## SCRIPTURES ON WARRIOR

### **Exodus 15:3**

**The LORD is a warrior; the LORD is his name**

### **1 Chronicles 12:8**

**Some Gadites defected to David at his stronghold in the wilderness. They were brave warriors, ready for battle and able to handle the shield and spear. Their faces were the faces of lions, and they were as swift as gazelles in the mountains**

## THE GREATER WEAPONS

I am seeking the Lord for instruction about what are the greater weapons we need.

*The greater weapons you need, are the ones I used when I was on the earth. What were those?*

- 1. I retreated from others to spend time with My Father so He could tell Me what was coming and how He wanted Me to deal with it. Remember I said I do only what My Father shows Me and speak only what He tells Me?*
- 2. Then all day and all night I watched to see what He had told Me to watch for, and responded as He had instructed Me to deal with it.*
- 3. You get caught off guard because you don't seek Me ahead of time to know what is coming and how to deal with it.*

When should we do that, Lord?

*In your early morning quiet time is the best. Remember I got up early and went apart to spend time with My Father. If you seek Me this way, then I won't need to alert you to pray through signals to his body so much. I use those signals to keep you alert and seeking Me. But if you do this early each morning, then you won't need those signals. They are for your protection and safety.*

*I want you to know what's coming and how to deal with it ahead of time. Try this idea out and see how it works. Seek Me early each morning for a few days and see what I show you. Ask Me to show you during those times what is coming for that day and night, and ask Me then how to deal with it when it comes.*

*My Father always instructed Me because He loved Me. Do you think I would do any less for you? NO! I love you and I will instruct you also, like He did for Me.*

*Remember that I will instruct you and teach you in the way that you should go. I will counsel you and watch over you. (Psalm 32:8)*

Anything else, Lord?

# WATCHMEN

WATCHMAN - One who watches and reports to people what he sees and hears

## SCRIPTURES ON WATCHMEN

(The watchman prophet spends time before the Lord and speaks/writes what he sees and hears)

### **Jeremiah 1:11-12**

**The word of the Lord came to me: "What do you see, Jeremiah?"**

**"I see the branch of an almond tree," I replied.**

**The Lord said to me, "You have seen correctly, for I am watching to see that my word is fulfilled."**

(The watchman tells the king what he sees as he stands on the wall.)

### **2 Samuel 18:25**

**While David was sitting between the inner and outer gates the watchman went up to the roof of the gateway by the wall. As he looked out, he saw a man running alone. The watchman called out to the king and reported it.**

(The watchman watches for troops coming to see whose side they are on)

### **2 Kings 9:17**

**When the lookout standing on the tower in Jezreel saw Jehu's troops approaching, he called out, "I see some troops coming."**

(The watchmen must co-labor with the Lord or their watching is in vain.)

### **Psalm 127:1**

**Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchmen stand guard in vain.**

(The watchmen go throughout the city and help people)

### **Song of Solomon 3:3**

**The watchmen found me as they made their rounds in the city. "Have you seen the one my heart loves?"**

(The watchman watches what is happening and is alert, fully alert.)

### **Isaiah 21:6-7**

**This is what the Lord says to me: "Go, post a lookout and have him report what he sees. When he sees chariots with teams of horses, riders on donkeys or riders on camels, let him be alert, fully alert."**

(The watchman looks to see what is left of the night)

### **Isaiah 21:11**



**An oracle concerning Dumah: Someone calls to me from Seir, "Watchman, what is left of the night? Watchman, what is left of the night? If you would ask, then ask; and come back yet again."**

(The watchmen speak good news proclaiming salvation and God reigns;  
when the Lord returns they will see it with their own eyes)

**Isaiah 52:7-8**

**How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!" Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. When the Lord returns to Zion, they will see it with their own eyes.**

(The watchmen watch and tell the people like a trumpet sounding)

**Jeremiah 6:17**

**[The Lord says] "I appointed watchmen over you and said, 'Listen to the sound of the trumpet!'"**

(The watchmen will call people to go to the Lord)

**Jeremiah 31:6**

**There will be a day when watchmen cry out on the hills of Ephraim, 'Come, let us go up to Zion, to the Lord our God.'**

(The watchman is to hear the word the Lord speaks and warn others from Him)

**Ezekiel 3:17**

**At the end of seven days the word of the Lord came to me: "Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me.**

(It was the watchman's duty to sound warnings as the Lord leads him)

**Ezekiel 3:2-6**

**When I bring the sword against a land, and the people of the land choose one of their men and make him their watchman, and he sees the sword coming against the land and blows the trumpet to warn the people, then if anyone hears the trumpet but does not heed the warning and the sword comes and takes their life, their blood will be on their own head. Since they heard the sound of the trumpet but did not heed the warning, their blood will be on their own head. If they had heeded the warning, they would have saved themselves. But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet to warn the people and the sword comes and takes someone's life, that person's life will be taken because of their sin, but I will hold the watchman accountable for their blood.**

(The watchman sought the Lord and wrote down what He was told  
so others could run with it)

**Habakkuk 2:1-3**

**I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what he will say to me, and what answer I am to give to this complaint. Then the Lord replied: "Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it. For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay.**

## WEEPING AND GNASHING OF TEETH

WEEPING AND GNASHING OF TEETH - Regret, remorse, sorrow, crying

### SCRIPTURES ON WEEPING AND GNASHING OF TEETH

**Psalm 112:10**

**The wicked will see and be vexed, they will gnash their teeth and waste away; the longings of the wicked will come to nothing.**

**Matthew 8:11-12**

**I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. But the subjects of the kingdom will be thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**

**Matthew 13:41-42 KJV**

**And the Son of Man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; and shall cast them into a furnace of fire; there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.**

**Matthew 24:50-51**

**The master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he is not aware of. He will cut him to pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**

**Matthew 25:28-30**

**So take the bag of gold from him and give it to the one who has ten bags. For whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them. And throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**

**Luke 13:24-28**

**Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to. once the owner of the house gets up and closes the door, you will stand outside knocking and pleading, "Sir, open the door for us."**

**But he will answer, "I don't know you or where you come from"**

**Then you will say, "We ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets."**

**But he will reply, "I don't know you or where you come from. Away from me, all you evildoers!"**

**There will be weeping there, and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but you yourselves thrown out.**

(Quotes from Derek Prince's book *Prophetic Guide to the End Times*.)

Regarding *Weeping and Gnashing of Teeth* p 102-104

Then He [Jesus] says, "There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Jesus uses that phrase about five times in the New Testament for a certain category of people: those who have known all about Him, who have heard all the truth, who have been close to it perhaps all their lives, but never really committed themselves. And there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth because they will suddenly realize they were so close all their lives, they could have stepped in at any moment. But they never did, and now they are shut out forever.

1. Jesus first use of this phrase, found in Matthew 8:12, refers to "the sons of the kingdom." Jesus is speaking to His fellow Jews and saying, "You are rejecting Me, but the Gentiles will come. They will enter the Kingdom, and you will be shut out. And there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." These are people who have known it all, who had every opportunity but never availed themselves.
2. In Matthew 13:42 this phrase is used of the people who are the tares in the wheat field, looking exactly like the wheat but never producing fruit. Jesus says the angels will come and root them up and "cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth." All their lives these people have been close to it, right in the middle of it, but they never entered into it.
3. In Matthew 22:12-13, in the parable of the wedding feast, there is one guest who comes in without a wedding garment. Actually, he did not even have to buy his wedding garment -- the host provided it. So it is sheer audacity and presumption to walk in without one. When the master of the feast sees him, he says, "How did you come in here without a wedding garment?" The man is speechless. The master says, "Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Again, we see that this is somebody who knows all about it. He had received an invitation to the feast but he did not bother to put on the appropriate garment, which is the righteousness of Jesus Christ.
4. In Matthew 25:30, we find the "one talent" servant, and again it involves weeping and gnashing of teeth.
5. Finally, in Luke 13:26-28, there are people who say to Jesus, "We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets." And Jesus says to them, "I do not know you...Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity." And outside there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

## WELLS

WELL - A spring with its surrounding pool of water, or a pit dug in the ground to collect water.

### SCRIPTURES ON WELLS

**Genesis 24:11**

**He had the camels kneel down near the well outside the town (Abraham's servant who came to find Rebekah to be Isaac's bride)**

**Numbers 21:17**

**Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well! Sing about it, about the well that the princes dug, that the nobles of the people sank - the nobles with scepters and staffs."**

**2 Samuel 23:15, 16**

**David longed for water and said, "Oh, that someone would get me a drink of water from the well near the gate of Bethlehem!" So the three mighty warriors broke through Philistine lines, drew water from the well near the gate of Bethlehem and carried it back to David.**

**Song of Solomon 4:15**

**You are a garden fountain, a well of flowing water streaming down from Lebanon.**

**Jeremiah 6:7**

**As a well pours out its water, so she pours out her wickedness**

**Luke 14:5**

**If one of you has a child or an ox that falls into a well on the Sabbath day, will you not immediately pull it out?"**

### WELLS OF SALVATION

**With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation. (Isaiah 12:3)**

*salvation for you. What do I want you to read today? Look up "well" and see what all I talk about that word in My Word.*

## NAMES OF WELLS

### BEER

Numbers 21:16-17

**From there they continued on to Beer, the well where the Lord said to Moses, "Gather the people together and I will give them water." Then Israel sang this song: "Spring up, O well!**

### BEER-ELIM

Exodus 15:27

**Then they came to Elim, where there were twelve springs and seventy palm trees, and they camped there near the water.**

### BEER-IAHAI-ROI (well of the Living One who sees me)

Genesis 16:14

**She gave this name to the Lord who spoke to her: "you are the God who sees me," for she said, "I have now seen the One who sees me." That is why the well was called Beer Lahai Roi. (well of the Living One who sees me).**

### BEER-SHEBA (well of seven and well of the oath)

Genesis 21:30,31

**He replied, "Accept these seven lambs from my hand as a witness that I dug this well." So that place was called Beersheba (well of seven and well of the oath), because the two men swore an oath there.**

### BEEROTH

Deuteronomy 10:6

**And the children of Israel took their journey from Beeroth of the children of Jaakan to Mosera; there Aaron died, and there he was buried; and Eleazar his son ministered in the priest's office in his stead.**

### ESEK (dispute)

Genesis 26:20

**But the herders of Gerar quarreled with those of Isaac and said, "The water is ours!" So he named the well Esek (dispute), because they disputed with him.**

### HAGAR

Genesis 21:19

**Then God opened her eyes and she saw a well of water. So she went and filled the skin with water and gave the boy a drink.**

JACOB

John 4:6

**Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about noon.**

REHEBOTH (room)

Genesis 26:22

**He moved on from there and dug another well, and no one quarreled over it. He named it Rehoboth (room), saying, "Now the Lord has given us room and we will flourish in the land."**

SITNAH (opposition)

Genesis 26:21

**Then they dug another well, but they quarreled over that one also, so he named it Sitnah (opposition).**

Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. (Acts 13:38)

**24. I have been freed from all sins.**

Through him everyone who believes is justified from everything you could not be justified from by the law of Moses. (Acts 13:39)

**25. I am among the called of Jesus Christ.**

And you also are among those who are called to belong to Jesus Christ. (Romans 1:6)

**26. I am loved by God, a saint.**

To all in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints... (Romans 1:7)

**27. I have been justified by faith and I have peace with God.**

Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ... (Romans 5:1)

**28. I have grace through faith.**

(Jesus Christ)...through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. (Romans 5:2)

**29. I have perseverance, character, and hope.**

We also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. (Romans 5:3-4)

**30. The love of God has been poured out in my heart through the Holy Spirit.**

And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us. (Romans 5:5)

**31. I have been justified by His blood and saved from the wrath of God.**

Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God’s wrath through him! (Romans 5:9)

**32. I reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.**

For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God’s abundant provision of grace and the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:17)



**33. I have been made righteous through the obedience of Christ.**

For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:19)

**34. I have died to sin.**

We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? (Romans 6:2)

**35. I have been baptized into Christ's death.**

Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? (Romans 6:3)

**36. I have been raised from the dead to walk in newness of life.**

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. (Romans 6:4)

**37. I am no longer a slave of sin.**

For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. (Romans 6:6)

**38. I am dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.**

In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. (Romans 6:11)

**39. I am not under law, but under grace.**

For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace. (Romans 6:14)

**40. I am a slave of righteousness.**

You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness. (Romans 6:18)

**41. I have now no condemnation.**

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2)

**42. I have been set free from the law of sin and of death.**

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2)

**43. I have life in my mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in me.**

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. (Romans 8:11)

**44. I am a child of God.**

The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. (Romans 8:16)

**48. No power can separate me from the love of God.**

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

**49. I have a measure of faith.**

For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the measure of faith God has given you. (Romans 12:3)

**50. I have been given gifts.**

We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. (Romans 12:6)

**51. Whether I live or die, I am the Lord's.**

If we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. (Romans 14:8)

**52. I am full of goodness and filled with all knowledge.**

I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another. (Romans 15:14)

To the church of God in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus and called to be holy... (1 Corinthians 1:2)

**54. I have been given the grace of God in Christ Jesus.**

**55. I do not lack any spiritual gift.**

Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. (1 Corinthians 1:7)

**58. I am God's fellow-worker; I am God's field, God's building.**

**59. I am a temple of God in which the Spirit of God dwells.**

Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! (2 Corinthians 5:17)

**70. I have the ministry of reconciliation.**

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18)

**71. I am an ambassador for Christ.**

We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. (2 Corinthians 5:20)

**72. I have all sufficiency in everything.**

And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8)

**73. I am crucified with Christ.**

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. (Galatians 2:20)

**74. I have the fruit of the Spirit.**

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. (Galatians 5:23)

**75. I am blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.**

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

**76. I am chosen in Him, holy and blameless before Him.**

For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. (Ephesians 1:4)

**77. I am a son through Jesus Christ.**

In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will... (Ephesians 1:5)

**78. I have been raised up and seated with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.**

And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:6)

**79. I am saved by grace through faith.**

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God -- not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8)

**80. I have a power source within me which is able to do immeasurably more than all I ask or imagine.**

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen. (Ephesians 3:20)

**81. I am confident that He who began a good work in me will carry it on to completion.**

...being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. (Philippians 1:6)

**82. God is at work in me to will and to act according to his good purpose.**

...for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose. (Philippians 2:13)

**83. The peace of God guards my heart and mind.**

And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7)

**84. I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.**

I can do everything through him who gives me strength. (Philippians 4:13)

**85. God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.**

And God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

**86. I have been rescued from the dominion of darkness and brought into the kingdom of the Son.**

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. (Colossians 1:13)

**87. All my sin debt was paid in full at the cross.**

He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. (Colossians 2:13-14)

**88. I will meet the Lord in the air.**

After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. (1 Thessalonians 4:17)

**89. God has not given me a spirit of timidity, but of power, love and self-discipline.**

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline. (2 Timothy 1:7)

**90. I am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him.**

I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day. (2 Timothy 1:12)

**91. The Lord has laid up for me the crown of righteousness.**

Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day--and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing. (2 Timothy 4:8)

**92. Angels have been sent out to minister to me.**

Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation? (Hebrews 1:14)

**93. As I enter God's rest I rest from my own work.**

There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God; for anyone who enters God's rest also rests from his own work, just as God did from his. (Hebrews 4:9-10)

**94. I have a high priest who can sympathize with my weaknesses.**

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are--yet was without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)

**95. I have a great cloud of witnesses surrounding me.**

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. (Hebrews 12:1)

**96. God disciplines me for my good that I may share His holiness.**

God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness. (Hebrews 12:10)

**97. I have received a kingdom which cannot be shaken.**

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful... (Hebrews 12:28)

**98. God will never leave me or forsake me.**

God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." (Hebrews 13:5)

**99. I am a chosen person, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, belonging to God.**

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9)

**100. I am a part of the family of God and I have received mercy.**

Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (1 Peter 2:10)

**101. By His wounds I am healed.**

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed. (1 Peter 2:24)

**102. I am an overcomer because the one who is in me is greater than the one who is in the world.**

## **THE HIDDEN MANNA AND THE WHITE STONE**

Yesterday I was meditating again on the hidden manna and the white stone as I wrote out the rewards for being an overcomer in the book of Revelation. Then, later, I read an article by Rick Joyner online ([www.morningstarministries.org](http://www.morningstarministries.org)) called "The White Stone Promise" about that very Scripture. Here is what Rick said:

The hidden manna and stone with their name on it that no one knows speaks of a secret provision and relationship with the Lord. All Christians that refused to bow their knee to the new institution of the church [referring to Pope, etc] had to remain hidden because they were hunted and persecuted by the increasingly corrupted church. We can only imagine how confusing this was, but God took care of the faithful. There has always been a remnant that kept itself from the corruption of the world.

In Roman trials, the accused would be given a black stone if found guilty and a white stone if found innocent. By the Lord promising those who overcome in this period a white stone, He was saying to the overcomers that He found them innocent and has given them a new name, even if it could not be revealed yet. To be given a new name is one of the greatest honors from the Lord, such as when He gave Jacob the name Israel, and He also gave different names to some of His disciples. The

names given by God are a reflection of how He sees us, who we really are. It is far better to be known by God than by all men.

No one has ever gone into heaven except the one who came from heaven--the Son of Man.

The Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through  
him.

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned  
already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world,

Whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in  
him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.

Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit  
and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit, and his worshipers  
must worship in spirit and in truth.

My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.

My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I, too, am working.

## TOPICAL STUDY

I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does.

For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it.

Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father.

He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.

I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live.

For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself.

And he has given him authority to judge because he is the Son of Man.

A time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear this voice and come out--those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned

By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.

I have testimony weightier than that of John. For the very work that the Father has given me to finish, and which I am doing, testifies that the Father has sent me.

And the Father who sent me has himself testified concerning me.

These are the Scriptures that testify about me.

I do not accept praise from men,

I have come in my Father's name

If you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote about me.

The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent.

It is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.

I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.

All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away.

For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me.

And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day.

For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.

No one has seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father.

I tell you the truth, he who believes has everlasting life.

I am the bread of life. I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

I tell you the truth, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him.

Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me.

The words I have spoken to you are spirit and they are life.

The world - hates me because I testify that what it does is evil.

I am not yet going up to this Feast, because for me the right time has not yet come.

My teaching is not my own. It comes from him who sent me.

I am not here on my own, but he who sent me is true.

You do not know him, but I know him because I am from him and he sent me.

I am with you for only a short time, and then I go to the one who sent me.

Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him.

I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.

I know where I came from and where I am going.

I pass judgment on no one. But if I do judge, my decisions are right, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent me.

I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent me.

If you knew me, you would know my Father also.

I am going away, and you will look for me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come.

You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world.

When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am the one I claim to be and that I do nothing on my own but speak just what the Father has taught me.

The one who sent me is with me; he has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases him.

If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin.

If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and now am here. I have not come on my own; but he sent me.

Why is my language not clear to you? Because you are unable to hear what I say. You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire.

He who belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God.

I am not seeking glory for myself; but there is one who seeks it, and he is the judge.

I tell you the truth, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death.

My Father, whom you claim as your God, is the one who glorifies me.

I tell you the truth, before Abraham was born, I am!

## TOPICAL STUDY

As long as it is day, we must do the work of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work.

While I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

For judgment I have come into this world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind.

The man who enters by the gate is the shepherd of his sheep.

The watchman opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice.

He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.

I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep.

I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture.

I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me --just as the Father knows me and I know the Father--and I lay down my life for the sheep.

I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd.

The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life--only to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father.

The miracles I do in my Father's name speak for me, but you do not believe because you are not my sheep.

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;

No one can snatch them out of my hand.

My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.

I and the Father are one.

## TOPICAL STUDY

Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, 'I am God's Son'? Do not believe me unless I do what my Father does. But if I do it, even though you do not believe me, believe the miracles, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father.

(Lazarus) This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for God's glory so that God's Son may be glorified through it.

I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die.

Father, I thank you that you have heard me. I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me.

The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.

Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.

Now my heart is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name!

Now is the time for judgment on this world; now the prince of this world will be driven out.

But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.

When a man believes in me, he does not believe in me only, but in the one who sent me. When he looks at me, he sees the one who sent me. I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in me should stay in darkness.

As for the person who hears my words but does not keep them, I do not judge him. For I did not come to judge the world, but to save it. There is a judge for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; that very word which I spoke will condemn him at the last day.

For I did not speak of my own accord, but the Father who sent me commanded me what to say and how to say it. I know that his command leads to eternal life. So whatever I say is just what the Father has told me to say.

Unless I wash you, you have no part with me.

You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am.

I know those I have chosen.

I tell you the truth, whoever accepts anyone I send accepts me; and whoever accepts me accepts the one who sent me.



## TOPICAL STUDY

Now is the Son of Man glorified and God is glorified in him. If God is glorified in him, God will glorify the Son in himself, and will glorify him at once.

My children, I will be with you only a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I told the Jews, so I tell you now: Where I am going, you cannot come.

A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

Where I am going, you cannot follow now, but you will follow later.

Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me.

In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

You know the way to the place where I am going.

I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

If you really knew me, you would know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him.

Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father.

The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.

Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.

I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.

If you love me, you will obey what I command.

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.

Before long, the world will not see me anymore, but you will see me.

## TOPICAL STUDY

Because I live, you also will live. On that day you will realize that I am in my Father, and you are in me, and I am in you.

Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me.

He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him.

If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.

He who does not love me will not obey my teaching.

These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me.

But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives.

Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

I will not speak with you much longer, for the prince of this world is coming. He has no hold on me, but the world must learn that I love the Father and that I do exactly what my Father has commanded me.

I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful.

You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you.

Remain in me, and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.

I am the vine; you are the branches.

If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.

If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.

As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.

If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in his love.

## TOPICAL STUDY

I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends.

You are my friends if you do what I command.

I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit - fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.

This is my command: Love each other.

I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you.

When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me.

But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you.

He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you.

I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.

I came from the Father and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going back to the Father.

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

I have brought you glory on earth by completing the work you gave me to do. And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.

I have revealed you to those whom you gave me out of the world.

For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me.

I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours.

All I have is yours, and all you have is mine.

And glory has come to me through them. I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you.

While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me.

I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them.

I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world.

My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it.

Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.

I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one. I in them and you in me.

Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me.

I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them.

My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jews. But now my kingdom is from another place.

You are right in saying I am a king. In fact, for this reason I was born, and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me.

Peace be with you!

As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.

Receive the Holy Spirit.

If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven.

Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.

You must follow me.

I Am The Lord Who Changes You To Be Like Me

**Those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. (Romans 8:29)**

*Very slowly, one step at a time, I gradually change you into being like Me, Joan. This takes your whole lifetime to accomplish. I do it one day at a time. But this is a remarkable transition if you could only see it on the spiritual side like I do.*

**And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. (2 Corinthians 3:18)**

**Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.(2 Corinthians 4:16)**

*I watch the darkness in you decrease and the light in you increase step by step.*

(Job 33:14-18)**

*Another way I change you is by worship. Worship draws you into a special relationship with Me that comes no other way. And this special relationship brings about change in you. It helps take away the self-centeredness, which is born into mankind through the fall of Adam, and focuses your "self" instead on Me - something outside yourself.*

**Ascribe to the Lord, O families of nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength, ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name. Bring an offering and come before him; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness. (1 Chronicles 16:28-29)**

**Come let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. (Psalm 95:6-7)**

*I will complete the transition of changing you into being like Me when I bring you up here to be with Me forever. At that time you will give up your earthly body and take on your heavenly body which is like Mine.*

**But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body. (Philippians 3:20-21)**

*And we will be together forever and ever.*
