SCORPIONS

Scorpions: demons

Luke 10:17

The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." (Jesus said) "I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy."

Ezekiel 2:6 Do not be afraid, though briers and thorns are all around you, and you live among scorpions.

Figurative of:

Heavy burdens

1 Kings 12:11

My father laid on you a heavy yoke; I will make it even heavier. My father scourged you with whips; I will scourge you with scorpions.

Agents of antichrist

Revelation 9:3, 5, 10

And out of the smoke locusts came down upon the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth... The agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes a man... they had tails and stings like scorpions, and in their tails they had power to torment people for five months. They had as king over them the angel of the Abyss, whose name in Hebrew is Adaddon, and Greek, Apollyon.

SEA

Sea: people, nations

Isaiah 27.1

In that day, the Lord will punish with his sword, his fierce, great and powerful sword, Leviathan the gliding serpent, Leviathan the coiling serpent; he will slay the monster of the sea.

Psalm 93:3-4

The seas have lifted up, O Lord, the seas have lifted up their voice; the seas have lifted up their pounding waves. Mightier than the thunder of the great waters, mightier than the breakers of the sea - the Lord on high is mighty.

Psalm 98:7

Let the sea resound, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it. Let the rivers clap their hands, let the mountains sing together for joy; let them sing before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world in righteousness and the peoples with equity.

The wicked

Isaiah 57:20

But the wicked are like the tossing sea, which cannot rest, whose waves cast up mire and mud.

Figurative of:

Extension of the Gospel

Isaiah 11:9

They will neither harm nor destroy on my holy mountain, for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.

Afflictions

Isaiah 43:2

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers they will not sweep over you.

Righteousness

Isaiah 48:18

If only you had paid attention to my commands, your peace would have been like a river, your righteousness like the waves of the sea.

False teachers

Jude 13

They are wild waves of the sea, foaming up their shame; wandering stars, for whom blackest darkness has been reserved forever.

SEAL

Seal: instrument used to authenticate ownership

Seal: Holy Spirit

Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

Figurative of:

Ownership of married love

Song of Solomon 4:12 You are a garden locked up, my sister, my bride; you are a spring enclosed, a sealed fountain.

Song of Solomon 8:6

Place me like a seal over your heart, like a seal on your arm; for love is as strong as death, its jealousy unyielding as the grave. It burns like a blazing fire, like a mighty flame.

Hidden things

Isaiah 29:11

For you this whole vision is nothing but words sealed in a scroll. And if you give the scroll to someone who can read, and say to him, "Read this, please," he will answer, "I can't; it is sealed."

Acceptance of Christ

John 3:32-33

He bears witness to what he has seen and heard, yet no one receives his testimony; he who receives his testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true.

God's witness to Christ

John 6:27

Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval. Believer's security

2 Corinthians 1:21-22

Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

Assurance

Ephesians 4:30

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

God's ownership of His people

Revelation 7:2-3

Then I saw another angel coming up from the east, having the seal of the living God. He called out in a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm the land and the sea: "Do not harm the land or the sea or the trees until we put a seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God."

SEED

Seed: the Word

Mark 4:3-8, 14

A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants, so that they did not bear grain. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, multiplying thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times... The farmer sows the word.

Seed: the message about the kingdom

Matthew 13:18-19

Listen the to what the parable of the sower means: When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is the seed along the path.

Seed: Jesus Christ

Galatians 3:19

What then, was the purpose of the law? It was added because of transgressions until the Seed [Galatians 4:4] to whom the promise referred had come.

Genesis 3:15

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring [seed] and hers; he will crush your head and you will strike his heel.

Good seed: people of the kingdom

Matthew 13:24-25

Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away."

Matthew 13:37-39

He answered, "The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of man. The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels."

Figurative of:

New believers

1 Peter 1:23

For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

God's Word

Matthew 13:3, 31-32

Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed... He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. Though it is the smallest of all your seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and perch in its branches."

Christ's death

John 12:24

I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.

Christians' body

1 Corinthians 15:36-37

How are the dead raised? With what kind of body will they come? When you sow, you do not plant the body that will be, but just a seed, perhaps of wheat or of something else. But God gives it a body as he has determined, and to each kind of seed he gives its own body.

SERPENT

Serpent: the devil, Satan

Genesis 3:1 KJV Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made.

Luke 10:19 He replied, ''I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy.''

Revelation 12:9

The great dragon was hurled down - that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray.

Figurative of:

Intoxication

Proverbs 23:31, 32

Do not gaze at wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the cup, when it goes down smoothly! In the end it bites like a snake and poisons like a viper.

Wisdom

Matthew 10:16

I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves.

Malice

Psalm 58:4

Their venom is like the venom of a snake, like that of a cobra that has stopped its ears.

Unexpected evil

Ecclesiastes 10:8

Whoever digs a pit may fall into it; whoever breaks through a wall may be bitten by a snake.

Enemies

Isaiah 14:29

Do not rejoice, all you Philistines, that the rod that struck you is broken; from the root of that snake will spring up a viper, its fruit will be a darting, venomous serpent.

Christ

John 3:14-16

Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.

Satan

Revelation 20:2

He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil, or Satan, and bound him for a thousand years.

SEVENS

Seven: a week of years, with each year being 360 days. Seventy 'sevens' equals 490 prophetic years

Daniel 9:24

Seventy 'sevens' are decreed for your people and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy.

Symbol of:

Purification

Psalm 12:6

And the words of the Lord are flawless, like silver refined in a furnace of clay, purified seven times.

Worship

Psalm 119:164 Seven times a day I praise you for your righteous laws.

Gospel light

Isaiah 30:26

The moon will shine like the sun, and the sunlight will be seven times brighter, like the light of seven full days, when the Lord binds up the bruises of his people, and heals the wounds he inflicted.

Spirits

Revelation 1:4

John, To the seven churches in the province of Asia: Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits before his throne.

Seals

Revelation 5:1

Then I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals.

Angels

Revelation 8:2

And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets.

Heads and crowns

Revelation 13:1

And I saw a beast coming out of the sea. He had ten horns and seven heads, with ten crowns on his horns, and on each head a blasphemous name.

Plagues

Revelation 15:6 Out of the temple came the seven angels with the seven plagues.

Bowls

Revelation 15:7

Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls filled with the wrath of God, who lives for ever and ever.

Kings

Revelation 17:10

They are also seven kings. Five have fallen, one is, the other has not yet come; but when he does come, he must remain for a little while.

SHEAVES

Sheaves: people who belong to the Lord

Genesis 37:7

Joseph had a dream, and when he told it to his brothers, they hated him all the more. He said to them, "Listen to this dream I had: We were binding sheaves of grain out in the field when suddenly my sheaf rose and stood upright, while your sheaves gathered around mine and bowed down to it."

Psalm 126:6

He who goes out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with him.

Sheaves: people gathered together by the Lord to be threshed (beaten)

Micah 4:12

But they do not know the thoughts of the Lord; they do not understand his plan, he who gathers them like sheaves to the threshing floor.

SHEPHERD

The Good Shepherd - Christ

John 10:14-15

I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me - just as the Father knows me and I know the Father - and I lay down my life for the sheep.

Shepherd of Israel -God

Psalm 80:1

Hear us, O Shepherd of Israel, you who lead Joseph like a flock; you who sit enthroned between the cherubim.

Isaiah 63:11

Then his people recalled the days of old, the days of Moses and his people - where is he who brought them through the sea, with the shepherd of his flock?

Worthless shepherd: one who deserts the flock

Zechariah 11:17 Woe to the worthless shepherd, who deserts the flock!

Hired hand: cares nothing for the sheep

John 10:12-13

The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep.

Descriptive of:

God

Psalm 78:52, 53

But he brought his people out like a flock; he led them like sheep through the desert. He guided them safely, so they were unafraid.

Christ

Hebrews 13:20

May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will.

Joshua

Numbers 27:16-23

Moses said to the Lord, "May the Lord, the God of the spirits of all mankind, appoint a man over this community to go out and come in before them, one who will lead them out and bring them in, so the Lord's people will not be like sheep without a shepherd."

So the Lord said to Moses, "Take Joshua son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay your hand on him. Have him stand before Eleazar the priest and the entire assembly and commission him in their presence. Give him some of your authority so the whole Israelite community will obey him."

David

2 Samuel 5:2

In the past, while Saul was king over us, you were the one who led Israel on their military campaigns. And the Lord said to you, "You will shepherd my people Israel, and you will become their ruler."

Judges

1 Chronicles 17:6

Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their leaders whom I commanded to shepherd my people, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?"

National leaders

Jeremiah 49:19

Like a lion coming up from Jordan's thickets to a rich pastureland, I will chase Edom from its land in an instant. Who is the chosen one I will appoint for this? Who is like me and who can challenge me? And what shepherd can stand against me?

Cyrus

Isaiah 44:28

[I am the Lord] who says of Cyrus, 'He is my shepherd and will accomplish all that I please; he will say of Jerusalem, "Let it be rebuilt," and of the temple, "Let its foundations be laid." '

Jewish leaders

Matthew 9:36

When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Church elders

1 Peter 5:1, 2

To the elders among you, I appeal as a fellow elder, a witness of Christ's sufferings and one who also will share in the glory to be revealed: Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers.

SHEEP

Sheep: those who belong to the Shepherd, Jesus Christ.

John 10:11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

Sheep: Those who know Jesus Christ, their Shepherd.

John 10:14 I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and my sheep know me

Sheep: those who listen to Jesus' voice

John 10:3 The sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

Sheep: those who follow Jesus and know his voice

John 10:4 His sheep follow him because they know his voice.

Figurative of:

Innocent

2 Samuel 24:17

When David saw the angel who was striking down the people, he said to the Lord, "I am the one who has sinned and done wrong. These are but sheep. What have they done? Let your hand fall upon me and my family."

Wicked

Psalm 49:14

Like sheep they are destined for the grave, and death will feed on them. The upright will rule over them in the morning; their forms will decay in the grave, far from their princely mansions.

Jewish people

Psalm 74:1 Why does your anger smolder against the sheep of your pasture?

Backsliders

Jeremiah 50:6 My people have been lost sheep.

Lost sinners

Matthew 9:36

When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Christians

John 10:7, 11, 14

I am the gate for the sheep...I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep...I know my sheep and my sheep know me.

Christ

John 1:29

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.

Church

Acts 20:28

Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood.

SHIELD

Figurative of:

God's protection

Psalm 33:20 We wait in hope for the Lord; he is our help and our shield.

Favor

Psalm 5:12

For surely, O Lord, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

Salvation

Psalm 18:35 RSV Thou hast given me the shield of thy salvation, and thy right hand supported me, and thy help made me great.

Truth

Psalm 91:4 KJV He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shall thou trust; his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

Faith

Ephesians 6:16

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.

Rulers

Psalm 47:9 RSV

The princes of the peoples gather as the people of the God of Abraham. For the shields of the earth belong to God; he is highly exalted!

SHOES

Symbolism of:

Putting on - readiness for a journey

Exodus 12:11 This is how you are to eat it: with your cloak tucked into your belt, your sandals on your feet and your staff in your hand. Eat it in haste. It is the Lord's Passover.

Putting off - reverence before God

Exodus 3:5

"Do not come any closer," God said. "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground."

Joshua 5:15 The commander of the Lord's army replied, "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy," And Joshua did so.

Want of - mourning

2 Samuel 15:30

But David continued up the Mount of Olives, weeping as he went; his head was covered and he was barefoot.

Giving to another - renunciation of Mosaic marriage right

Ruth 4:7-8

(Now in earlier times in Israel, for the redemption and transfer of property to become final, one party took off his sandal and gave it to the other. This was the method of legalizing transactions in Israel.) So the kinsman-redeemer said to Boaz, "Buy it yourself," And he removed his sandal.

To loose another's - act of homage

Luke 3:16

John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire."

Figurative of:

Preparation for service

Ephesians 6:14-15

Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

Protection and provision

Deuteronomy 33:25 KJV Thy shoes shall be iron and brass; and as thy days, so shall thy strength be.

Alertness

Isaiah 5:27

Not one of them grows tired or stumbles, not one slumbers or sleeps; not a belt is loosened at the waist, not a sandal thong is broken.

SIEVE

Figurative of:

God's judgment

Amos 9:9 For I will give the command, and I will shake the house of Israel among all the nations as grain is shaken in a sieve, and not a pebble will reach the ground.

Isaiah 30:28 He shakes the nations in the sieve of destruction.

Satan's temptation

Luke 22:31 Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat.



SILVER

Figurative of:

God's Word

Psalm 12:6 And the words of the Lord are flawless, like silver refined in a furnace of clay, purified seven times.

God's people

Zechariah 13:9

This third I will bring into the fire; I will refine them like silver and test them like gold. They will call on my name and I will answer them; I will say, "They are my people," and they will say, "The Lord is our God."

Understanding

Proverbs 3:13, 14 Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding, for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold.

Degeneration

Isaiah 1:22 Your silver has become dross, your choice wine is diluted with water.

Reprobation

Jeremiah 6:30 They are called rejected silver, because the Lord has rejected them.

SILVER CORD

Silver cord: that which ties you to life

Ecclesiastes 12:6-7

Remember him - before the silver cord is severed or the golden bowl is broken; before the pitcher is shattered at the spring, or the wheel broken at the well, and the dust returns to the ground it came from, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.

SMOKE

Figurative of:

God's anger

Deuteronomy 29:20 RSV

The Lord would not pardon him, but rather the anger of the Lord and his jealousy would smoke against that man, and the curses written in this book would settle upon him, and the Lord would blot out his name from under heaven.

Our life

Psalm 102:3 For my days vanish like smoke.

Spiritual distress

Psalm 119:83 Though I am like a wineskin in the smoke, I do not forget your decrees.

Weak nations

Isaiah 7:4

Be careful, keep calm and don't be afraid. Do not lose heart because of these two smoldering stubs of firewood.

Something offensive

Isaiah 65:5

[A people who continually provoke me] ...who say, "Keep away; don't come near me, for I am too sacred for you!" Such people are smoke in my nostrils, a fire that keeps burning all day.

Spirit's advent

Joel 2:29, 30

Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days. I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke.

Christ's gentleness

Matthew 12:20

A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out.

SNAKES

(See serpent)

Snakes: demons

Luke 10:17

The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." (Jesus said) "I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy."

Psalm 91:13

You will tread upon the lion and the cobra, you will trample the great lion and the serpent

SNOW

Snow: clean, pure

Isaiah 1:18-20

"Come now, let us reason together," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool. If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land, but if you resist and rebel, you will be devoured by the sword." For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.

Whiteness illustrative of:

Leprosy

Exodus 4:6

Then the Lord said, "Put your hand inside your cloak." So Moses put his hand into his cloak, and when he took it out, it was leprous, like snow.

Converted sinner

Psalm 51:7

Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

Nazarite's purity

Lamentations 4:7

Their princes were brighter than snow and whiter than milk.

Messiah's glory

Mark 9:3

His clothes became dazzling white (white as snow), whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them.

Angel

Matthew 28:2-3

And angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. his appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow.

Risen Christ

Revelation 1:14 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow.

SODOM

Figurative of:

Jerusalem

Isaiah 1:9-10

Unless the Lord Almighty had left us some survivors, we would have become like Sodom, we would have been like Gomorrah. Hear the word of the Lord, you rulers of Sodom: listen to the law of our God, you people of Gomorrah!

Judah

Ezekiel 16:46-48

Your older sister was Samaria, who lived to the north of you with her daughters; and your younger sister, who lived to the south of you with her daughters, was Sodom. You not only walked in their ways and copied their detestable practices, but in all your ways you soon became more depraved than they. As surely as I love, declares the Sovereign Lord, your sister Sodom and her daughters never did what you and your daughters have done.

Wickedness

Deuteronomy 32:32 Their vine comes from the vine of Sodom and from the fields of Gomorrah. Their grapes are filled with poison, and their clusters with bitterness.

Sin of, illustrative of:

Shamelessness

Isaiah 3:9

The look on their faces testifies against them; they parade their sin like Sodom; the do not hide it.

Obduracy

Jeremiah 23:14

And among the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen something horrible: they commit adultery and live a lie. They strengthen the hands of evildoers, so that no one turns from his wickedness. They are all like Sodom to me; the people of Jerusalem are like Gomorrah.

Unnaturalness

Jude 7

In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as an example of those who suffer the punishment of eternal fire.

Destruction of, illustrative of:

God's wrath

Deuteronomy 29:23

The whole land will be a burning waste of salt and sulfur - nothing planted, nothing sprouting, no vegetation growing on it. It will be like the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah and Zeboiim, which the Lord overthrew in fierce anger.

Sudden destruction

Lamentations 4:6

The punishment of my people is greater than that of Sodom, which was overthrown in a moment without a hand turned to help her.

Total destruction

Jeremiah 49:18

"As Sodom and Gomorrah were overthrown, along with their neighboring towns," says the Lord, "so no one will live there; no man will dwell in it."

Future judgment

Matthew 11:23, 24

And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted up to the skies? No, you will go down to the depths. If the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Sodom, it would have remained to this day. But I tell you, that it will be more bearable for Sodom on the day of judgment than for you.

Examples of wickedness

2 Peter 2:6

If he [God] condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by burning them to ashes, and made them an example of what is going to happen to the ungodly.

SOIL

Soil: where the word is planted, the heart

- 1. Hard soil: pathway
- 2. Rocky soil: shallow root, don't allow teaching of Word to go deep in their lives; give it up when trouble comes
- 3. Thorny soil: cares of world, deceitfulness of riches, desires for other things
- 4. Good soil: produces crop, multiplication

Matthew 13:8

Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop - a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.

Luke 8:15

But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.

Mark 4:3-8, 14

A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants, so that they did not bear grain. Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, multiplying thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times... The farmer sows the word.

Ezekiel 17:8

It had been planted in good soil by abundant water so that it would produce branches, bear fruit and become a splendid vine.

STAR

Star that had fallen to earth: Satan

Revelation 9:1-3

The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. The star was given the key to the shaft of the Abyss. When he opened the Abyss, smoke rose from it like the smoke from a giant furnace. The sun and sky were darkened by the smoke from the Abyss. And out of the smoke locusts came down upon the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth.

Isaiah 14:12

How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth.

Star: leader of church

Revelation 1:20

The seven stars that you saw in my right hand and of the seven golden lampstands is this: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Stars: the twelve tribes of Israel (also see Revelation 7:4-8)

Revelation 12:1-2

A great and wondrous sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head. She was pregnant and cried out in pain as she was about to give birth.

Stars: the angels who fell with Satan

Revelation 12:3

Then another sign appeared in heaven: an enormous red dragon with seven heads and ten horns and seven crowns on his heads. His tail swept a third of the stars out of the sky and flung them to the earth.

Revelation 12:7

And there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought back. But he was not strong enough, and they lost their place in heaven. The great dragon was hurled down - that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who lead the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him.

I see him, but not now: I behold him, but not near. A star will come out of Jacob; a scepter will rise out of Israel.

Christ's second advent

I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star.

Angels

Revelation 1:16, 20

In his right hand he held seven stars... The mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand...is this: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.

Princes

Daniel 8:10

It grew until it reached the host of the heavens, and it threw some of the starry host down to the earth and trampled on them.

Judgment

Ezekiel 32:7

When I snuff you out, I will cover the heavens and darken their stars; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon will not give its light. All the shining lights in the heavens I will darken over you; I will bring darkness over your land, declares the Sovereign Lord.

Contempt

2 Samuel 16:6, 13

He pelted David and all the king's officials with stones, though all the troops and the special guard were on David's right and left...So David and his men continued along the road while Shimei was going along the hillside opposite him, cursing as he went and throwing stones at him and showering him with dirt.

Christ rejected

Psalm 118:22 The stone the builders rejected has become the captstone.

Gift

Proverbs 17:8 RSV A bribe is like a magic stone in the eyes of him who gives it; wherever he turns he prospers.

Christ as foundation

Isaiah 28:16

So this is what the Sovereign Lord says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who trusts will never be dismayed."

Desolation

Jeremiah 51:26

"No rock will be taken from you for a cornerstone, nor any stone for a foundation, for you will be desolate forever," declares the Lord.

Unregeneracy

Ezekiel 11:19

I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh.

Christ's advent

Daniel 2:34, 35

While you were watching, a rock was cut out, but not by human hands. It struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and smashed them. Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were broken to pieces at the same time and became like chaff on a threshing floor in the summer. If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light.

On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper, so that contributions need not be made when I come.

ISAIAH 35

SUN

Sun: Jacob (Israel)

Genesis 37:9

Then he [Joseph] had another dream, and he told it to his brothers. "Listen," he said, "I had another dream, and this time the sun and moon and eleven stars were bowing down to me."

When he told his father as well as his brothers, his father rebuked him and said, "What is this dream you had? Will your mother and I and your brothers actually come and bow down to the ground before you?"

Revelation 12:1-2

A great and wondrous sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head. She was pregnant and cried out in pain as she was about to give birth.

The sun, moon, and stars symbolize Jacob, his wife, and his twelve sons, which were the root of the tribe of Israel (Jacob) so this sign of the woman represents Israel. Out of Israel came the birth of Jesus Christ.

Figurative of:

God's presence

Psalm 84:11

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless.

Earth's sphere of action

Ecclesiastes 1:3, 9, 14

What does man gain from all his labor at which he toils under the sun? ...What has been will be again, what has been done will be done again; there is nothing new under the sun... I have seen all the things that are done under the sun; all of them are meaningless, a chasing after the wind.

God's law

Psalm 19:1, 4-6

The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands...Their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens he has pitched a tent for the sun, which is like a bridegroom coming

forth from his pavilion, like a champion rejoicing to run his course. It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is hidden from its heat.

Future glory

Matthew 13:43

Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father.

Now therefore I tell you that I will not drive them out before you; they will be thorns in your sides and their gods will be a snare to you.

God's judgments

Jeremiah 51:33

The Daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor at the time it is trampled; the time to harvest her will soon come.

Minister's labor

1 Corinthians 9:9-10

For it is written in the Law of Moses: "Do not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain." Is it about oxen that God is concerned? Surely he says this for us, doesn't he? Yes, this was written for us, because when the plowman plows and the thresher threshes, they ought to do so in the hope of sharing in the harvest.

THUNDER

Figurative of:

God's power

Job 26:14 NLT These are just the beginning of all that he does, merely a whisper of his power. Who, then, can comprehend the thunder of his power?

Control

Psalm 104:7

But at your rebuke the waters fled, at the sound of your thunder they took to flight.

Majesty

Revelation 4:5

From the throne came flashes of lightning, rumblings and peals of thunder. Before the throne, seven lamps were blazing. These are the seven spirits of God.

Visitations of judgment

Revelation 11:19

Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and within his temple was seen the ark of his covenant. And there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake and a great hailstorm.

TIME

Time: one year Times: two years Half a time: half year

Revelation 12:14

The woman was given the two wings of a great eagle, so that she might fly to the place prepared for her in the desert, where she would be taken care of for a time, times and half a time, out of the serpent's reach.

My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you, turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding, and if you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God.

People of God

Exodus 19:5

Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession.

Man's spiritual possibilities

Matthew 12:35 RSV

The good man out of his good treasure brings forth good, and the evil man out of his evil treasure brings forth evil.

New life in Christ

TREES

Trees: people

Isaiah 44:23

Sing for joy, O heavens, for the Lord has done this; shout aloud, O earth beneath. Burst into song, you mountains, you forests and all your trees, for the Lord has redeemed Jacob, he displays his glory in Israel.

Good trees: the man with good things inside him, people of the kingdom

Psalm 1:2-3

He [the blessed man] is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

Psalm 92:13-15

The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; planted in the house of the Lord, they will flourish in the courts of our God. They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green, proclaiming, "The Lord is upright; he is my Rock, and there is no wickedness in him."

Bad trees: the man with bad things stored up in him

Matthew 12:33-35

Make a tree good and its fruit will be good, or make a tree bad and its fruit will be bad, for a tree is recognized by its fruit... how can you who are evil say anything good? For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil thing out of the evil stored up in him.

Pine tree: the man who is eternal, everlasting

Isaiah 55:12-13

You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands. Instead of a thornbush will grow the pine tree, and instead of briers the myrtle will grow.

Unnatural tree: Satan's growing empire with false teaching infiltrating the church

Matthew 13:31-32

The kingdom on heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds [evil spirits] come and perch in its branches.

Tree of the knowledge of good and evil: Satan's tree

Genesis 2:16-17

The Lord God commanded the man [Adam, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden, but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat of it you will surely die."

"You will not surely die," the serpent [Satan] said to the woman. "For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

Trees of the field: the people of the world

Isaiah 55:12 You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.

Tree of life: Jesus

Revelation 2:7

To the one who is victorious, I [Jesus] will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.

Trees: people

Isaiah 41:19-20

I will put in the desert the cedar and the acacia, the myrtle and the olive. I will set pines in the wasteland, the fir and the cypress together, so that people may see and know, may consider and understand, that the hand of the Lord has done this, that the Holy One of Israel has created it.

TRUMPET

Trumpets: symbols of testimony connected with the regathering and repentance of Israel after the Church Age is ended. (New Scofield NIV Study Bible, pg 176)

Joel 2:1-2

Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of the Lord is coming. It is close at hand - a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and blackness.

Used of, in Israel, to:

Signalize God's presence

Exodus 19:16, 19

On the morning of the third day there was thunder and lightning, with a thick cloud over the mountain, and a very loud trumpet blast... and the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder. Then Moses spoke and the voice of God answered him.

Regulate marchings

Numbers 10:2, 5, 6

Make two trumpets of hammered silver, and use them for calling the community together and for having the camps set out... When a trumpet blast is sounded, the tribes camping on the east are to set out. At the sounding of a second blast, the camps on the south are to set out. The blast will be the signal for setting out.

Call assemblies

Numbers 10:2, 3, 7

Make two trumpets of hammered silver, and use them for calling the community together and for having the camps set out. When both are sounded, the whole community is to assemble before you at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting... To gather the assembly, blow the trumpets, but not with the same signal.

Announce a feast

Leviticus 23:23-25

The Lord said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites: 'On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts. Do no regular work, but present an offering made to the Lord by fire.' "

Alert against an enemy

Nehemiah 4:17-20

Those who carried materials did their work with one hand and held a weapon in the other, and each of the builders wore his sword at his side as he worked. But the man who sounded the trumpet stayed with me. Then I said to the nobles, the officials and the rest of the people, "The work is extensive and spread out, and we are widely separated from each other along the wall. Whenever you hear the sound of the trumpet, join us there. Our God will fight for us!"

Herald a king

1 Kings 1:34

There have Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint him king over Israel. Blow the trumpet and shout, "Long live King Solomon!"

Hail a religious event

1 Chronicles 13:8

David and all the Israelites were celebrating with all their might before God, with sons and with harps, lyres, tambourines, cymbals and trumpets.

Assist in worship

Nehemiah 12:35-41

I assigned two large choirs to give thanks. One was to proceed on top of the wall...As well as some priests with trumpets...The second choir proceeded in the opposite direction... the two choirs that gave thanks then took their places in the house of God...with their trumpets. The sound of rejoicing in Jerusalem could be heard far away.

Uses of, at Christ's return, to:

Herald Christ's coming

Matthew 24:31

And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

Signalize prophetic events

Revelation 8:2, 6, 13

And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets...Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them...As I watched I head an eagle that was flying in midair call out in a loud voice: Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels!"

Revelation 9:13-14

The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice coming from the horns of the golden altar that is before God. It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates."

John 7:37-39

Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away."

Matthew 13:37-39

He answered, "The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of man. The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one, and the enemy who sows them is the devil. The harvest is the end of the age, and the harvesters are angels."

Week: seven years

Genesis 29:26-28

Laban replied, "It is not our custom here to give the younger daughter in marriage before the older one. Finish this daughter's bridal week; then we will give you the younger one also, in return for another seven years of work."

WELLS

Well: One's wife **Proverbs 5:15 Drink water from your own cistern, running water from your own well.**

Well: Mouth of the righteous **Proverbs 10:11 The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life.**

Well: Wisdom **Proverbs 16:22 Prudence is the fountain of life to the prudent.**

Well: Salvation Isaiah 12:3 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

Well: Rich blessings

Jeremiah 2:13

My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken me, the spring of living water (the fountain of living waters), and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water.

His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor, gathering his wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire. (Matthew 3:12)

As I looked at the living creatures, I saw a wheel on the ground beside each creature with its four faces....As they moved, they would go in any one of the four directions the creatures faced...Wherever the spirit would go, they would go, and the wheels would rise along with them, because the spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels...Above the expanse over their heads was what looked like a throne of sapphire, and high above on the throne was a figure like that of a man...This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord, and I heard the voice of one speaking...He said to me, "Son of man, I am sending you to the Israelites..."

Punishment

Proverbs 20:26 A wise king winnows out the wicked; he drives the threshing wheel over them.

Cycle of nature ("course")

James 3:6 RSV

And the tongue is a fire. The tongue is an unrighteous world among our members, staining the whole body, setting of fire the cycle of nature, and set on fire by hell.

God's sovereignty

Ezekiel 10:9, 18-19

I looked, and I saw beside the cherubim four wheels, one beside each of the cherubim...Then the glory of the Lord departed from over the threshold of the temple and stopped above the cherubim. While I watched, the cherubim spread their wings and rose from the ground, and as they went, the wheels went with them.

They stopped at the entrance to the east gate of the Lord's house, and the glory of the God of Israel was above them.

Desolate place

Matthew 3:1-3 RSV In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judea.

Desolation

Jeremiah 22:6 RSV

For thus says the Lord concerning the house of the king of Judah: "You are as Gilead to me, as the summit of Lebanon, yet surely I will make you a desert (wilderness), an uninhabited city.

WIND (S)

Winds: the Lord's messengers

Psalm 104:4 He makes winds his messengers, flames of fire his servants.

Four winds of heaven

Daniel 7:2

Daniel said: "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me were the four winds of heaven churning up the great sea.

Four winds of the earth

Revelation 7:1

After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth to prevent any wind from blowing on the land or on the sea or on any tree.

Four winds

Ezekiel 37:9

See, a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice. Each man will be like a shelter from the wind and a refuge from the storm, like streams of water in the desert and the shadow of a great rock in a thirsty land.

The woman was given the two wings of a great eagle, so that she might fly to the place prepared for her in the desert, where she will be taken care of for a time, times and half a time, out of the serpent's reach.

WOLVES

Wolves - men who distort the truth

Acts 20:29-31

I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them. So be on your guard!

Figurative of:

False teachers

Matthew 7:15

Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will know them.

Gospel transformation

Isaiah 11:6 The wolf will live with the lamb.

WOMAN

Woman: city

Revelation 17:18

The woman you saw is the great city that rules over the kings of the earth.

Woman: Israel

Revelation 12:1-2

A great and wondrous sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head. She was pregnant and cried out in pain as she was about to give birth.

Revelation 12:6

The woman fled into the desert to a place prepared for her by God, where she might be taken care of for 1,260 days.

WOMEN

Women: churches

Isaiah 4:1

In that day seven women will take hold of one man and say, "We will eat our own food and provide our own clothes; only let us be called by your name. Take away our disgrace."

Seven women represent the churches (See seven churches in Revelation 2 and 3). The churches will say to the one man (Jesus) that they will eat their own food (choose what they will believe rather than His Word), provide their own clothes (their own righteousness rather than His), but still want to be called by His name (Christians) so they won't be disgraced. (Ideas from Robert Morris in a sermon.)

WOOL

Wool: whiteness, cleanness

Isaiah 1:18-20

"Come now, let us reason together," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool. If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land, but if you resist and rebel, you will be devoured by the sword." For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.

YEAST

Yeast: that which grows until it influences all the dough.

Matthew 13:33

He told them still another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into a large amount of flour until it worked all through the dough.

Old yeast: malice and wickedness

1 Corinthians 5:6-8

Don't you know that a little yeast works through the whole batch of dough? Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast - as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed. Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.

Yeast: Teaching that is wrong.

Matthew 16:6, 11-12

"Be careful," Jesus said to them. "Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees." ... "How is it you don't understand that I was not talking to you about bread? But be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees." Then they understood that he was not telling them to guard against the yeast used in bread, but against the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

ZION

Figurative of:

Israel as a people of God

2 Kings 19:21 This is the word that the Lord has spoken against him: "The Virgin Daughter of Zion despises you and mocks you."

God's spiritual kingdom

Psalm 125:1

Those who trust the Lord are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever.

The Church

144,000: a pure group
