even the darkness will not be dark to you.

For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him.

HIGHWAY - WAY - ROAD

Figurative of:

Holy way

Proverbs 16:17

The highway of the upright avoids evil; he who guards his way guards his life.

Israel's restoration

Isaiah 11:16

There will be a highway for the remnant of my people that is left from Assyria, and as there was for Israel when they came up from Egypt.

Gospel's call

Isaiah 40:3

A voice of one calling: "In the desert prepare the way for the Lord, make straight in the wilderness a highway for our God."

Way of salvation

Isaiah 35:8-10

And a highway will be there; it will be called the Way of Holiness. The unclean will not journey on it; it will be for those who walk in that Way; wicked fools will not go about on it. No lion will be there, nor will any ferocious beast get up on it; they will not be found there. But only the redeemed will walk there, and the ransomed of the Lord will return.

(Wages)

Figurative of:

Spiritual adultery

Ezekiel 16:32-33

You adulterous wife! You prefer strangers to your own husband! Every prostitute receives a fee, but you give gifts to all your lovers, bribing them to come to you from everywhere for your illicit favors.

Sexual relations

Genesis 30:16

So when Jacob came in from the fields that evening, Leah went out to meet him. "You must sleep with me," she said. "I have hired you with my son's mandrakes." So he slept with her that night.

Things consecrated

Isaiah 23:17-18

At the end of seventy years, the Lord will deal with Tyre. She will return to her hire as a prostitute and will ply her trade with all the kingdoms on the face of the earth. Yet her profit and her earnings will be set apart for the Lord; they will not be stored up or hoarded. Her profits will go to those who live before the Lord, for abundant food and fine clothes.

HONEY

Figurative of:

God's Word

Psalm 19:9-10

The he ordinances of the Lord are sure and altogether righteous. They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey from the comb.

God's blessings

Exodus 3:8

I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey.

Wisdom

Proverbs 24:13, 14

Eat honey, my son, for it is good; honey from the comb is sweet to your taste. Know also that wisdom is sweet to your soul; if you find it, there is a future hope for you, and your hope will not be cut off.

Pleasant words

Habakkuk 3:4 KJV

And his [God's] brightness was as the light; he had horns coming out of his hand: and there was the hiding of his power.

Christ's power

Revelation 5:6

Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

Power of the wicked

Psalm 22:21

Rescue me from the mouth of the lions; save me from the horns of the wild oxen.

Power of the earthly kingdoms

Daniel 7:7, 8, 24

After that, in my vision at night I looked, and there before me was a fourth beast -terrifying and frightening and very powerful. It had large iron teeth; it crushed and devoured its victims and trampled underfoot whatever was left. It was different from all the former beasts, and it had ten horns...The ten horns are ten kings who will come from this kingdom.

Power of the antichrist

Revelation 13:1

And I saw a beast coming out of the sea. He had ten horns and seven heads, with ten crowns on his horns, and on each head a blasphemous name.

Arrogance

1 Kings 22:11

Now Zedekiah son of Kenaanah had made iron horns and he declared, "This is what the Lord says: 'With these you will gore the Arameans until they are destroyed."

Conquests

Deuteronomy 33:17

In majesty he is like a firstborn bull; his horns are the horns of a wild ox. With them he will gore the nations, even those at the ends of the earth.

Exaltation

1 Samuel 2:1, 10

Then Hannah prayed and said: "My heart rejoices in the Lord; in the Lord my horn is lifted high."

Destruction

Jeremiah 48:25

"Moab's horn is cut off; her arm is broken," declares the Lord.

Salvation

Luke 1:69

He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David.

HORSE

Figurative of

Human trust

Hosea 14:3

Assyria cannot save us; we will not mount warhorses.

Obstinacy

Psalm 32:9

Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle, or they will not come to you.

James 3:3

When we put bits into the mouths of horses to make them obey us, we can turn the whole animal.

Impetuosity in sin

Jeremiah 8:6

No one repents of his wickedness, saying, "What have I done?" Each pursues his own course like a horse charging into battle.

God's protection

2 Kings 2:11

As they were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire and horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up to heaven in a whirlwind.

HOST OF HEAVEN

Used of stars as objects or worship

Objects of idolatry

Deuteronomy 4:19

When you look up to the sky and see the sun, the moon and the stars - all the heavenly array - do not be enticed into bowing down to them and worshiping things the Lord your God has apportioned to all the nations under heaven.

Practiced in Israel

2 Kings 17:16

They forsook all the commands of the Lord their God and made for themselves two idols cast in the shape of calves, and an Asherah pole. They bowed down to all the starry hosts, and they worshiped Baal.

Introduced by Manasseh

2 Kings 21:5

In both courts of the temple of the Lord, he built altars to all the starry hosts.

Abolished by Josiah

2 Kings 23:4-12

The king ordered Hilkiah the high priest, the priests next in rank and the doorkeepers to remove from the temple of the Lord all the articles made for Baal and Asherah and all the starry hosts. He burned them outside Jerusalem in the fields of the Kidron Valley.

Worship of, on roofs

Jeremiah 19:13

The houses in Jerusalem and those of the kings of Judah will be defiled like this place, Topheth - all the houses where they burned incense on the roofs to all the starry hosts and poured out drink offerings to other gods.

Used of stars as created things

Created by God

Isaiah 45:12

It is I who made the earth and created mankind upon it. My own hands stretched out the heavens; I marshaled their starry hosts.

Cannot be numbered

Jeremiah 33:22

I will make the descendants of David my servant and the Levites who minister before me as countless as the stars of the sky and as measureless as the sand on the seashore.

Named by God

Isaiah 40:26

Lift your eyes and look to the heavens; Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name.

To be dissolved

Isaiah 34:4

All the stars of the heavens will be dissolved and the sky rolled up like a scroll; all the starry host will fall like withered leaves from the vine, like shriveled figs from the fig tree.

Used of angels

Created by God

Nehemiah 9:6

You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to everything, and the multitudes of heaven worship you.

Around the throne

1 Kings 22:19

Micaiah continued, "Therefore hear the word of the Lord: I saw the Lord sitting on his throne with all the host of heaven standing around him on his right and on his left."

HOUR

(Hour: a division of time)

Used literally and descriptively of:

Christ's death

Mark 14:35

Going a little farther, he fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him.

Christ's betrayal

Matthew 26:45

Then he returned to the disciples and said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the hour is near, and the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. Rise, let us go! Here comes my betrayer!"

Christ's glorification

John 12:23

Jesus replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified."

Christ's set time

John 7:30

At this they tried to seize him, but no one laid a hand on him, because his time [hour] had not yet come.

Christ's predestined time

John 12:27

"Now, my heart is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour."

Used prophetically of:

Gospel age

John 4:21 RSV

Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father...But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth."

Great tribulation

Revelation 3:10

I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth.

God's judgment

Revelation 14:7

He said in a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come.

Christ's return

Matthew 24:42, 44, 50

Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come...So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him...The master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he is not aware of.

HOUSE

House: person

Matthew 12:44

When an evil spirit comes out of a man, it goes through arid places seeking rest and does not find it. Then it says, "I will return to the house I left."

House: the redeemed

2 Timothy 2:20

In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

House: life

Isaiah 38:12

Like a shepherd's tent my house has been pulled down and taken from me.

Figurative of:

Grave

Job 30:23 RSV

I know that thou wilt bring me to death, and to the house appointed for all living.

Body

2 Corinthians 5:1 NLT

For we know that when this earthly tent we live in is taken down (that is, when we die and leave this earthly body), we will have a house in heaven, an eternal body made for us by God himself and not by human hands.

Church here

Galatians 6:10 RSV

So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

Whole church

Hebrews 10:21

Since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith.

Earthly life

Security and insecurity

Matthew 7:24-27

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The sun, moon, and stars symbolize Jacob, his wife, and his twelve sons, which were the root of the tribe of Israel (Jacob) so this sign of the woman represents Israel. Out of Israel came the birth of Jesus Christ.

Psalm 72:5, 7

He will endure as long as the sun, as long as the moon, through all generations...In his days the righteous will flourish; prosperity will abound till the moon is no more.

Universal praise

Isaiah 66:23

From one New Moon to another and from one Sabbath to another, all mankind will come and bow down before me," says the Lord.

God's faithfulness

Jeremiah 31:35, 37

This is what the Lord says, he who appoints the sun to shine by day, who decrees the moon and stars to shine by night, who stirs up the sea so that its waves roar - the Lord Almighty is his name..."Only if the heavens above can be measured and the foundations of the earth below be searched out will I reject all the descendants of Israel because of all they have done."

Isaiah 32:20 RSV

Happy are you who sow beside all waters, who let the feet of the ox and the ass range free.

Minister's support

1 Corinthians 9:9-12

For it is written in the Law of Moses: "Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain." Is it about oxen that God is concerned? Surely he says this for us, doesn't he? POT - CALDRON

Oppression, Merciless punishment

"Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah, with his garments stained crimson? Who is this, robed in splendor, striding forward in the greatness of his strength?" "It is I, speaking in righteousness, mighty to save." "Why are your garments red, like those of one treading the winepress?" "I have trodden the winepress alone; from the nations no one was with me."

Persecution

Weakness

Isaiah 36:5-6

On whom are you depending, that you rebel against me? Look now, you are depending on Egypt, that splintered reed of a staff, which pierces a man's hand and wounds him if he leans on it!

Instability

Matthew 11:7

As John's disciples were leaving, Jesus began to speak to the crowd about him: "What did you go out into the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind?"

God's measure

Ezekiel 40:3 RSV

When he brought me there, behold, there was a man, whose appearance was like bronze, with a line of flax and a measuring reed in his hand.

Davidic line

Isaiah 42:3

A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out.

RICHES

Applied, spiritually to:

Christ

Isaiah 33:6

He will be a sure foundation for your times, a rich store of salvation and wisdom and knowledge; the fear of the Lord is the key to this treasure.

Oh the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God!

Colossians 2:3

My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Symbol of authority

Genesis 41:42

Then Pharaoh took his signet ring from his finger and put it on Joseph's finger. He dressed him in robes of fine linen and put a gold chain around his neck.

Sealing royal documents

Esther 3:12

These were written in the name of King Xerxes himself and sealed with his own ring.

Expression of position

Luke 15:22

But the father said to his servants, "Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found."

Figurative of:

Prosperity of saints

Psalm 1:3

He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

Affliction

Psalm 124:1, 4

If the Lord had not been on our side - the flood would have engulfed us, the torrent would have swept over us, the raging waters would have swept us away.

Christ

Isaiah 32:1, 2

See, a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice. Each man will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm, like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land.

God's presence

Isaiah 33:21

Figurative of:

Material foundation

Jeremiah 12:2

You have planted them, and they have taken root; they grow and bear fruit.

Remnant

Judges 5:14

Some came from Ephraim, whose roots were in Amalek.

National existence

Isaiah 14:30

But your root I will destroy by famine; it will slay your [Philistine] survivors.

National source

Romans 11:16-18

If the part of the dough [Israel] offered as firstfruits is holy, then the whole batch is holy; if the root is holy, so are the branches.

Cause

Job 19:28

If you say, "How we will hound him, since the root of the trouble lies in him."

Source of evil

1 Timothy 6:10

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.

Judgment and destruction

1 Kings 14:15
